TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A, Houston Astros) look to even the series against the Salem Red Sox (Single-A, Boston Red Sox) as the two squads play game four of a six-game series. Fayetteville took the series opener on Tuesday night with a 5-4 victory before the Red Sox grabbed games two and three on Wednesday and Thursday. This is the fourth of 15 total matchups between the clubs in the season series. In today's contest, Fayetteville turns to RHP Rafael Gonzalez while Salem calls upon RHP Austin Ehrlicher. It is Star Wars night tonight and the Woodpeckers will dawn specialty Star Wars themed jerseys on the diamond.

ABOUT THE SALEM SOX: The Salem Red Sox, established in 1955, have been members of the Carolina league since 1968. They were previously members of the Appalachian League from 1957-1967 and were known as the Salem Rebels. The franchise has been affiliated with the Boston Red Sox since the 2009 season and has won five division titles and one Carolina League championship (2013) over that span. The Red Sox play at Carilion Clinic Field, a 6,300 seat facility constructed in 1995. Previous MLB affiliates include the Colorado Rockies (1995-2002) and the Houston Astros (2003-2008). Last season, Salem took the season head-to-head series with an 8-4 record, going 4-2 at Segra Stadium.

(SOMEWHAT) FAMILIAR FOES: This past offseason, the Carolina League experienced significant changes that saw the league re-shuffle ahead of the start of the 2025 season. In May of 2024, the Down East Wood Ducks would re-locate to Spartanburg, S.C. and re-brand as the Hub City Spartanburgers, and shortly thereafter, in July, the Texas Rangers decided to swap them with the Hickory Crawdads, sending them to the High-A South Atlantic League while the Crawdads took their place in the Carolina League. Upon their entry to the league, the Crawdads were placed in the South Division, and the Woodpeckers took Down East's spot in the North Division, grouping them with the Shorebirds, Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A Cleveland Guardians), Carolina Mud-cats (Single-A Milwaukee Brewers), Fredericksburg Nationals (Single-A, Washington Nationals), and Salem Red Sox (Single-A, Boston Red Sox).

AWARD TOUR: During the last series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, a pair of Woodpeckers received Houston Astros Minor League monthly awards. Jancel Villarroel was named the organization's Lower Level Player of the Month while Bryce Mayer earned Lower Level Pitcher of the Month honors for the month of April. In the first month of the season, Villarroel slashed .296/.385/.469 with one home run, 11 RBI, seven doubles, two triples, 12 runs, 11 walks, and 10 stolen bases without being caught. As for Mayer, he sported a 2.51 ERA, striking out 27 batters to just two walks, scattering four runs over 10 hits across 14 innings ahead of his promotion to High-A.

POWELL NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers, in conjunction with Minor League Baseball, announced on Monday that infielder Caden Powell has been named the Carolina League Player of the Week for the week ending on May 4th, 2025. This is the first time during the 2025 season that a Woodpeckers' position player has earned a weekly league award. Powell had a huge showing at the plate across a six-game home series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, going 8-for-24 (.467 OBP) with four HR, seven RBI, seven runs scored, six walks and two stolen bases. Over the span of the six games, he tallied two multi-hit games, three multi-RBI games and became the first player this season to homer twice in a contest.

WOODPECKERS TAKE FLIGHT The Woodpeckers announced two promotions on Monday, sending RHP Bryce Mayer and OF Lucas Spence to High-A Asheville. Mayer was Fayetteville's most consistent arm during April, fanning 30 hitters over 17.2 innings while walking just six. Offensively, Spence hit .286 and ranked top ten in the Carolina League with a .450 OBP, reaching base safely in 20 straight games leading up to his promotion. In corresponding moves, Fayetteville returned relievers Dawil Almonte and Garrett Aker to the bullpen and also added outfielder Cam Fisher, a member of the 2023 squad and the former 4th round pick out of UNC Charlotte.

TO A GALAXY FAR-FAR AWAY: The Woodpeckers lineup has been slugging homers to a galaxy far-far away, mashing four on Thursday night in the 11-9 extra-inning loss to Salem. Caden Powell is tied for the league lead with Salem's Freili Encarnacion with six long balls. Meanwhile, the Fayetteville offense as a whole now leads the league with 22 home runs, ranks third in OPS (.718), and is tied four fourth in slugging percentage at .365. This series as a whole has been a derby, with ten combined homers between the two teams over the first three contests.

THIS DAY IN WOODPECKERS HISTORY: May 9, 2019 - Six years ago, the Fayetteville Woodpeckers defeat the Carolina Mudcats 4-2 at Five County Stadium in Zebulon. Miguelangel Sierra hits his fourth home run of the season in the third inning. Bryan de la Cruz, Jake Beyers, Seth Beer and Jake Adams all have two hit games, plus Enoli Paredes pitches 5.0 innings of one-run ball while striking out nine.
