LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn was held to just one run in a 5-1 loss to Rome on Saturday night...The Cyclones' lone run came on an RBI infield single from 3B **Wilfredo Lara** in the bottom of the third inning...Rome would score the final five runs of the game, including one in the fifth, two in the sixth, and two in the eighth...LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** tossed 41 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision, while RHP **Luis G. Moreno** was tagged with the loss...RHP Blake Burkhalter was sharp for Rome, limiting Brooklyn to an unearned run on six hits over 6.0 frames without allowing a walk...LF **Stephen Paolini** notched a pair of hits with three RBI for the Emperors...2B **Nick Ward** brought in Rome's other two tallies.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On July 28, 2001, OF **Frank Corr** went 5-for-5 and scored three runs at Vermont, becoming the first player in franchise history to record five hits in a single game...In 2007, 3B **Jake Eigsti** laid down a sacrifice bunt in the bottom of the 10th inning, but a throwing error on the play allowed the winning run to score in Brooklyn's 2-1 walk-off win vs. Vermont...In 2011, CF **Travis Taijeron** clubbed a walk-off solo home run with one out in the bottom of the ninth inning in a 2-1 win vs. Connecticut...In 2014, 3B **Jhoan Ureña's** 13-game hitting streak was snapped in an 8-5 win at Lowell...The 13-game streak was Ureña's second of the year, becoming just the fourth player in franchise history to record two 10+ game hit streaks and the third to do it in a single season...In 2016, RHP **Harol González** struck out 11 over 7.0 innings of one-run ball, while 1B **Pete Alonso** went 2-for-4 with a triple and two runs batted in during a 5-3 win at Vermont.

SRF 47: RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** rejoined the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment on Sunday...The 28-year-old has been on the New York Mets' 15-day injured list since June 22 with right shoulder impingement...Reid-Foley was also on New York's 15-day IL from March 28 until April 22 with the same ailment...This is the right-hander's second rehab stint on Coney Island in 2024 and third overall...On April 14, Reid-Foley made his season debut vs. Asheville, striking out the side in the seventh inning...He also made three appearances with Brooklyn in 2023, allowing one run on one hit over 2.2 innings with one walk and three strikeouts...In 23 games at the Major League level this year, Reid-Foley holds a 1-2 record with a 1.66 ERA (4 ER in 21.2 IP), 14 walks, and 25 strikeouts.

SO LONG, STU: For the second time this weekend, the New York Mets swung a trade involving a 2023 Brooklyn Cyclone...New York acquired OF **Jesse Winker** from the Washington Nationals in exchange for RHP **Tyler Stuart** on Sunday morning...Stuart, who was ranked as the organization's No. 23 prospect by *Baseball America*, was Minor League Baseball's ERA leader (2.20) in 2023, splitting the season between Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton...In 14 starts with the Cyclones, the 24-year-old went 4-0 with a microscopic 1.55 ERA (13 ER in 75.2 IP) with 23 walks and 84 strikeouts before joining Double-A on July 14...Stuart's Cyclones teammate — OF **Rhylan Thomas** — was dealt by New York to the Seattle Mariners on Friday in return for RHP **Ryne Stanek**.

TALK 2 'EM: RHP **Kade Morris** has found his stride at the High-A level...The 22-year-old took a perfect game into the seventh on Friday against Rome and holds a minuscule 2.12 ERA over his last six appearances (five starts) dating back to June 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Morris' record during that span sits at 3-2...He has yielded just 24 hits and 10 walks while striking out 35...Since June 21, Morris has been one of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...The righty is tied for second in the league in strikeouts (35)...He is also tied for the SAL lead in wins (3) and is second in innings pitched (34.0), tied for sixth in batting average against (.192) and is seventh in both WHIP (1.00) and ERA (.212)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is second in the league in innings pitched (57.2), fourth in batting average against (.221), tied for sixth in strikeouts (57), eighth in WHIP (1.16) and 10th in ERA (3.43).

