Leading Off

Today, Reading and Hartford play the final game of this home-opening, six-game homestand. Hartford took the first two contests, then Reading responded with a win Thursday, but Hartford won Friday and Saturday to take a 4-1 series lead. Reading is looking to get its second win of the season and salvage two of the six games this week.

Looking Back

The R-Phils fell to Hartford 5-1 last night in a game that Reading's offense struggled to get going. Reading outhit Hartford again 8-6, but all eight were singles. For Hartford, the Yard Goats collected four extra base hits, incluing a triple and home run from Grant Lavigne.

Wacky Numbers

When looking at Reading's early-season results, there are a lot of numbers that stand out. The R-Phils lead the entire Eastern League in hitting at .262 (24 points ahead of number two), but ranks 10th in runs scored with 30, which is good for 3.8 per game. The R-Phils early-season achilles heal has been its pitching. Reading ranks in the bottom-half of the league in all major pitching categories through eight games.

Early Game Success

One part of the game the R-Phils have found success in has been the first inning. In the first inning of games, Reading is outscoring opponents by seven runs., But, over the rest of the game, opponents are out scoring the R-Phils **by** 17 runs. The third inning has been a struggle spot for Reading, as opponents are outsocring the R-Phils by five runs in the frame.

Around the Organization

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies, got blown out 13-0 on the road against the Reds last night. Bryson Stott and Alec Bohm each garnered hits to stay hot to open the season. Stott now has hits in 15-straight games. Elsewhere, Lehigh Valley fell to Durham 8-6 on the road last night. High-A Jersey Shore fell at home 7-3 to Greensboro last night. Finally, Clearwater earned the organizations only win, a 3-1 victory over Fort Myers.

Looking Ahead

Following the next today against Hartford, Reading will embark north to take on the Portland Sea Dogs up in Maine. Portland is rolling early in the season with a 7-1 record and have won four of five so far on the road at New Hampshire this week. Corey Rosier and Tyler Dearden pace Portland at the plate, both hitting .438.

This Day in Baseballtown History

Suarez allows 6 hits and strikes out 10 over 8.0 innings and does not issue a walk. The Goats

Hartford enters today's matchup 5-3 on the season after last night's victory. The Yard Goats dropped two of three games at home to the Bowie Baysox last weekend. After the series finale today, Hartford will return home to open a six-game home series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies on Tuesday.

Local Goat

Local pitcher Chris McMahon will get the start today for Hartford. McMahon played locally at West Chester Rustin High School. After being originally drafted by Atlanta in 2017, he pitched three seasons at Miami before being selected by Colorado in 2020. Tuesday, he threw three innings, alllowing six hits and four runs. He spent all of last year with high-A Spokane. He missed most of 2022 with injury but was 10-3 in 2021.
