LAST TIME OUT: Rocket City closed out the regular season with a loss to Birmingham 9-2 Sunday afternoon to cap their home record at 49-20 and 81-57 for the regular season. The Barons got three RBI from Moises Castillo, including a sac fly, RBI single and RBI double while going 3-4 with a run scored, while Bryan Ramos belted a three-run homer and singled as well. The Trash Pandas got an RBI fielder's choice from Kyren Paris and sac fly from Zach Humphreys for their runs. Center fielder Jordyn Adams went 2-4 with a double and run while Sonny DiChiara and Preston Palmeiro each collected two singles. Starter Coleman Crow took the loss, his first since the end of April, after firing six innings of three-run ball on six hits with five strikeouts.

TAKING IT 'SERIES'OUSLY: Rocket City's performance this season has been remarkable due to the consistency of the team's performance from Opening Day until the end of the regular season. The Trash Pandas lost only four series on the year. They were swept in May and July against Pensacola and Mississippi, lost four of six in a meaningless series at Birmingham in June after the first-half title was already clinched, then lost four of six to division-winning Montgomery in September. All four series were on the road. The Trash Pandas only swept one series; the season-opening three-game set at Birmingham. They either split or won their other 20 series for the season, including all 12 at Toyota Field.

BEST FROM THE REST: With Pensacola's loss to Tennessee on 9/10, the Trash Pandas clinched the best record in the Southern League for 2022. They will face off against Tennessee in one of the Southern League's Semifinal Series with game one scheduled for 9/20 in Kodak, Games two and, if necessary, three would be played on 9/22 and 9/23 in Rocket City. They have won both North Division regular season titles for 2022.

BULLISH PEN: A huge key to Rocket City's success has been the work of its bullpen. Specifically, the trio of Kolton Ingram, Eric Torres, and Luke Murphy have all been impressive. Ingram posted a 2.02 ERA with eight saves and 53 Ks in his last 44.2 innings of work with only 11 walks and 10 runs allowed. Torres, meanwhile, registered 18 saves and a 2-1 record in his last 38 innings with 13 hits and six ER allowed for a 1.42 ERA to go along with 56 punchouts. Murphy tied for second on the team with seven wins. In fact, in 33 appearances this season he did not allow a run in 27 of them, including no runs at Toyota Field. Over his last 24 appearances, he went 3-0 with a 1.42 ERA over 25.1 innings and 28 strikeouts with four ER. Ingram led the Southern League with 13 holds while Murphy was close behind, ending the season with 12 holds to rank second in the league.

SAVING THE GAME: The work of back-end relievers Kolton Ingram and Eric Torres have provided the Trash Pandas with a nice two-headed monster at the end of games. Torres' 22 saves are tops in the Southern League with Ingram owning 10 more and tied for fifth. Rocket City, as a team leads the league in saves with 46. Torres' 22 saves set a new Angels' Double-A single-season record, passing the 21 saves by Jose Musset in 1993. Luke Murphy recorded his first Double-A save in the second-half clincher on 9/15, becoming the 10th different Rocket City pitcher to record a save this season, after Torres (21), Ingram (10), Luis Ledo (4), Aaron Hernandez (3), Cristopher Molina (2), Nick Jones (1), Brett Kerry (1), Braden Olthoff (1), and Ben Joyce (1).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP Ky Bush will take the hill for the Trash Pandas in the first playoff game in team history. In his last outing, he took the loss after allowing three runs on four hits over five innings in a 5-2 loss on 9/13 against Birmingham. In his first four appearances in August (8/3-8/25), Bush went 2-0 with a 2.17 ERA with 21 strikeouts in 20.2 innings and a .197 opponents' batting average. Between the All-Star Break and limiting the first full-season pro's workload, Bush had only appeared in the All-Star Futures Game where he tossed one scoreless inning on 7/16. Over six outings from 5/14-6/17, he had been on a roll posting a 3-1 record and a 1.75 ERA after giving up only seven ER over 36 innings in his previous six starts with 35 strikeouts. Selected by the Angels with the 45th overall pick in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of St. Mary's.

PROSPECT RANKINGS: The Trash Pandas' active roster features 13 of the Angels' Top 30 prospects (according to MLB.com): newly-acquired catcher Logan O'Hoppe (No. 1), infielder Zach Neto (No. 2), left-handed pitcher Ky Bush (No. 4), right-handed pitcher Sam Bachman (No. 6), right-handed pitcher Chase Silseth (No. 7), right-handed pitcher Ben Joyce (No. 12), infielder Jeremiah Jackson (No. 14), infielder Kyren Paris (No. 20), outfielder Jordyn Adams (No. 21), right-handed pitcher Coleman Crow (No. 23), right-handed pitcher Mason Erla (No. 26), right-handed pitcher Luke Murphy (No. 27), and lefty Eric Torres (No. 28).

WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunartics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball.

The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).



