**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels dropped their third straight game, falling, 9-1, to the Akron RubberDucks in the series finale. The RubberDucks scored two in the first inning and plated four runs in the second to open an early 6-0 lead. **Brett Auerbach** brought in Richmond's only run with an RBI single in the fifth inning. George Valera and Will Brennan opened Akron's lead to 9-1 with RBI hits in the top of the ninth inning. Richmond relievers **Blake Rivera**, **Taylor Rashi** and **Chris Wright** combined for four scoreless innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels opener the finale of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This series is the first meeting between the two clubs this year and the first of two series the Flying Squirrels will play at FNB Field in 2022. Richmond returns to Harrisburg for a six-game series from June 14-19. The Senators will play the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond in a six-game series from August 30-September 4.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** had won seven straight prior to dropping the last three games. After winning the first three games of last week's home series against Akron to extend their winning streak to seven games overall, the Flying Squirrels lost the final three games of the set for a series split. Richmond leads the Eastern League's Southwest Division by one game over second-place Erie.

**THE SENATORS** have lost three of their last five games. Last week, they lost three of five at Bowie, including being swept in a double-header to close the series on Sunday afternoon. Harrisburg has lost its last two series, falling in four of six against Hartford at home from April 27-May 1 prior to last week's series in Bowie. Harrisburg's roster includes four of the Washington Nationals' Top-30 prospects as rated by MLB.com, including RHP Cole Henry (3), LHP Matt Cronin (13), LHP Evan Lee (18) and SS Jackson Cluff (22). Taylor Gushue is currently tied for fourth in the Eastern League in home runs (6), seventh in OBP (.416), second in SLG (.607) and second in OPS (1.023). Justin Connell is tied for fourth in homers (4), eighth in SLG (.533) and tied for first in runs scored (21). Jake Alu is tied for fourth in RBIs (18), tied for seventh in hits (25) and tied for ninth in total bases (43). Matt Brill is leading the EL in saves (8).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Bryan Brickhouse** makes his sixth start of the season. Lat time out, he worked his longest outing of the year, throwing six innings and allowed two runs against Akron on Wednesday and matched a season high with seven strikeouts. Brickhouse was signed as a free agent with a non-roster invitation to spring training by the Giants on December 15, 2021. Last year, Brickhouse signed with the Los Angeles Dodgers and spent the season with Double-A Tulsa, making 10 starts and nine relief outings. He was originally drafted by the Kansas City Royals in 2011 and retired in 2017 after battling injuries. He returned to the field in the 2018 season. **For more on Brickhouse, see page two.**

**FOR HARRISBURG:** Right-hander Ronald Herrera makes his sixth start of the season. He last pitched last Tuesday at Bowie and allowed five runs (four earned) over five innings for the second straight start. Herrera is pitching his fifth season at the Double-A level dating back to 2015 with San Antonio. He also pitched for Trenton from 2016-2017 and with Frisco in 2019. Last year, he made six starts for the independent New Jersey Jackals of the Frontier League, going 2-2 with a 4.68 ERA in six starts. In his career, Herrera has pitched for the Oakland, San Diego, New York (AL), Texas and Washington organizations. He signed as a free agent with the Nationals on February 9.

**WINNING EARLY:** The Flying Squirrels are sitting in first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division, 1.0 game over second-place Erie. Richmond's 16-11 record is tied for the best start in franchise history through 27 games, even with the team's start in its inaugural season in 2010. That year, the team also posted the franchise's best record through 28 games at 17-11.

**COMEBACK KIDS:** On the year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in eight of their 16 wins. Richmond trailed before coming back to win in five straight victories from April 13-21. On April 13, the fell behind, 5-1, to the Curve before scoring nine runs in a 10-6 win. On April 14, Altoona pulled ahead 3-0 in the first before Richmond rallied and took the lead with a two-run homer by **Sean Roby** in the seventh. On April 16, the Curve pulled ahead, 4-0, before Richmond scored the next eight runs to win, 8-4. On April 17, Altoona led, 2-1, before the Flying Squirrels tied the game in the eighth and later won on a walk-off grand slam by **Will Wilson** in the bottom of the 10th. In the second game of a double-header on April 21 at Erie, the SeaWolves scored two in the first inning and the game was tied, 3-3, in the last frame before the Flying Squirrels plated five runs in the top of the seventh. On April 30, the Baysox took an early 1-0 lead before the Flying Squirrels scored the next three runs to win 3-1. On Tuesday, the RubberDucks opened a 3-0 lead in the fourth and pulled ahead in the top of the ninth, 4-3, before **Frankie Tostado** tied the game in the bottom of the ninth and **Shane Matheny** hit a walk-off single in the 10th. On Wednesday, Akron pulled ahead, 2-1, until a six-run seventh pushed the Flying Squirrels to a 7-3 win.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** On the year, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (109,030) and average attendance (6,057). Richmond is third of the 120 MiLB teams in total attendance and 10th in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 34 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League. **Sean Roby** is tied for the league lead with eight homers on the season, with seven coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 174 home runs.

**STRONG ARMS:** Since April 28, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a 2.77 ERA (28 ER/91.0 IP) in 10 games, which is second-best in the league behind Somerset (2.45, 9 G). The Richmond pitching staff has held the Baysox and RubberDucks to a .209 batting average the last eight games.

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** is tied for the lead in the Eastern League with eight home runs on the season. With his two-run homer on April 29, Roby tied the franchise record for the most home runs in a calendar month, evening **Jarret Parker's** record of eight from May 2013. Seven of Roby's home runs have come at The Diamond, which ties him for the fifth-most homers in a season at home in franchise history.

**TOASTY:** After hitting .263 (10-for-38) over his first 10 games of the year, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .346 (19-for-55) with three homers, three doubles and nine RBIs over his last 14 games since April 22. He went 0-for-4 on Thursday, snapping his league-leading 10-game hitting streak. Tostado is ranked fourth in the Eastern League in batting average (.312) and tied for third in hits (29).

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Sean Roby** is tied for the league lead in home runs (8), tied for seventh in RBIs (17), fourth in SLG (.573), eighth in OPS (.924) and third in total bases (47). **Frankie Tostado** is fourth in batting average (.312), tied for third in hits (29) and tied for seventh in total bases (44). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for third (3). **Jake Dahlberg** is tied for first in games started (6) and third in innings pitched (30.1). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for first in starts (6) and seventh in innings pitched (28.0). **Chris Wright** is tied for sixth in saves (3).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).

**ROAD TO THE SHOW:** Right-handed pitcher **Sean Hjelle**, who pitched for the Flying Squirrels in the 2019 and 2021 seasons, made his Major League debut for the San Francisco Giants on Friday night against the St. Louis Cardinals. He worked the seventh inning out of the bullpen and did not allow a base runner, picking up his first strikeout by getting Corey Dickerson swinging. With his debut, Hjelle tied former pitcher Jon Rauch as the tallest player on record in MLB history at 6-foot-11. With the Flying Squirrels, Hjelle made 19 starts over two seasons and went 4-4 with a 3.96 ERA.
