SANOJA SMASH LEADS JACKSONVILLE TO WIN

Javier Sanoia's two-run home run in the sixth inning on Saturday spurred Jacksonville to a 6-4 victory over Nashville. The teams traded runs in the first five frames, with the Jumbo Shrimp scoring in the second only for the Sounds to tie the score in the third. After Jacksonville plated two on Victory Mesa Jr.'s two-run single in the fourth, Nashville tied the score with a pair in the fifth. Sanoja's two-run home run had no answer; Jacksonville added a run in the seventh on Jhonny Pereda's RBI single. A Yonny Hernández RBI base knock in the eighth set the score at 6-4.

BATMEN

Heading into play on June 16, Jacksonville had mustered only 304 runs in 68 games (4.5 per game), which ranked last out of 30 Triple-A teams. The Jumbo Shrimp also placed just 20th in batting average (.254), 25th in OBP (.337), 24th in slugging (.409) and 24th in OPS (.746) in the first 68 games of the season. Jacksonville has registered at least nine hits in nine of their last 12 games, sparking an offensive resurgence from the club. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp rank second in Triple-A in batting average (.309) and hits (130), ninth in OBP (.368), 12th in SLG (.470), 12th in OPS (.838) while scoring 63 runs (5.3 per game).

GET PITCH OR DIF TRYIN'

Jacksonville has won 13 of their last 20 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 15 of those 20 affairs. Since this run began on June 7. Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in runs allowed (67) and ERA (3.07) while ranking second in OPS against (.700), fourth in batting average against (.239) and WHIP (1.34) and sixth in hits allowed (161).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 53 of Jacksonville's 80 games (66.3 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 14 of the club's last 18 contests and nine of the last 11. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 25 of its last 38 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 25-28 (.472) in these affairs.

STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Somewhat incredibly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 18 of the last 19 games, with 15 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and eight being scoreless. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 27 runs, 23 earned, on 67 hits (7.9 H/9) in 76.0 innings for a 2.72 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 71 strikeouts (8.4 K/9) against 35 walks (4.1 BB/9) during this stretch.

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A. Javier Sanoia was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 42 of his last 47 games, notching 20 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 66for-190 (.347/.404/.505/.909) at the plate with 15 doubles. three triples, three home runs, 33 RBIs, 20 walks and 26

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 45 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 50-for-hislast-155, slashing .323/.399/.639/1.038 with 11 doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 33 RBIs, 20 walks and 29 runs scored. Among the 122 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks 12th in HR/FB (25.9 percent). On the season, he ranks tied for sixth in the IL in extra-base hits (32), tied for 12th in home runs (15), 15th in SLG (.539), 16th in OPS (.908), tied for 19th in doubles (16) and 22nd in hits (68).

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp are vying for their first home series win since taking four of six from Norfolk from April 16-21. They are just 1-4-2 in their home sets this season... Over his last 31 games, **Troy Johnston** is hitting .348/.408/.539/.947 with six doubles, two triples, four home runs, 15 RBIs, 11 walks and 25 runs scored... Victor Mesa Jr. has collected at least one hit in 10 of the last 11 contests, slashing .375/.404/.583/.987 during that span.

ABOUT EDWARD

-Cabrera made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 25, 2021 against the Washington Nationals from loanDepot park. He yielded three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings.

-Once ranked as the No. 2 prospect in the Marlins' organization by MLB.com, Cabrera signed with Miami for \$100,000 on July 2, 2015 as an international free agent. He was also a consensus Top-100 prospect in 2022, ranked 33rd by Keith Law of *The Athletic*, 34th by *MLB Pipeline* and No. 69 by both *Baseball Prospectus* and *Baseball America*.

-The Marlins were fairly aggressive with Cabrera in the minor leagues, starting his professional career in the Gulf Coast League. After just 82.2 innings in 24 games, including 13 starts, with the GCL Marlins and Short Season Class A Batavia, Cabrera found himself in full season ball with Low-A Greensboro in 2018 at the age of 19.

2024 SEASON

-Currently on his second rehab assignment with Jacksonville this season.

2023 SEASON

-Posted a $2.91\,\mathrm{ERA}$ in seven home MLB starts, going 5-0 while going 0-6 in 10 road starts with a $6.28\,\mathrm{ERA}$.

-Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 7-13 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings of one-hit ball with 10 strikeouts on August 12 against Norfolk.

2022 SEASON

-In 14 starts with Miami, posted a $1.49\ \mathrm{ERA}$ in seven road starts versus a $4.58\ \mathrm{ERA}$ in seven starts at home.

2021 SEASON

-Cabrera made two rehab starts with Low-A Jupiter on June 6 and June 12, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts and no walks. His rehab assignment ended on June 15, when he was assigned to Double-A Pensacola. After five starts with the Blue Wahoos, he was promoted to Jacksonville on July 15.

2020 SEASON

-Cabrera was a member of the Marlins' Alternate Training Site.

2019 SEASON

-Cabrera was assigned to Jacksonville on June 23 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the right-hander ranked second in the Florida State League out of 60 pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched in FIP (2.28), third in strikeout percentage (32.2 percent), fourth in K-BB% (24.3 percent), fifth in xFIP (2.64) and ninth in ERA (2.02). He also tallied the circuit's sixth-highest swinging strike percentage (14.5 percent).

-The Santiago, Dominican Republic native surrendered four runs to the first five batters he faced on the season on April 5 at Palm Beach. However, he did not cede another tally until the sixth inning of his start on May 23, a span of 28 consecutive scoreless innings.
