LAST GAME

Normalcy returned for the Bowie Baysox on Wednesday night, as they plated seven runs in a constant attack against the Akron RubberDucks to win 7-3. It was a near-instant lead for the Baysox, as Connor Norby blasted the second pitch of the game to right-center field for a solo home run. It was a short-lived lead, as Jose Tena matched the feat for Akron, dealing his own leadoff home run in the bottom of the frame. Akron hit three solo home runs in the game, two off of Justin Armbruster. Bowie ran into good luck when Akron's relievers walked in one run in the sixth inning, and hit two different batters with the bases loaded in the ninth inning.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Akron has been the hottest team in the Southwest Division over the past month, and have an opportunity to complete their late-season comeback with this final six-game series. The last time these two teams met, Bowie was entering a seven-game series with an active eight-game win streak, but only won two of the seven games. Since the start of that series, Akron is 21-11, and Bowie is only 14-17. Akron has been dictated by their pitching plenty this season, their 3.53 ERA over that same span is the third-best in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Still in his first season of pro ball, left-hander Doug Nikhazy was a late-season jump from High-A to Akron, but is still trying to get his legs underneath him. Cleveland's second-round pick last season racked up high strikeouts numbers in High-A, punching out 118 batters in 93 innings, but he has been learning the hard lesson of losing batters in Double-A, as his first two starts have seen him walk eight batters in just 6.1 innings, including a career-high tying six walks in his last start. Despite the walks he surrendered last week, Nikhazy still found time to strike out nine batters, and kept Harrisburg from scoring in the outing. His fastball can sit in the low-90s that works in the top half of the zone, and a strong overhead, looping curveball, as well as a slider with late bite.

NORBY KNOWS HOW TO HIT

Connor Norby is taking on all pitches lately, while he has shifted back into the top of the Bowie lineup, Norby is hitting 7-for-21 (.333) at the plate with six walks and only four strikeouts. His 24 home runs across High-A and Double-A are tied with Jordan Westburg for the most among Orioles minor league players. He has hit ten home runs in the first inning of games this season, the most in Minor League Baseball, and tied for the most with Austin Riley and Jose Altuve for the most in all of baseball. He has seven home runs in the first inning of games with Bowie, that's the most among any player in Double-A this year.

DASCH-ING THROUGH THE SNOW

First baseman Andrew Daschbach is on his best run of the season. Since the start of a 10-game hit streak that began on August 27, Daschbach is 14-for-46 (.304) at the plate, with four home runs and nine RBI. Daschbach only drew 42 walks in 105 total games last season, but is already up to 51 in just 99 games this season. Bowie was known for his strikeouts in 2021, his 144 strikeouts were the second-most in the Orioles system, behind only Kyle Stowers (171). This season, however, Daschbach has already eclipsed his 2021 total with 156 strikeouts.

MEAT LEFT ON THE BONE

Some of Bowie's offensive woes this season have not been from a lack of effort. In fact, the Baysox are the team most likely to start an inning with a runner on base in the Eastern League. Bowie leads the league in all three slash lines (.272/.370/.467) from the first batter of an inning this season. They also lead the league in lead off doubles. All of those numbers combine to Bowie leaving 987 runners on base this season, the most in the league, and an average of 7.4 per game. Bowie has also stranded the most runners in scoring position in the league (729). Inversely, Bowie has the second-most strikeouts in the league when batting with runners on base (579). Since the start of their last series with Richmond, Bowie is only 5-for-64 (.078) at the plate with runners in scoring position.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie has had a love-hate relationship with one-run games this season. One-run games have been one of the most common outcomes for Bowie this season, as their 49 one-run games leads the Eastern League. Their .429 winning percentage in one-run games (21-28) is the second-lowest in the Eastern League, trailing only Binghamton. The 28 one-run losses is the most in all of Minor League Baseball.

CAREER NOTES

- Finished two-plus year career at Ball State going 12-4 with a 3.43 ERA, including 199 strikeouts in 139 innings pitched.
- Redshirted his freshman season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John surgery
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball.
 - Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler
 - Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State
 - Grandfather, Alan Darner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state championships, and is in the Indiana state basketball hall of fame.
 - Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively.
 - Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern, and won a national championship in 2015. Also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay, and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING

BASEBALL AMERICA: "McDermott has a solid set of four pitches. He misses bats with an aboveaverage fastball that sits 92-96 mph and can get up to 98 on occasion. He pairs his heater with two potentially above-average breaking pitches in his 12-to-6 curveball in the mid 70s and a titling slider that gets chase swings out of the strike zone. McDermott's changeup is still a major work in progress, as is his control of both breaking pitches. Even during his excellent pro debut, he walked 10 batters in 18 innings at Fayetteville."

McDermott - On Being Traded for Trey Mancini: "I know how important Trey was to the organization as a person and a player, and firstly, it does mean plenty to have been part of this trade for someone that meant so much to his team. I want to try and contribute to this team too and show what I'm capable of. I can't compare myself to Trey, though. He's an outfielder. I'm a pitcher. He's his own player, and I'm my own player. All I can really say is how much I want to help this organization succeed."

NOTES BY OUTING ^

- 8/17 v SOM Double-A Debut. Career-highs in runs, home runs, and walks. Hit two snags in the second inning where he walked a batter and allowed a two-run home run. Walked three more batters and allowed a grand slam before being lifted in the fourth.
- 8/23 v ALT Allowed another three-run home run in the first inning, and a two-run home run in the third inning. Retired the first nine batters, allowed a walk and a double for one run in the fourth.
- 9/3 @ ERI Allowed a solo home run to open the third inning. Had a runner thrown out at home later in the frame, and retired the next batters to finish the outing.

Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach. He spent three seasons as a player/coach (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds) before being named as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016 and the Keys hitting coach in 2017. Moore signed as a non-drafted free agent with the Orioles in 2010 after playing collegiately at the University of Alabama. As a high schooler, he starred at Edgewood Academy (AL), where he won three AISA state baseball championships. Kyle, his wife Whitney and their two daughters reside in Sarasota, FL. He is a Type-1 Diabetic.

Hitting Coach: Branden Becker

Becker was drafted by the Orioles in the 17th round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft in 2015 and played parts of four seasons in the organization before retiring in May, 2019. He rejoined the Orioles as the Fundamentals Coach for the IronBirds for the 2020 season before it was canceled. He served as the Hitting Coach for the Complex League Orioles in 2021.

Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
