- Trailing by three late, the Blue Jays rallied for two seventh inning runs, but Dunedin's losing streak reached six games with a 5-2 defeat to Jupiter.
- Starter Grant Rogers was strong for Dunedin, opening the game with four shutout innings and six strikeouts.
- Jupiter ended the scoreless game in the fifth. Sam Praytor opened the scoring with a one-out RBI double. After a Renny Hidalgo walk, Rogers bounced back to strike out McCants in an 11-pitch battle to end his outing. Kai Peterson entered the game, inheriting two runners. Both scored one on a bases-loaded walk and the other on a wild pitch, which made it 3-0.
- After six shutout innings from starter Brandon White, Dunedin cracked the Hammerheads bullpen in the seventh. The Jays drew three straight walks to open the frame. The next two batters, Tucker Toman and Bryce Arnold, both drove in runs on fielders' choices to trim the lead to 3-2.
- Jupiter got both runs back in the bottom of the seventh on a JT Mabry two-RBI double, pushing the deficit back to three, at 5-2.

SLLLLLIDING

After ripping off six consecutive victories from April 6 through April 12, the Blue Jays have dropped six straight, dating back to Friday vs Clearwater. These streaks mark the first instance of Dunedin having a win streak and losing streak longer than five games in the same month since July 2019, when a 10-game win streak was immediately followed by a five game losing streak. Dunedin had two losing streaks of six games or longer last season, including a nine-game slide from July 5 through July 18.

OFFENSIVE OUTAGE

Dunedin's offense has sputtered across its six game losing streak, scoring just 14 runs while batting .197 with an OBP of .286. In the six games prior to the losing streak, the Jays tallied 45 runs.

DURAN DURAN

Edward Duran extended his team-leading hit streak to eight games last night with his eighth inning single. The backstop is hitting .345 with a .855 OPS across the stretch. Duran was acquired by the Blue Jays from the Marlins in the trade that sent Zach Pop and Anthony Bass to Toronto in 2022.

THIEVERY

This week's series pits the Florida State League's two best base-stealing teams against each other. Dunedin's 44 stolen bases on 54 attempts (81%) ranks second in the circuit to Jupiter's 54. After Dunedin surrendered a season-high six stolen bases Wednesday, the Hammerheads went without a steal last night.

FREE PASSES GIVETH, FREE PASSES TAKETH AWAY

While Dunedin has racked up 93 walks at the plate (5.1 per game), ranking third in the Florida State League, the team has struggled with command on the mound, issuing a league-leading 102 walks (5.6 per game).

REHAB CITY, USA

With Saturday night's start on the mound, Lazaro Estrada became the sixth player to make a rehab appearance with Dunedin this season. MLB rehabbers Alek Manoah and Erik Swanson both pitched on April 7 against Lakeland.

YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

ALMOST PERFECT 10

Dunedin's 8-2 start to the season marked the best start by a Blue Jays' squad since 2014, then the team also opened the season 8-2 through its first 10 games. The 2024 D-Jays pushed their record to 13-2 before picking up a third loss.

COMING UP THE PIPELINE

The D-Jays Opening Day roster is loaded with eight of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. The 30-man roster includes the Jays' last two first round draft picks; LHP Brandon Barriera (2022) and Infielder Arjun Nimmala (2023). Nimmala is ranked as the third-best prospect in the system, while Barriera is ranked fourth. Opening Day starter Fernando Perez is Pipeline's No. 24 Blue Jays prospect, after leading the FCL Blue Jays in innings pitched in 2023.

- With the 2020 renovation, the stadium's capacity increased from 5,500 to 8,500.
