YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Bowie Baysox, 9-4. Richmond opened a 3-0 lead in the second inning with a two-run homer by **Frankie Tostado** and a solo homer by **Vince Fernandez**. Bowie answered in the bottom of the inning with a two-run homer by Doran Turchin and an RBI double by **Adley Rutschman**. In the bottom of the third, the Baysox jumped in front, 4-3, with a solo homer by Robert Neustrom. Bowie added two runs in the fourth, a solo homer by Johnny Rizer in the fifth, an RBI single by Kyle Stowers in the sixth and scored a run on a wild pitch in the eighth to stretch the lead to 9-3. Fernandez brought in a fourth Richmond run in the top of the ninth with an RBI groundout.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in their first trip to Prince George's Stadium this year. Bowie won four-of-six games at The Diamond from May 18-23. The Baysox return to Richmond for a six-game series from July 27-August 1. The two teams meet for a second series in Bowie from August 10-15.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS had a three-game win streak snapped with Tuesday's loss. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 4.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .235 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked tied for fifth in the league with a 3.98 ERA for the season.

THE BAYSOX have lost four of the last six games since June 30 and 11 of the last 16 games since June 18. The Baysox are ranked seventh in the league with a .246 team batting average. The Bowie pitching staff is ranked seventh in the league with a 4.25 ERA. The Bowie roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects including C **Adley Rutschman** (No. 1/No. 2 overall), RHP **Grayson Rodriguez** (No. 2/No. 19 overall), LHP **D.L. Hall** (No. 4/No. 53 overall), RHP **Mike Baumann** (7), INF **Terrin Vavra** (10), OF **Kyle Stowers** (22) and INF **Joseph Ortiz** (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Luis Amaya** makes the first start of his professional career. He last pitched on Sunday against Binghamton and allowed two runs while working the eighth inning in a 12-5 Flying Squirrels win. After posting a 15.43 ERA (4 ER/2.1 IP) in his first two outings of the season for the Flying Squirrels, Amaya went 1-0 without allowing an earned run over 10.2 innings from May 12-June 13. Over his last four appearances since June 17, Amaya has posted a 10.80 ERA (8 ER/6.2 IP). Amaya was signed by the Giants as an international free agent on December 14, 2014 out of Venezuela.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander **Kyle Brnovich** makes his second Double-A start and third overall appearance in the league. Last time out, he worked 3.0 relief innings in a no-decision at Akron on Thursday and allowed four runs (three earned). Brnovich began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 4-1 with a 2.36 ERA in eight starts. On June 6, he worked a season-high 6.0 innings and struck out 13 batters, tied for the second-most for a pitcher at the High-A level this year. He was promoted to Double-A Bowie on June 22 and made his Double-A debut in a start against New Hampshire on June 24, allowing one run over 4.0 innings. Brnovich was drafted by the Los Angeles Angels in the eighth round in 2019 out of Elon University, but did not pitch a game for the Angels system. He was traded to the Baltimore Orioles on December 9, 2019 along with three other right-handed pitchers in exchange for right-handed pitcher **Dylan Bundy**.

TOASTY: Over his last 24 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .340 (32-for-94) with six homers, seven doubles and 28 RBIs. In the last road series, he hit go-ahead, two-run homers in the ninth inning in back-to-back games on June 25 and 26 at Hartford. Last week, he hit a three-run homer in the second game of Friday's double-header against Binghamton and added a bases-clearing, three-run double on Sunday night in the series finale. On Tuesday, he hit a two-run homer in the series opener at Bowie. During his current ten-game hitting streak since June 25, Tostado is batting .425 (17-for-40) with five homers, four doubles, a triple and 16 RBIs. He has at least one extra-base hits in eight of his last 10 games.

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, **David Villar** has hit .339 (22-for-65) with five homers and 11 RBIs over his last 18 games since June 16. In the last road series against Hartford, Villar hit three homers. For the season, Villar leads the Flying Squirrels with 10 home runs.

SIMON SAYS: **Simon Whiteman** started his Double-A career 0-for-17 in his first four games from June 15-18 after being promoted from High-A Richmond. In his last 15 games since June 19, Whiteman is batting .322 (19-for-59) with five doubles and one homer. He hit his first Double-A homer in the second game of last Friday's double-header against Binghamton. On Saturday, he picked up a game-winning, RBI double in the seventh inning. He has picked up an RBI in four of the last five games. Since joining the Flying Squirrels, Whiteman has picked up six stolen bases, which is tied for the team lead this season.

SAY HEY! Since the calendar turned to July, **Jacob Heyward** is batting .333 (5-for-15) with two homers and four RBIs. He has homered in two of his last three games. The stretch comes after hitting .077 (1-for-13) over his last seven games in June. The 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game MVP is in his second overall season with Richmond.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with nine hits, six walks and six RBIs by pitchers at the plate. On the year, Richmond has gone 26-14 (.650) against National League affiliates, but have gone 3-10 (.231) against affiliates of American League clubs. After back-to-back series against National League affiliates Hartford and Binghamton, the Flying Squirrels now face American League clubs for the remaining four sets in July and will use the designated hitter.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked seventh in the Double-A Northeast with 38 RBIs and ranked tied for seventh with 55 hits. **Shane Matheny** is ranked fourth with 28 walks. **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for fourth in the circuit with five saves.

MOVING UP: Reliever **Norwith Gudino** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday. He departs Richmond ranked tied for fourth in the league with five saves on the year. He made 17 relief appearances for the Flying Squirrels prior to his promotion, going 1-1 with a 1.44 ERA and 39 strikeouts over 25.0 innings of work. Gudino is ranked seventh in the league among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings of work with a 1.44 ERA and seventh with a 39.8 strikeout percentage.

NEW FACES: Infielder **Will Wilson** and outfielder **Diego Rincones** were added to the Richmond roster on Tuesday from High-A Eugene. With the Emeralds, Wilson was ranked tied for second in the High-A West with 10 home runs, fifth with a .497 SLG, ninth with a .837 OPS, tied for eighth with 49 hits, seventh with 14 doubles, tied for third with 26 extra-base hits, fourth with 97 total bases and tied for sixth with 37 runs scored. Rincones has been limited to 25 games played this year after spending time away to play for Venezuela in the Olympic qualifiers, including hitting a walk-off homer to beat Colombia on June 1.

SOMETHING TO PLAY FOR: On Thursday, Minor League Baseball announced that there will be a postseason in the 2021 season. The season was originally announced with no playoffs. Under this year's playoff format, the top two teams by winning percentage from the Double-A Northeast will qualify for the postseason, regardless of division. The Double-A Northeast Championship Series will be a best-of-five series from Sept. 21-Sept. 26.

BACK TO THE FUTURES GAME: Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** has been selected to participate in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field in Denver on Sunday during the MLB All-Star Week festivities. It is the third time Ramos has been selected to play in the Futures Game. In 2018, Ramos played in the Futures Game at Nationals Park in Washington, D.C., and went 1-for-1 with a pinch-hit single. In 2019, Ramos played in the Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland and entered the game to replace Taylor Trammell, hitting a single to center field in his lone plate appearance. Along with Ramos, shortstop **Marco Luciano** will represent the Giants on the National League team. The 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game will air live on MLB Network and will be streamed on MLB.com on Sunday, July 11 at 3 p.m.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13), **Sean Hjelle** (14) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Five players, including Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
