## NEWS AND NOTES

**NASHVILLE TWO STEP:** The Sounds and Tides will play two at First Horizon Park on Thursday night after the rain out on Tuesday. The Sounds went 5-1 in their three doubleheaders played at First Horizon Park during the 2025 season. Since joining the International League, Nashville is 12-4 (4-0-4) in doubleheaders at First Horizon Park.

**BUMP IT, SPIN IT, PITCH IT:** Robert Gasser will make his First Horizon Park debut this season and his fourth overall start of the year when he takes the ball in game one of Thursday's twin bill. Gasser faced the Tides on Opening Night in Norfolk and struck out 11 over 5.2 scoreless innings and two hits allowed. The Brewers' no. 16-rated prospect has allowed five earned on 12 hits over his 11.0 IP this season. **Brewers no. 26-rated prospect Coleman Crow will get the start in game two.** He also faced the Tides opening weekend and allowed two earned on six hits over 4.2 IP with six strikeouts and a couple of walks.

**WINNER, WINNER, WALK-OFF DINGER:** Jett Williams' walk-off homer was the first walk-off win of the season for Nashville and the first since Eric Haase hit a walk-off home run on September 11, 2025, to beat the Gwinnett Stripers. Williams now has home runs in two of his last three games played after leaving the yard in game two

against Charlotte Saturday night. It was just his third career home run in the ninth inning or later and was Nashville's 15th all-time walk-off home run at First Horizon Park.

**SWINGING A HOT PRATT:** Cooper Pratt continues to heat up offensively for Nashville. The Brewers no. 4-rated prospect added his fifth multi-hit game of the season and third in his last four games after finishing Wednesday night 2-for-3 with a double, walk, two stolen bases and a run scored. Pratt is hitting .471 (8-for-17) over his last five games played with a home run, triple, double, four RBI, five walks, and five runs scored. Pratt was hitting a season-low .156 after starting the Charlotte series 0-for-14 through the first three games played last week but has quickly turned things around with his play of late.

**TWO QUERO:** Jeferson Quero collected his third straight multi-hit game on Wednesday vs. Norfolk. His seven multi-hit games on the season rank third on the team behind Luis Lara (10) and Eddys Leonard (8). It's the sixth time in his professional career with 3+ consecutive multi-hit games. He set a career-best with four straight multi-hit performances from September 3-7, 2022 with High-A Wisconsin. Quero finished Wednesday 2-for-5 with two doubles and a pair of RBI and has added four of his six doubles on

the year in his last three games played after also hitting two doubles in game one of Nashville's doubleheader in Charlotte on Saturday night.

**QUADRUPLE DOUBLE:** The Sounds hit four doubles off Norfolk on Wednesday to tie their single-game high in 2026. Jeferson Quero (6), Cooper Pratt (2) and Brock Wilken (6) combined for the four Sounds two baggers. Wilken and Quero tied Eddys Leonard for the team lead in doubles this season. All four of Nashville's games with 3+ doubles have come in the last 13 games of the season dating back to March 15 vs. Worcester.

**POWER HOUR:** Luis Lara hit just two home runs in 136 games played with Double-A Biloxi during the 2025 season. The Brewers no. 11-rated prospect matched that total through his first five games of this season with Nashville. He entered Sunday's finale against Charlotte sitting on four home runs through his first 25 Triple-A games to match his previous single-season career-high that he set with High-A Wisconsin during the 2024 season in 110 games. His solo home run in Sunday's finale not only helped set a new single-season career-high, but it was also the first time in his professional career with a home run in back-to-back games.
