Closing Time – The fifth season of WooSox Baseball at Polar Park – a fifth consecutive winning campaign that began 178 days ago on a sunny and crisp March 28th day (the earliest start date ever for a Red Sox Minor League team) - comes to a conclusion this afternoon on another sunny and cool day (about 24 hours before the Fall solstice arrives) when the Worcester Red Sox host the Rochester Red Wings for the final game of the 2025 season at Polar Park at 1:05 pm. The game is live on NESN+ with radio coverage on NASH Icon 98.9 FM.

Winners - Worcester's five straight winning seasons (2021-2025) are the first for a Boston Triple-A affiliate since the Pawtucket Red Sox had five consecutive winning years from 1996-2000. Furthermore, WooSox manager Chad Tracy becomes the first Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever have four winning seasons in a row. "Trace" took over in 2022 and has since gone 75-73, 79-68, 79-71, and 75-73 (with one game to go). The 40-year-old WooSox skipper is 308-285 overall in his four seasons at the helm of the WooSox.

The Grand Finale for WooSox '25 at Polar Park - Today is the final day of Fan Appreciation Week/Weekend at Polar Park that has featured six days of fan/player interaction, special deals, and gifts for fans. Gate C opens this morning at 10:30 a.m. for season ticket members and then all gates open at 10:45 a.m. for all fans. Among the highlights before, during, and after the home finale are:

- Fans will receive a 2025 WooSox Team Poster as they enter the park and from 11:00 – 11:45 a.m., fans can go on the field for autographs from the players and coaches who will be seated at tables around the warning track.
- WooSox Player Awards and other honors will be presented during pre-game ceremonies
- Also in pre-game ceremonies, the WooSox Rewards Fan of the Year will be feted while the town of Natick will be presented with a trophy and a championship banner for once again producing the highest turnout during "Town Takeovers" at Polar Park this season.
- After opening ceremonies, fans will pay tribute to Childhood Cancer Awareness
- Passing of the Puck to our neighbors in sports, the Worcester Railers who begin play in October
- After the game, players will sign soft baseballs and toss them into the stands.
- Lucky fans selected at random during the game will return to the field at the conclusion of the game as players give them "the shirts off their backs" in appreciation for their season-long support.
- Once that is done, "Kids (young and old) Run the Bases".
- And finally, fans can play catch into the night on the outfield grass with an unlimited Sunset Catch on the Field, presented by Planet Fitness to cap off our final "Fallon Health Family Funday Sunday" and our final game of a memorable 2025 season!

Thank You Fans – WooSox fans will finish 6th in the country in average attendance among all 120 Minor League Baseball teams this season. Today's sellout crowd of 9,508 (the 25th of the season at Polar Park) will push Worcester's final attendance total to 455,467 in 66 openings for an average of 6,901 fans per opening. With today's attendance total factored in, the WooSox will have drawn a total of 2,339,957 fans in their five years of existence. Furthermore, the WooSox are the only team in Minor League Baseball to sell more than 500,000 tickets in each of the last four years. Thank you WooSox fans!

Wait 'Til Next Year – For those who want to count down the days, after today it will be a mere 186 days before the 2026 WooSox take the Polar Park field to play their home-opener on Friday, March 27, 2026 vs. the Syracuse Mets at 4:05 pm. March 27th will then be the earliest date ever a Red Sox Minor League team has started a season. Of course, Polar Park will be far from dark this baseball off-season as several special events are already planned highlighted by "Boo in the Woo", a Halloween Festival throughout much of October with a spooky nighttime experience for mature audiences and a fall festival for children and families on weekend afternoons, as well as "Winter in WooVille" throughout much of December when Polar Park is transformed into a magical holiday destination. We will keep you posted on the many community and civic events that will take place inside and outside Polar Park this fall & winter.

Besting Rochester – No matter the outcome today, Worcester will post their best record in their history against any International League opponent in a single season as they are 17-6 vs. Rochester with today's finale on tap. Last season the WooSox went 16-7 vs. Lehigh Valley and that .696 winning pct. is their best against any IL foe (of more than six games) since they came into existence in 2021. During that inaugural 2021 Covid-impacted season, the WooSox only faced five different opponents all year and they had their most success against Lehigh Valley going 22-13 (.629). In 2022 the Sox were 14-10 vs. Buffalo and in 2023 they finished 15-8 vs. Buffalo (both their best marks each year).

