- The Blue Jays collected a second straight walk-off win, using a Cristian Feliz bases loaded walk in the bottom of the 10th to seal a 5-4 comeback win over St. Lucie.
- Feliz also belted a game-tying, solo home run in the bottom of the ninth to send the game to extras.
- The contest saw a combined six homers - three for each team - including back-to-back longballs for Ronald Hernandez and Jeffrey Rosa in the sixth inning against Grant Rogers.
- Alexis Hernandez hit his fourth homer in six games with a solo bomb in the second inning.
- The Blue Jays bullpen fired 4.2 scoreless innings, highlighted by Kai Peterson's 2-inning, 6-strikeout effort that earned him the win.
- The victory is just the second time this season the Blue Jays have won after trailing through eight innings (2-17).
- Dunedin now leads the series 3-0 and can do no worse than a series split.

HEAD ABOVE WATER

Wednesday's Dunedin victory pushed the team back above .500 for the first time since April 24. The Blue Jays' 25-23 record is the team's best since they were 9-7 on April 23. Dunedin dove as far as six-games below the .500 mark (13-19, 14-20). With last night's Clearwater win, the Jays remain eight games out of first place.

FEELING STREAKY

Following six straight wins to climb to 20-20 last week, the Blue Jays lost three straight to Bradenton. Following those three straight losses, Dunedin has won five straight.

LONG WALK OFFS A FEW BLOCKS FROM THE BEACH

Last night's walk-off win was the Blue Jays' ninth walk-off result of the season - four for, and five against. Manuel Beltre collected each of the first two walk off knocks before Perez's triple on Wednesday. St. Lucie's loss marked their ninth walk-off loss of the season.

JAYS JUICE

With three homers last night, the Blue Jays took the FSL lead with 38 home runs this season. The team trails Modesto by one homer for the Single-A lead. Dunedin's 27 homers this month are the most in Single-A. Dunedin has homered in 15 of their last 17 games. Across that stretch, 10 different players have gone deep.

UNO, DOS, ADIOS

After Dunedin tied a season high with 15 strikeouts as a pitching staff Wednesday, St. Lucie tied a season-high for strikeouts against the Blue Jays lineup, striking out 16 last night. The Blue Jays pitching staff ranks 3rd in the FSL with 510 Ks, while St. Lucie leads the circuit with 526.

CLOSE BUT COMFORTABLE

Last night's game marked the fourth contest of the team's last seven decided by one run. Dunedin has played 17 one-run games (9-8). The Jays have won six of their last seven one-run contests. 33 of the Blue Jays 48 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 18-16 record in those games.

NO BULL FROM THE 'PEN

Juanmi Vasquez and Kai Peterson combined for 4.2 scoreless innings to close last night's game out of the Jays bullpen. Much of the Blue Jays' success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 3.14 ERA with a 1.22 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 5.79 ERA with a 1.72 WHIP. The bullpen's 4.39 overall ERA ranks 7th in the league.

HOW ABOUT HERNANDEZ?

Alexis Hernandez continued tear last night, belting his fourth home run in his last six games. Across his current six-game on base streak, Hernandez is 11-24 with 8 RBIs and just 4 strikeouts. Across those six games, Hernandez has boosted his batting average from .165 to .233, and his OPS from .509 to .750.

WELCOME BACK, WILLIAMS

First baseman Peyton Williams began a rehab assignment with the D-Jays last night. Williams, a 2022 7th round draft pick, has spent parts of the last two seasons with Dunedin, hitting .274 with 7 homers in 45 games. He was selected as the league's best first baseman according to Baseball America's survey of FSL coaches last season. Williams is the seventh minor or major league rehabber to appear in Dunedin this season.

ABOUT FERNANDO

- Signed by the Blue Jays as an international free agent out of Nicaragua in July 2022.
- Native of Rivas, Nicaragua - located in southwestern Nicaragua. Also the hometown of MLB reliever Erasmo Ramirez (currently with Tampa Bay).
- Is a consensus top-30 Toronto prospect due to impressive command of strike zone... often described as "polished."
- Boasts best control in the Blue Jays' system, according to Baseball America's 2024 Best Tools list.
- Arsenal features a mid-90s fastball, changeup, curveball, and slider.

2024 SEASON

- Posted new season high with 6.1 innings on 5/24 at Bradenton. Allowed just one earned run on a solo homer - his first allowed since Opening Day.
- 4.66 ERA in 4 starts at home; 2.78 ERA in 4 starts on the road.
- Has yet to allow more than 3 ER in a start this season.
- Struck out a career-high 9 on 4/26 at Jupiter. Did not allow a walk in six innings of one-run ball.
- Posted 5.27 ERA through first three starts...