MORABITO BITE: OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old finished with his 27th multi-hit game of the year in Saturday's loss, and notched the go-ahead RBI single on Tuesday, in addition to scoring from second base on a sacrifice fly for an insurance run...The McLean, Va. native is tied for eighth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (43)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (71), is second in stolen bases (32), fifth in runs scored (43), and tied for eighth in batting average (.284)...The former second-round selection is fifth in the SAL in stolen bases (32), tied for seventh in batting average (.284), and eighth in on-base percentage (.367) on the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.311), stolen bases (43) and on-base percentage (.410)...He is also second in hits (102) and runs scored (57), and tied for fifth in triples (3).

GRAB A PINT-ARO: RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** has been on a tear over the past month or so...The Pelham, Ala. native surrendered only one unearned run over 4.2 frames of work in Tuesday's win over Rome...The 26-year-old has not surrendered an earned run since June 25 at Aberdeen...Over his four July outings, the veteran has a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 14.0 IP), with eight hits, two hit batters, five walks, and 15 strikeouts...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 14.0+ innings of work this month, Pintaro is tied for the league lead in ERA (0.00) and is seventh in batting average against (.160) and tied for ninth in WHIP (0.93) during the month...As a starter, Pintaro sports a 2.96 ERA across six games, while giving up only one earned run over two relief appearances...Unfortunately, the Shorter University product has not received a lot of run support...The 'Clones have mustered only four runs with Pintaro on the bump across his six starts this season.

vs. ROME: Brooklyn continues a nine-game homestand with six contests against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors have six of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Cade Kuehler** (7), RHP **Jhancarlos Lara** (12), INF **Sabin Ceballos** (17), and RHP **Blake Burkhalter** (26)...RHP **Owen Murphy** (4) and INF **Ambioris Tavarez** (20) are on the injured list...This marks Rome's first trip to Coney Island and the second series ever between the two franchises...Brooklyn and Rome split a six-game series at AdventHealth Stadium from May 7-12.

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old had a four-game multi-hit streak snapped last Saturday but has six multi-hit efforts in his last 12 games...Since July 6, he is hitting .381/.435/.429 with a .864 OPS, five runs scored, two doubles, and three runs batted in over 12 games...Clark is second in the league in batting average (.381) and on-base percentage (.435), and tied for fourth in hits (16) since that date.

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old went yard again on Friday night, and has homered four times in his last eight games, going 8-for-29 (.276) at the plate with eight runs scored, a double, and seven runs batted in...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fourth in the South Atlantic League with 33 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (70) and is tied for fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142).

SHUT IT: Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts lately...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutouts performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones are also tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the Iron-Birds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road...He is hitting .302/.385/.396 with a .781 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 25 stolen bases in 36 road contests...He is fourth in the circuit in road batting average (.302) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (45) and stolen bases (25) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .257/.342/.287 line with a .629 OPS, three extra-base hits, four RBI, and seven stolen bases over 25 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .288/.357/.410 mark with a .767 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 39 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .171/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests...C **Chris Suero** is hitting .269/.383/.462 with a .845 OPS, four home runs, and 19 RBI in 22 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .170/.284/.250 with a .534 OPS, a home run, and 15 RBI in 33 affairs in visiting ballparks.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Even after suffering a loss on Thursday, the 21-year-old is 2-2 with a 2.30 ERA (7 ER in 27.1 IP), allowing only 18 hits and nine walks, while striking out 40 over his last six starts since June 20...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit in strikeouts (78)...If he had logged enough innings to qualify, Tong would be fourth in batting average against (.212), and sixth in both ERA (3.36) and WHIP (1.25)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is first in FIP (2.06), tied for fourth in strikeout rate (35.4%), ninth in strikeout-to-walk rate (25.8%) and 11th in strikeouts (114).