Tracing History – WooSox manager **Chad Tracy** earned his 300th victory of his Worcester managerial career on August 31 in Durham. Coming into today he has a 308-285 record since taking over as WooSox manager for the 2022 season. He has had winning seasons in each of his first four years at the helm and is the first Red Sox Triple-A manager ever to accomplish that feat. Venerable scribe Bill Ballou confirms that fact dating back to at least the 1930's. "Trace", who turned 40 this past July 4th, became the sixth manager in modern Red Sox organizational history to reach the 300-win plateau with a Red Sox Triple-A affiliate. Joe Morgan is the all-time leader with 601 wins in his nine years as Pawtucket Red Sox manager (1974-82), followed by other PawSox managers - Buddy Bailey with 502 wins in seven years (1993-96, 2002-04), Ron Johnson with 357 victories in five years (2005-09), Kevin Boles with 345 wins in his five years as Pawtucket manager (2014-18), and Ed Nottle with 302 wins (1986-90). Chad had 176 wins in three years as a Minor League manager in the Los Angeles Angels' system from 2015-17 giving him a total of 484 career managerial wins overall heading into play today.

Rewrite the Record Book – The 2025 WooSox have already set, or are on the verge of setting, a handful of new Boston Red Sox Triple-A records (that are at least 55 years old).

Worcester batters currently have tied the Pawtucket Red Sox mark of **9 grand slams** in a season set back in 1999. And WooSox hitters will try to avoid setting a new record for **Most Strikeouts** as they currently have 1379 this season while the Sox Triple-A record is 1391 strikeouts set by the 2022 WooSox.

Worcester pitchers have already established a new Red Sox Triple-A record for **Most Wild Pitches** as they have 86 this season bettering the previous mark of 81 by the PawSox in 1998. Unless today's Worcester starter Shane Drohan throws a complete game, the WooSox staff will finish the year with **0 Complete Games** which would be a first. The 2005, 2011, and 2018 Pawtucket Red Sox and the 2021 Worcester Red Sox all had 1 complete game each season which stands as the current record. WooSox pitchers this season have issued just **3 Intentional Walks** which would be the fewest in a season (the 2021 WooSox hold the record with 5 IBB). And despite currently leading the International League with 95 hit batsman, unless Sox pitchers decide they don't like the Rochester Red Wings today, they will fall short of the team record of 99 hit batsmen in 2021.

Hot Sox

-INF **Kristian Campbell** has hit in 7 of his last 11 games (13-for-42, .310) and is batting at a .303 clip in his last 53 games (61-for-201) with 8 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR, 27 RBI, 15 BB, and 35 runs scored. Had a 15-game hitting streak that began on July 19 and ended on August 7. It was the longest on the WooSox this season and the second longest in WooSox club-history.

-INF **Mikey Romero** in his last 15 games has 7 doubles, 4 homers, 14 RBI, and 11 runs scored. In his last 27 games is batting .255 (28-for-110) but with 12 2B, 6 HR, 20 RBI, and 16 runs.

-1B **Nathan Hickey** has hit in 4 of his last 5 games (8-for-19, .421) with 3 doubles and 3 RBI.

-INF **Tyler McDonough** has hit in 4 of his last 5 games (5-for-19, .263) with 4 runs scored.

-OF **Corey Rosier** has hit in 12 of his last 17 games (18-for-62, .290) with 4 doubles, 4 RBI and 7 runs scored.

-INF/OF **Karson Simas** has hit in 4 straight (6-for-14, .429) with 2 doubles and 3 RBI.

-INF **Abraham Toro** has hit in 10 of his last 14 games (14-for-51, .275) with 1 2B, 3 HR, 9 RBI, and 8 runs scored.

-C **Chadwick Tromp** has hit in 3 of his last 4 games (4-for-14, .286) with 2 doubles & 2 RBI.

