**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Quakes continue a six-game road trip tonight, as they take on the Visalia Rawhide (Arizona Diamondbacks) in game three of a six-game series at Valley Strong Ballpark. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, August 20, hosting the Lake Elsinore Storm in a six-game series.

**VS THE RAWHIDE:** Today's game is the 21st of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the 12th of 15 at Valley Strong Ballpark. The Quakes are 10-10 against the Rawhide in 2024, 6-5 here in Visalia. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 10-8 at Valley Strong Ballpark.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes committed a season-worst five errors and took an ugly loss, dropping a 9-3 decision to the Visalia Rawhide on Wednesday night at Valley Strong Ballpark. Rawhide starter Wilkin Paredes (4-5) allowed just one run on six hits over six innings. The Rawhide scored three times in the second inning to take the lead for good, as Rancho reliever Pedro Santillan (1-2) allowed three runs while recording just two outs, taking the loss. Carlos Rojas and Kendall George each had two hits to lead the Rancho offense, which put up nine hits on the night.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Quakes made a total of four moves in the last two days, placing RHP David Tiburcio on the Injured List and RHP Samuel Sanchez on the Development List on Wednesday. Taking their respective spots on the roster are RHP Seamus Barrett and RHP Dilan Figueredo. Barrett, drafted in the tenth round of the 2024 draft out of Loyola-Marymount University, has yet to appear in a pro game. Figueredo, who signed with the Dodgers in 2021 out of Venezuela, went 1-0 with a 1.84 ERA over 13 games and 14.2 innings of relief in the ACL this year.

**CLEAN SWEEP FOR WEEKLY AWARDS:** The Quakes had a great week at home, taking four of six, but they got a couple stand-out efforts and for the first time this year, swept the Player of the Week Awards. RHP Roque Gutierrez was named Cal League Pitcher of the Week, after he allowed one run on three hits over seven innings, striking out a career-high 13 Fresno hitters in a win over the Grizzlies. OF Jose Meza was named the Cal League Hitter of the Week, as he slugged four homers and drove in 11 runs in five games, batting a team-high .412 (7-for-17) in the Fresno series.

**ANOTHER SERIES WIN:** The Quakes are in the midst of their best stretch of the second half, having won eight of their last 11 and 14 of their last 20 games. Saturday's win over Fresno gave them their third straight series win (at Inland Empire, vs San Jose, vs Fresno) and they currently own the best second-half record in the league, now two games up in the South over the Visalia Rawhide and the Lake Elsinore Storm. In order to make the playoffs, Rancho must finish the second half ahead of both Visalia and Inland Empire (six games back).

**HYUN-SEOK JANG:** Right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang will make just his second appearance with the Quakes tonight, after joining the team from the recently-completed Arizona Complex League. In his debut against Fresno on August 8, he worked a 1-2-3 first, before allowing three runs on two hits with two walks while recording just four outs in a loss to the Grizzlies. Jang went 1-2 with an 8.14 ERA over 13 games (10 starts) and 24.1 innings pitched in the ACL. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 15th best prospect.

**ADONYS PEREZ:** Lefty Adonys Perez will make his 19th appearance and 18th start of the year, his fourth start against the Quakes. In three games against the Quakes, he's 1-0 with a 4.80 ERA, allowing eight runs on 11 hits over 15 innings. In his last outing, he allowed one unearned run on seven hits over six innings in a win at Modesto on August 8. The Diamondbacks signed Perez in 2022 out of the Dominican Republic.
