TODAY'S GAME: Tonight is the opening game of the longest road trip of the year for the Quakes, as they take on the Stockton Ports (ATH) in game one of a six-game set and the first game of a 12-game, 13-day road trip. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 3rd to face the San Jose Giants. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the 13th of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the seventh of 12 at Banner Island Ballpark. The Quakes dropped four of six in Stockton on their first road trip of 2025, but after winning five of six at home, are now 7-5 against Stockton in 2025. In 2024, Rancho went 8-2 against the Ports, 5-1 in Stockton.

LAST GAME: The Quakes earned their league-leading fifth shutout of the year, shutting out Inland Empire in the final game of the six-game series with an 8-0 win at LoanMart Field on Sunday afternoon. Christian Zazueta (4-1) went a season-high six innings and matched a season-best with eight strikeouts, helping the Quakes take five of six in the series. Jaron Elkins had two extra-base hits and scored three runs, while Mairo Martinus and Roger Lasso each chipped in with two hits for the Rancho offense, which collected 11 hits on the day. Inland Empire starter Andre Sanchez (0-4) gave up four runs over two innings in the loss.

POW TREND KEEPS GOING: The Quakes have snapped up five of the 12 weekly awards that have been handed out this year, with Samuel Munoz keeping the trend going, as he was named the league's Player of the Week on Monday. Munoz hit .417 (10-for-24) against Inland Empire with two homers, five RBIs, 11 runs scored and five walks. Other winners this year include P Sean Paul Linan, P Sterling Patick, OF Mike Sirota and OF Eduard Quintero.

ALL GOOD THINGS...: Saturday night's loss snapped Rancho's six-game win streak overall and a separate six-game win streak at home. The Quakes still have the best record in the Cal League at 28-11, a home record of 17-4 and have won 19 of their last 23 games overall as they enter this 12-game road trip. Rancho's best record in a single half was in the second half of the 2018 season, when they went 52-18 and finished a whopping 15 games ahead of second-place Lancaster. That 2018 season also marked their last Cal League Championship, their third in franchise history.

OFFENSIVE OUTBURST: The offense slowed down on Saturday with just three runs on six hits, but scored eight on Sunday and put up some remarkable numbers over the course of the six-game series. They set a franchise record with 25 runs in Tuesday's series-opener and scored a total of 66 runs on 76 hits over 50 offensive innings last week. Rancho's offense is currently first in the league with a team average of .275 and a league-best 33 home runs in 39 games.

STERLING PATICK: 19-year-old Sterling Patick makes his third start and seventh appearance and third against the Ports. Patick was scratched from his last scheduled start on May 14th just minutes before game time. In his last game, he dominated the Visalia Rawhide over four innings, allowing just two hits while fanning five. In his first outing against Stockton, he allowed seven runs on six hits with three walks over just one inning in a loss on April 9th, his season-debut. Patick was named Cal League Pitcher of the Week for the week for five perfect innings against Stockton on May 2nd. Patick was a 2023 18th-round selection for the Dodgers out of South Hills High School in West Covina.

DONNY TROCONIS: 19-year-old righty Donny Troconis makes his eighth appearance and sixth start overall, his third appearance and second start against the Quakes. In two games against Rancho, he's 1-0 while allowing no runs on three hits over nine innings. In his last appearance overall, he allowed three hits over five scoreless innings in a no-decision vs San Jose on May 14th. Troconis has only been scored upon in one outing this year, in a May 8th game where he gave up four runs at Inland Empire. Troconis signed with the Athletics in January of 2023 out of Venezuela.