-RHP **Alex Hoppe** has given up just one hit and no runs in his last 8 relief appearances – 8.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 4 BB, 10 SO.

-RHP **Wyatt Olds** has not given up an earned run in his last 12.1 innings over 8 relief appearances allowing just 4 hits and 1 run with 17 strikeouts.

It Will Be Scranton/Wilkes-Barre at Jacksonville for the IL Championship – It hurts to say, but congrats to the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (AAA-New York Yankees) who clinched 1st-place in the International League's 2nd-half on Friday night to secure the playoff berth that comes with that. Scranton/WB will face 1st half champ Jacksonville in the International League playoffs that will be a best 2 out of 3 series with all games in Jacksonville, FL from September 23-25. The winner of that series will face the Pacific Coast League champion in the Triple-A National Championship Game in Las Vegas on September 27.

Results This Series - Worcester won the first two games of this 6-game series on Tuesday (6-5) and Wednesday (3-1), the Red Wings evened matters with their 10-1 victory on Thursday and an 8-7, 10-inning win on Friday, but the Sox went back up 3 games to 2 thanks to a 4-3 triumph on Saturday. Worcester is 7-9-10 in their 26 series this season - seven wins, nine losses, ten splits.

Stretch Run - The Sox have won 7 of their last 11 games and 5 of their last 8 home games.

Home Goods – The WooSox will finish with a winning home record for the fourth time in the five years of Polar Park. Worcester is 39-34 at home this season.

Polar Power – The WooSox team batting average at Polar Park this season is .269 (625-for-2327) with 77 HR & 372 runs scored. Worcester pitchers are 39-34 at home with a 4.69 ERA (328 ER in 629 IP) with 88 HRA and 369 runs allowed. The Sox reached a season-high of 8-games over .500 at home four different times this season (June 20 & 22, July 2, and August 8). Worcester won a club-record 8 straight at home from May 25 – June 18.

The End of the Road – The WooSox finished 36-39 on the road this season as they suffered their first losing road record in their first five years. The team batting average on the road was .236, but the WooSox both out-homered (91-75) and out-scored (372-351) their opponents on the road this season. Sox pitchers had a 36-39 record with a 4.56 ERA in away games. Worcester's next away game won't come for about 6½ months when the 2026 WooSox travel to St. Paul, Minnesota to take on the St. Paul Saints next March 31st.

Turning the Beat Around – Worcester is 8-6 in their last 14 games after having lost 6 of their previous 7 games from August 28 – September 4. That skid came on the heels of a 4-game winning streak from August 23-27.

September Mourn – Worcester is 8-9 in September. Pitchers have a 3.95 ERA this month (65 ER in 148 IP) with 15 HRA while batters are hitting .232 (128-for-551) with 14 HR. The Sox have been out-scored by their opponents in September, 79-69.

Final Sunday – The WooSox finished with an outstanding record on Tuesdays going 16-6 on what was the first day of 22 series they played that began on Tuesdays. The Sox went 13-11 on Wednesdays, 12-13 on Thursdays, 13-13 on Fridays, and 9-15 on Saturdays. They are 13-13 on Sundays with the decisive Sunday affair on tap for today.

Wings To Go – Worcester has won 17 games in 23 tries against Rochester this season finishing 8-4 in Rochester and going 9-2 here at Polar Park thus far. The WooSox most recently split a 6-game set in Rochester from July 8-13. The Sox won 5 of 6 vs. the Wings at Innovative Field in Rochester back from April 15-20 and have now won 32 of their last 44 games in Rochester since the latter part of the 2021 season. Worcester swept a 6-game series from the Red Wings here at Polar Park from June 3-8 marking the second-ever WooSox 6-game sweep in their 5-year history with the other coming in Rochester from August 31 – September 5, 2021. And the Sox made it 8 wins in a row over the Wings here in Worcester with their 6-5 and 3-1 victories this Tuesday and Wednesday before the Wings won on Thursday, 10-1 and Friday, 8-7 in 10 innings. Worcester made it 9 wins in 11 tries at Polar Park with a 4-3 victory on Saturday.