NEW MILB RULES FOR 2022

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 14, 2022

Major League Baseball announced a variety of experimental playing rules that have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee for use during the 2022 Minor League season. Consistent with the preferences of fans, these rules are designed to improve the pace of play, create more action on the field, and reduce player injuries.

Many experimental rules were first tested on a limited basis in 2021. The use of the most promising rules has been expanded to additional levels of play, providing more players and fans with exposure to the rules and allowing the Competition Committee to better evaluate the impact of each on game play. Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2022 Minor League season:



PITCH TIMER: On-field timers will be used at all full-season affiliates to enforce regulations designed to create a crisp pace of play, with batters required to be ready to hit and pitchers required to deliver the pitch within allotted periods of time. With runners on base, pitchers will have additional allotted time for each pitch but will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. These rules were used in tandem in the Low-A West and in the Arizona Fall League in 2021 and led to a significant improvement in pace of play and a reduction in average game time of more than 20 minutes.

LARGER BASES: The size of first, second and third base will be increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square at all full-season affiliates to reduce player injuries. Bigger bases were used in 2021 at the Triple-A level and in the Arizona Fall League, and were associated with a decrease in the severity of base-related injuries. In addition, the reduction in distance between bases led to a modest increase in the rate of successful stolen base attempts.

DEFENSIVE POSITIONING: In Double-A, High-A and Low-A, the defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, with at least two infielders completely on either side of second base. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to allow infielders to better showcase their athleticism, to increase batting average on balls in play, and to restore a more traditional set of aesthetics and outcomes on batted balls.

TRASH TALK

THE BUSH FILE: LHP Ky Bush gets the ball for the first playoff game in Trash Pandas history to open this series in Tennessee following a stellar regular season in his first full professional season. He enters play tonight on a two-game losing streak, the only time all season he's lost back-to-back starts, most recently a week ago against Birmingham in the series opener, allowing 3 homers in a 5-2 loss to the Barons last Tuesday. That was his seventh appearance since pitching for the AL in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on 7/13. That day, he tossed a scoreless third inning, giving up a walk and a hit with one strikeout. In his return to the rotation on 8/3, Bush allowed one run on three hits with five strikeouts in a no-decision against Tennessee. On 8/11, he allowed just one run over 4.2 solid innings at Biloxi but tied a season-high with four walks in a 3-1 win. His then had 2 of his best starts, allowing 2 runs with no walks over 6 innings to earn his sixth win and first in two months on 8/18 over Chattanooga before another quality start in a 3-2 win at Tennessee on 8/25 before ending the regular season on a two-game losing streak. Overall for Rocket City this season, Bush has allowed three or fewer earned runs in 16 of his 21 starts, including five straight quality starts from 5/21-6/17. That run came to an end on 6/24, as Bush was beaten by the Barons, allowing seven runs 3.1 innings before a season-low 2 innings on 7/1 in Tennessee and 3.2 scoreless innings against the Lookouts on 7/9. Bush picked up his fifth win on 6/17, firing 6 scoreless innings in a 5-0 shutout win over Montgomery for his fifth straight quality start. He earned fourth win the previous Friday, dominating for 6 innings in a 3-2 win over Mississippi. Preceding the win, he allowed only an unearned run on 2 hits over 6 innings with 6 strikeouts on 6/3 in Chattanooga. Prior to that, he earned his third win of the season with 6 dominant innings and a season-high 9 strikeouts against Tennessee on 5/28. He suffered his first loss on 5/14 in Pensacola, giving up two runs over 5.2 innings as the Trash Pandas fell 2-1. He got a no-decision over 4.0 innings as Rocket City went on to win 9-5 on 5/7 vs. Chattanooga. He won his previous start, allowing 1 run on 2 hits with a season-high 6 strikeouts to beat Birmingham on 4/30. Bush picked up his first pro win on 4/19 at Smokies Stadium with 5 scoreless innings, striking out 2. He became the first Trash Pandas starter to earn a win in the team's 10th game. In his Double-A debut on 4/13 against Pensacola, he gave up one run on five hits in 3.2 innings, throwing 61 pitches, 43 for strikes. Bush is currently ranked as the Angels No. 5 prospect according to MLB.com. For the season, Bush is holding righties to a .219 average while left-handed hitters are hitting .276.

<u>VS. TENNESSEE</u>: Bush will face the Smokies for the seventh time this season. Over his first six starts, he is 3-0 with a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP), giving up 26 hits while walking six and striking out 29, holding Tennessee batters to a .252 average.

MORE NOTES

PRO DEBUT: Bush signed his pro contract on 7/20/21 and went to the Angels' facility in Arizona before making his debut in 2021 for High-A Tri-City in August. He tossed 1.1 scoreless innings with 4 strikeouts in his first pro start on 8/12 vs. Spokane and threw a season-long 3.2 scoreless innings with 6 strikeouts on 8/24 vs. Eugene. In his final start, he gave up an unearned run on 3 hits with 2 strikeouts over 2.2 innings on 9/18 at Eugene.
