WELCOME TO THE CROW: Coleman Crow made his 16th start (17th appearance) of the season for the Sounds, recording his seventh quality start and earning a no decision against Louisville (7.0 IP, 9 H, 2 ER, 4 K). Six-of-the-seven quality starts have come in his last eight games since July 19 vs. Norfolk and the right-hander has earned four wins during the stretch. Since rejoining the Sounds on July 4, Crow ranks second in ERA (2.45), fourth in WHIP (1.13), fifth in IP (47.2) and sixth in AVG (.221) among qualified International League pitchers. The no. 23-rated prospect has recorded 23 quality starts in his professional career since 2021. Ten of the 23 quality starts have come within the Brewers' farm system since joining Double-A Biloxi and Nashville last season. He has the third-most quality starts in the system over the last two seasons behind Tyson Hardin and Jaron DeBerry with 12 each. Crow has earned a quality start all 23 times he has gone the minimum 6.0+ IP to qualify and Wednesday night was his fifth career QS of 7.0+ IP or more. He joined Hardin as the only two Sounds' starters to work 7.0 IP in a game this season after Hardin did it on May 17 in his Triple-A debut vs. Iowa.

THERE HE GOES AGAIN: Tyler Black went 1-for-3 with a RBI on Wednesday night to extend his on-base streak to 14 consecutive games. The 14 games is the third longest-active on-base streak on the team, and he is hitting .375 (6-for-16), two doubles, three RBI and two runs since August 14. He is riding a five-game hitting streak, has at least one hit in 11 of his last 14 games played and 18-of-24 overall since the start of August. His .430 OBP ranks seventh in the International League since August 1 and he leads the team in AVG (.309), hits (25), OPS (.899), SLG (.469), and walks (15) during the span. He is tied for the team-lead in doubles along with Brock Wilken (5), ranks second in total bases (38), tied for second in XBH (8), and third in RBI (14) over Nashville's last 27 games.

RUNS MATTER MORE THAN BATS: Despite getting held to five or fewer hits for a second straight game and being doubled up in the hit column, Nashville earned a second straight 3-2 win in the late innings on Wednesday night. The five hits Nashville had on Wednesday was the 34th time the Sounds have recorded five or fewer hits in game this year and the 17th now at home. The 34 games marks as the fifth-most in the International League with Norfolk leading the IL with 48. The team had five or fewer hits games 36 times during the 2025 season, and are now two shy of that mark with 16 games remaining in the regular season.

LOOK AT THE NUMBERS: With Wednesday night's win, the Sounds improved to 56-1 on the year when leading after the eighth inning. The Nashville bullpen has a league-best 3.21 ERA in the ninth inning this year (32 ER/89.2 IP). The mark ranks second in all Triple-A behind Sugar Land with their 2.98 ERA (31 ER / 93.2 IP). The Sounds have a bullpen ERA of 3.63 this season, which ranks second-best among all full-season minor league teams behind only Low-A Kannapolis (CWS) who have a 3.52 ERA in 127 games played.

WALK IT OFF: Tyler Black delivered the sixth walk-off win of the season for Nashville with his two-out, two-RBI double in the bottom of the ninth inning in Tuesday's series opener against Louisville. It was the third career walk-off hit for Black and his first since 2022. Black delivered his first two career walk-offs over an 11-game span with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. His first was a 2-RBI single in the bottom of the seventh inning in game two of a doubleheader against Peoria on April 10 to give the T-Rats a 3-2 win. He then walked off Quad Cities for a 6-5 win with an RBI single in the bottom of the ninth on April 22. **Black went 473 career games between walk-offs.** All six of Nashville's walk-offs this season have come from a different player. The Sounds have seven walk-off wins vs. Louisville since the start of the 2021 season. Tuesday night was the first since June 7, 2024, when Isaac Collins doubled home Freddy Zamora and Joey Wiemer with two outs in the ninth inning for a 6-5 win.

STILL STREAKING: Ethan Murray extended his on-base streak to 16 straight games, drawing a walk on Tuesday night. The 16-game on-base streak is now one shy of tying his career-best, a mark he set in 2021 with Low-A Carolina during his first professional season. Murray's 16-game streak is tied for the 15th-longest active on-base streak in the International League and tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak for a Nashville player this year. Two other Nashville players extended their on-base streaks in Tuesday's game.