Results vs. Rochester – Worcester is batting .291 vs. Rochester this season (their best against any of the 11 opponents they have faced) going 227-for-779 with 671 doubles, 2 triples, 29 HR & 149 runs scored. WooSox pitchers are 17-6 with a 4.30 ERA allowing 95 ER in 199 IP with 28 HRA and 106 runs given up. The Sox 17 victories have come by scores of... 7-2, 8-0, 4-3, 20-7, 7-0 (all those in Rochester); 6-5, 9-1, 9-6, 6-3, 10-4, and 5-4 (all those in Worcester); 11-5, 5-3, and 2-0 in a game called with two outs in the bottom of the 6th-inning (those three wins all back in Rochester); and 6-5, 3-1, and 4-3 here at Polar Park this week/weekend. The Red Wings wins thus far have come on April 19 in Rochester by a 12-3; on July 9th, 4-3; 10th, 14-9, and July 12th, 6-4 (all in Rochester); and 10-1 and 8-7 in 10-innings here in Worcester on September 18 & 19.

Worcester/Pawtucket vs. Rochester – Worcester leads Rochester in the all-time series against each other (since 2021) with 62 victories compared to 46 for the Wings. Rochester is 29-28 all-time at Polar Park while the WooSox are 33-17 in Rochester winning 32 of their last 44 games in the Finger Lakes region. Furthermore, Worcester/Pawtucket is up on Rochester with 386 wins against 369 losses in the remarkably close last 46 years of facing each other since the 1979 season.

It's Happened Often – While they are presently 75-73 on the year and will finish above .500 this season, the Sox had been at .500 on 19 different occasions this year...1-1, 2-2, 3-3, 8-8, 9-9, 14-14, 16-16, 18-18, 20-20, 21-21, 24-24, 25-25, 26-26, 27-27, 28-28, 47-47, 48-48, 67-67, and 69-69.

Highs and Lows – Worcester has been a season-high of 8-games over .500 on three different occasions (last on June 22 at 41-33). Those are their best marks since finishing last year with a 79-71 record. The Sox were a season-low 4-games below .500 (4-8) on April 11.

Double Trouble – On September 7th - for the 10th time this season (and 8th time at home) – the WooSox played a doubleheader which is one short of the club-record 11 doubleheaders the Sox played during the 2023 season. Worcester split the September 7th twin bill vs. 1st-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre at Polar Park and are now 4-2-4 in their first 10 twin bills this year - four sweeps, swept twice, and split four others.

Weather or Not – The rainout on September 6th was Worcester's 11th postponement of the year and their 9th PPD at Polar Park, thus adding on to a new WooSox club record for most home games either postponed or cancelled in a single season. The 9 home postponements are the most in all of Triple-A Baseball. The WooSox' previous high of six home postponements was set in 2021 during Worcester's inaugural season at Polar Park. This season's postponed or cancelled home games have come on Saturday, March 29; Tuesday, April 8; Saturday, April 12 (which was cancelled); Saturday, April 26; Thursday May 22; Tuesday, July 1; Thursday, July 31; Wednesday, August 20; and Saturday, September 6. Worcester has had only two road games postponed (April 16 in Rochester due to snow and July 23 at St. Paul).

Final August Numbers – Worcester finished 15-13 in August to post their second winning month. They have had two winners, two losers, and a .500 month thus far. The WooSox were 14-14 in March/April, 13-14 in May, 15-10 in June, and 10-13 in July. WooSox batters hit .247 in 28 games in August with 33 HR while Worcester pitchers were 15-13 with a 4.22 ERA with 28 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 139-129 last month.

Goodbye to July – Ironically, the WooSox began the month of July with a home rainout on July 1 vs. Syracuse and they ended July yesterday with another home rainout on July 31 vs. Lehigh Valley. Worcester finished 10-13 in July. Sox batters hit .264 with 29 HR while Sox pitchers were 10-13 with a 5.44 ERA and 38 HRA in July. The Sox were out-scored by their opponents, 124-122.

