#### LATE RALLY LIFTS CARDINALS OVER SURGE IN SERIES FINALE: The

Cardinals scored five unanswered runs in the last two innings on Sunday afternoon as Springfield defeated the Wichita Wind Surge 6-2 at Riverfront Stadium in the series finale. **RJ Yeager** tied the game 2-2 with a two-out RBI single to score **Mike Antico** from second base in the top of the 8th inning and **Bryan Torres** gave the Cardinals a 5-2 lead with a bases clearing double in the top of the 9th. **Jacob Buchberger** added two hits and an RBI for the Cards. The Springfield bullpen put together 3.1 scoreless innings in relief of starter **Max Rajcic** who allowed just 2 R over 5.2 IP with 7 K.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Left-hander **Danny Wirchansky** makes his 9th appearance (7th start) of the season for Arkansas...Last pitched a week and a half ago on Friday, May 24 at Corpus Christi and got the win allowing 2 ER on 5 H with 4 K over 4.0 IP in a relief appearance...Last two outings have been in relief... #### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**



# The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an

#### CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

RDAD WARRIDRS: The Cardinals have been more than solid on the road this season, going 17-9 away from Hammons Field. The Birds' road record is the second-best in the Texas League behind Frisco's 19-9 mark. The Cards have a 3.86 ERA on the road compared to a 5.80 mark at home.

HITS, HITS, HITS: This past week in Wichita the Cardinals' bats heated up again, wrapping out double-digit hits in four of the six games at Riverfront Stadium. Springfield batted .292 last week and are batting .300 over their last 14 games, averaging 9.7 hits per game during that time. For the season the Cardinals are batting .273, the top mark in Double-A, and have 460 hits, 14 more than any other Double-A team.

Nathan Church leads the Texas league in hits with 57, and Bryan Torres ranks 4th with 54.

MOUND TURNAROUND: While the 2024 season has been up and down for the Cardinals pitching staff, Springfield is on a nice run of late. Over their last 9 games, the Cards have a team ERA of 3.08, tied for 3rd in the Texas League during that time. During their series in Wichita, the Cardinals registered a 2.55 ERA. The Cards' bullpen was particularly effective against the Wind Surge, regsitering a 2.21 ERA over 20.1 IP with 3 saves on the week.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cards have struck out just 360 times in 51 games, the 3rd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. Springfield trails the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (352 K in 51 games) and Frisco RoughRiders (359 K). The Cards are averaging just 7.06 K's per game.

#### BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL PLAGUING CARDS STAFF: So far in

2024, home runs and the big inning have hurt the Birds. Springfield has surrendered 36 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 36 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 140 of the 265 total runs scored by the opposition, 52.8% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 8.3% of their innings pitched. In the other 398.2 IP Springfield has allowed 125 runs, which comes out to 2.82 runs per 9 innings. The Cardinals are 21-3 in games in which they have not allowed a "big inning".

The Cardinals have also allowed 59 homers in 51 games this season, most in Double-A.

**RED-HOT RIVAS:** Riding a 8-game hitting streak and an extended solid 15-game stretch, Cardinals shortstop Jeremy Rivas has seen his name rise amongst the top hitters in the Texas League at 3rd among gualified hitters with an average of .310. Over his last 15 games since May 16, Rivas is batting .367 (18-for-49), 2nd in the league behind Bryan Torres (.370) during that time.

TORRES AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: With a recent hot streak, Springfield leadoff man Bryan Torres finds his name at or near the top of several Texas League categories. Torres is the leading hitter among active, gualified hitters in the Texas League with a .331 batting average. He is 5th with a .404 OBP, 4th in hits (54) and tied for 3rd in stolen bases (15). Springfield's leadoff man is 17for-44 (.386) during a current 10-game hitting streak, and has led off the game for the Cardinals with a base hit in 5 of his last 10 games.

SLAM THE DOOR: Since the promotion of Andre Granillo to Triple-A Memphis on May 21, Cardinals reliever Matt Svanson has been a workhorse at the end of Springfield's bullpen. Svanson leads the Texas League in appearances with 20 and is 8-for-8 in save opportunities, also tops in the circuit. Since May 21. Svanson is 4-for-4 in save opportunities and has not allowed an earned run over his last 6 appearances and has allowed just one earned run over his last 11 appearances since May 7 and is on a 6.0 inning scoreless streak.

#### **REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his

go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, Redmond has gone 23 straight games without a home run.


