A Look at the Leaderboards

As the regular season wins down, a hanmdful of R-Phils are in the running for leading in the league in various statistical categories. Carlos De La Cruz's 24 home runs are two behind the leader. Oliver Dunn's 78 RBI trail Bowie's Billy Cook by three. Dunn also leads the league in OBP, is second in SLG and first in OPS. Carlos De La Cruz is running away with the Eastern League hit crown at 131, with second place Nick Yorke having 116. Dunn leads the league in walks at 81 and XBH at 51. De La Cruz is first in total bases at 230 and Dunn second at 208. De La Cruz is also second in the league in runs scored at 79.

This Day in Baseballtown History

September 12, 2015: At Reading, the Fightin Phils complete a 3-game sweep of Binghamton in the ELDS with a 4-2 win on a night in which it seemed almost impossible the game would be played due to heavy rains most of the day. After a 27 minute delay to start, the Fightin Phils jump out to a 1-0 lead in the 1st on J.P. Crawford's homer, then add 3 more in the 2nd on a sac fly by Angelo Mora and a 2-run HR by Nick Williams. Ben Lively (5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, BB, 6 K) picks up the win and Stephen Shackleford gets his 1st postseason save with a scoreless 9th.

Playoff Bound Ponies

Binghamton enters tonight with a 35-25 record in the second half and 70-59 overall this season. The Rumble Ponies clinched the second-half title on Sunday and will match up with Somerset next week in the playoffs. Last week, Binghamton went 4-2 on the road at Hartford. The Ponies have the following Mets prospects ranked within their top 30: Luisangel Acuna (1), Drew Gilbert (2), Jett Williams (3), Kevin Parada (5), Blake Tidwell (10), Christian Scott (12), Dom Hamel (16), Tyler Stuart (17), Jeremiah Jackson (22), Matt Rudick (27) and Coleman Crow (29).

Blake Tidwell makes his sixth start for Binghamton tonight. He is 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA over six starts (29 IP, 27 H, 15 BB, 31 SO). Tidwell last pitched last Tuesday at Hartford and suffered the loss. He went 3.1 innings, five hits, five runs, three homers allowed, four walks and five strikeouts. Tidwell began the season with High-A Brooklyn and went 8-3 with a 3.09 ERA over 17 starts and was called up to Binghamton on July 31. Tidwell split 2022 between the FCL Mets and Single-A St. Lucie and went 0-1 with a 1.93 ERA over five starts. The Mets drafted Tidwell in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Tennessee.