Tough Finish to a Winning June – Worcester posted a winning June with their 15-10 record that began with their 9-game winning streak from June 1-11 and was 14-5 prior to the start of the 2nd half (1-5 to end the month). The WooSox out-scored their opponents, 140-124 in June while batting .240 with solid production including 49 doubles, 7 triples, 34 HR and 140 runs scored. WooSox pitchers were 15-10 with a 4.72 ERA in June with 23 HRA & 124 runs allowed.

Other Month to Month - WooSox hitters batted .246 in May with 29 HR & 114 runs scored while Sox pitchers were 13-14 with a 4.84 ERA during the month with 32 HRA and 132 runs allowed. Worcester hit .273 in April with 25 HR & 145 runs scored and WooSox pitchers were 13-13 in April with a 4.74 ERA along with 26 HRA and 128 runs given up.

Ups and Downs – Worcester's stretch of winning 14 of 18 from June 1-22 was one of their best of the season along with an April 13-24 stretch when they won 10 of 11 games. Their worst stretches have come when they lost 15 of 21 from June 24 – July 20 and from April 25 – May 11 when they lost 11 of 15 games.

Doing One Better – The WooSox are 19-17 in 1-run games on the year and 6-5 in extra innings.

Home Run Derby – Worcester has maximized their use of the long-ball all season as 86 of their total 168 HR on the year have come with runners on base. Worcester batters have belted (82) solo HR, (53) 2-run homers, (24) 3-run blasts & (9) grand slams – leading the league with those 9 grannies.

Streaks Appeal – The WooSox enjoyed a season-high and Worcester club-record 9-game winning streak June 1-11. They fell two wins shy of matching the longest winning streak for a Red Sox Triple-A affiliate in 55+ years...since the Pawtucket Red Sox won 11 straight in 2014. The WooSox have also had two 5-game winning streaks (from April 13-18 and again from April 20-24). Worcester had a season-high 5-game losing streak from April 25-30.

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

WooSox to BoSox - The WooSox sent 28 different players to Boston during the 2024 season (not counting rehab players). A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs finished the second half with a 30-38 record and an overall season mark of 64-71.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today as of this morning and we think that will put a bow on another busy year of player moves between WooSox Nation and Red Sox Nation.

Worcester has made 269 player moves this season, so they will fall short of the Red Sox Triple-A record of 281 player transactions during the 2024 season. This season's moves by month...45 in April, 45 in May, 49 in June, 44 in July, 54 in August, and 32 thus far in September.

The WooSox have used 75 different players this season (44 pitchers and 31 position players). Last year, the WooSox employed a new Red Sox Triple-A record 84 different players during the 2024 season (47 pitchers and 37 position players).

Since the start of the season the WooSox have had 25 players directly promoted to Boston. The lucky list...RHP Hunter Dobbins (three times), RHP Robert Stock (twice), C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, INF Nick Sogard (five times), RHP Luis Guerrero (three times), RHP Cooper Criswell (six times), INF Abraham Toro, RHP Nick Burdi (twice), INF Marcelo Mayer, RHP Zack Kelly (three times), INF/OF Nate Eaton (three times), RHP Brian Van Belle, OF Roman Anthony, RHP Richard Fitts (three times), RHP Isaiah Campbell (twice), INF David Hamilton (twice), LHP Jovani Moran (twice), LHP Brennan Bernardino, OF Jhostynxon Garcia, LHP Payton Tolle, LHP Chris Murphy (three times including a rehab recall), LHP Connelly Early, and LHP Kyle Harrison to Boston. Isaiah Campbell, Toro, Moran, and Garcia, are all back with Worcester.

Furthermore, the Red Sox have also recalled rehabbers RHP Lucas Giolito, C Connor Wong, INF/OF Romy Gonzalez, OF Wilyer Abreu, RHP Jordan Hicks, RHP Tanner Houck, and RHP Justin Slaten from Worcester to Boston this season.

Of note, seven players have earned their first-ever Major League promotions going from Worcester to Boston this season...Hunter Dobbins on April 6, Marcelo Mayer on May 24, Roman Anthony on June 9, Brian Van Belle on June 9 (although he never pitched for Boston – he did make his big league debut with Tampa Bay in August), Jhostynxon Garcia on August 21, Payton Tolle on August 29, and Connelly Early on September 9.
