RIDERS TAKE FINALE OVER DRILLERS:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Midland RockHounds 10-3 in the first game of the series from Momentum Bank Ballpark on Tuesday night. The RoughRiders (24-22, 55-59) had their opportunities early on the offense side, loading the bases in two of the third three innings, but Midland (26-20, 58-57) struck first with two bases-loaded walks of their own in the first inning to nab the 2-0 lead off of Frisco starter **Noah Bremer** (0-2). Frisco didn't find the scoreboard until the third inning when **Jax Biggers** hit his 10th home run of the season, a solo shot, to make it 2-1. Biggers became the fourth RoughRiders player to reach double digits in homers, joining **Thomas Saggese**, **Evan Carter** and **Trevor Hauver**. After the RockHounds put three more runs on the board in the bottom of the third, the Riders came back in the fifth with a sacrifice fly from **Aaron Zavala** and a **Josh Hatcher** RBI single to pull within two at 5-3. That score held until the bottom of the eighth when Midland exploded for five runs to blow the game open. On the offensive side, Carter led the way, doubling twice in a 3-for-4 day with a walk. Hauver and **Liam Hicks** also reached four times to pace the Frisco lineup which walked a total of seven times. David Leal (5-5) earned the win for Midland, allowing two runs over 2.1 innings in relief.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 19 games in August, (9-10 record) the RoughRiders are second in the Texas League with a 4.08 ERA while allowing a league-low 14 home runs and .240 BAA. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday in Corpus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is second-to-last in the Texas League with a .726 OPS and last in runs per game with 4.5 per contest.

WINS AND LOSSES WITH RISP:

The RoughRiders won four in a row in Corpus Christi before losing seven of their last nine entering Wednesday's game. Over the four wins in a row, the Riders allowed just three runs on the pitching side (0.75 ERA) while scoring 4.8 runs per game and hitting .250 (8-for-32) with runners in scoring position. Over the last nine games, Frisco has allowed 61 runs (6.46 ERA) while scoring 4.3 runs per game and hitting .206 (21-for-102) with runners in scoring position.

THE ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season. In the second half, Frisco is a league-best 12-10 on the road and they have a 30-28 record overall. Away from Riders Field, Frisco is averaging 5.8 runs per game (second in the Texas League to Arkansas) and they have a league-high 109 doubles on the road as well. At home, the Riders are just 25-31 on the season, the worst home record in the Texas League.

HAVU YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 48 games since, he is batting .302/.417/.486/.903 with 13 doubles, six home runs, 29 RBIs and 37 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 43 points and his OPS 101 points.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 72 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 16.4 percent walk rate this year is fourth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 21 times in his last 20 games. His .415 OBP on the season is seventh in all of Double-A and among all 11 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 29 games, Hicks is batting .327 (32-for-98)/.451/.439/.890 with six doubles, a triple, a home run, 14 RBIs, 20 walks and 14 runs scored. In his last 16 games, he is batting .346 (18-for-52) with a .940 OPS.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on Thursday in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all nine save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

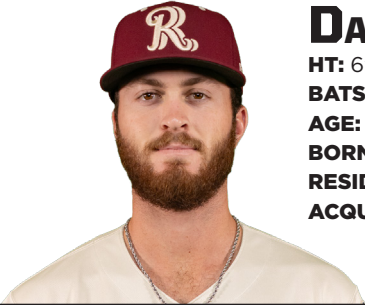

ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrienes College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