FLARE FOR THE DRAMATIC: Brooklyn's 2-1 walk-off win on Wednesday afternoon marked the second time in the last five games that the Cyclones won via a walk-off single...On Friday vs. Jersey Shore, **Chris Suero** provided the game-winning RBI single with the bases loaded in the bottom of the 10th in a 6-5...**Nick Lorusso** delivered the first walk-off win of the year, clubbing a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...On the flip side, Brooklyn has suffered seven walk-off defeats this season, most recently a 3-2 loss at Wilmington on July 12...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.66% of all defeats, including 26.15% of all road losses, while earning 10 walk-off wins...27 of Brooklyn's 226 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (11.95%)...The Cyclones have also earned 21 wins in their last 21 bat.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), RHP **Kade Morris** (26), and RHP **Jack Weninger** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (18), Báez (20), RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (21), **Wilfredo Lara** (22), OF **Nick Morabito** (24), and Morris (25)...Ziegler is on the full-season injured list.

Walked one and struck out five...Threw 74 pitches and 51 strikes (68.92%)...Relieved by RHP **Ben Simon** with the bases empty and two out in the top of the fifth and Rome leading 1-0...The Cyclones tied the game in the sixth on a C **Chris Suero** single and took the lead in the eighth on a CF **Nick Morabito** single and a sacrifice fly, defeating the Emperors, 3-1.

GRAB A PINT-ARO: The Pelham, Ala. native has been on a tear over the past month or so...The 26-year-old has not surrendered an earned run since June 25 at Aberdeen...Over his four July outings, Pintaro has a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 14.0 IP), with eight hits, two hit batters, five walks, and 15 strikeouts...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 14.0+ innings of work this month, Pintaro is tied for the league lead in ERA (0.00) and is seventh in batting average against (.160) and tied for ninth in WHIP (0.93) during the month...As a starter, Pintaro sports a 2.96 ERA across six games, while giving up only one earned run over two relief appearances...Unfortunately, Shorter University has not received a lot of run support...The 'Clones have mustered only four runs with Pintaro on the bump across his six starts this season.

CHANGE OF PLANS: Pintaro's final start for the Pioneer League's Glacier Range Riders (Kalispell, Mont.) was cut short due to great news...The 26-year-old tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball against the Great Falls Voyagers on June 2 before being told by manager **Paul Fletcher** that he would not continue...Pintaro's day came to a close because his contract had been purchased by the New York Mets, officially signing the following day..."It was surreal. After the second inning I came to the dugout and I heard him (Fletcher) say somebody get warm and I kind of gave him a look," said Pintaro to the *Daily Inter Lake*...In three starts for the Range Riders, Pintaro was 1-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER in 14.1 IP), one walk, and 23 strikeouts...The Pelham, Ala. native had a 14.44 strikeouts-per-nine innings ratio in the MLB Partner circuit...Pintaro was teammates with 2024 BlueClaws INF **Chad Castillo** with the Range Riders.

REMEMBER ME?: Following the 2021 and 2022 collegiate seasons, Pintaro pitched for the Frederick (Md.) Keys of the MLB Draft League...During that time, the 26-year-old was a teammate of a few current and former Cyclones...In 2021, Pintaro pitched alongside RHP **Dylan Tebrake**, who was a member of the 2023 bullpen and is currently on Double-A Binghamton's 60-day injured list...During the 2022 season, the Shorter University alum was a teammate of RHP **Jordan Geber** (2023-24) who is currently with Double-A Binghamton and current Cyclones RHP **Jonah Tong**...In 25 games (17 starts) for the Keys, Pintaro was 3-9 with a 4.55 ERA (44 ER in 87.0 IP), 41 walks, and 108 strikeouts.

SHORTER STACK: Pintaro became the first Shorter University alum to sign a contract with a Major League team since becoming an NCAA program in 2013...During his time with the Hawks, the Alabama native was Gulf South Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Pintaro accumulated a 20-7 record with a 3.19 ERA (70 ER in 197.1 IP), 76 walks, and 286 strikeouts during those two seasons...Shorter is located in Rome, Ga. and its campus is located 3.7 miles southwest of the Rome Emperors' Advent-Health Stadium...Pintaro was coached at Shorter by **Wes Timmons**, who was a member of the 2003 South Atlantic League champion Rome Braves.
