YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 1-0, for their second consecutive shutout win. **Jack Choate** started and threw 4.2 innings, striking out seven. **Evan Gates** worked 2.1 innings and struck out four. **Cameron Cotter** threw a quiet eighth and **Trent Harris** picked up his first Double-A save, striking out two in the ninth. The game's only run scored with a sacrifice fly by **Carter Howell** in the third.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels are looking to pick up back-to-back wins for the first time this season.

ZEROING IN: The Flying Squirrels have held the Baysox scoreless for their last 19 innings, which dates back to the ninth inning of Thursday's game. Richmond won, 10-0, on Friday night before a 1-0 shutout on Saturday. Those games marked the eighth time in team history the Flying Squirrels have pitched back-to-back shutouts and the first time since April 2018, also against the Baysox. The last time a team threw three consecutive shutouts in the Eastern League was in 2021 (Akron). The Flying Squirrels' current streak of 19.1 innings without allowing a run is the fifth-longest in team history. The record is 26.2 innings without surrendering a run from August 28-31, 2016.

1-0: Saturday's game was the first 1-0 shutout win for the Flying Squirrels since Sept. 3, 2024 against Akron and the fourth in the last four seasons. It was also the 32nd 1-0 win in team history, including a franchise-record six 1-0 wins in 2012. The only consecutive 1-0 shutout wins in franchise history were on April 17 and 18, 2018 against the Baysox at The Diamond.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,747 fans per home game, which leads all 120 MiLB clubs.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 2-4 in last week's road trip to Harrisburg, dropping four-of-five after winning the opener. In the Eastern League, the Richmond offense is second in hits (110), tied for second in batting average (.246), eighth in runs (51), fifth in total bases (157), tied for eighth in doubles (20), tied for ninth in homers (9), eighth in RBIs (43), seventh in walks (51) and first in strikeouts (101 - fewest). The Richmond pitching staff is seventh in ERA (4.19) and sixth in strikeouts (132).

THE BAYSOX split last week's series against the SeaWolves at home after taking two-of-three at Altoona the previous weekend to begin the season. Bowie's roster includes five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (No. 6), RHP Patrick Reilly (No. 16), RHP Trace Bright (No. 17), RHP Alex Pham (No. 26) and RHP Zach Fruit (No. 30). Five players are ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Bradfield (No. 3), Reilly (No. 10), C Creed Willems (No. 12), Bright (No. 25) and Pham (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Seth Lonsway** makes his third start of the season and the third of his career against the Baysox. In his season debut on April 8, Lonsway threw five scoreless innings and struck out seven, holding the Senators to two hits at FNB Field. He started the first game of this series and allowed four runs (three earned) over five innings. Prior to Tuesday's start, Lonsway had not allowed an earned run in his previous five outings, spanning 26.2 innings. During his time with Richmond, Lonsway has only allowed earned runs in three of his 42 innings pitched, with all eight earned runs against him coming in starts against the Baysox. Lonsway was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. **For more on Lonsway, see page two.**

FOR CHESAPEAKE: Right-hander Ryan Long makes his third start of the season. He started the first game of the series on Tuesday and threw five scoreless innings, allowing three hits with three strikeouts. In his season debut on April 9 against the SeaWolves, he allowed three runs (two earned) over 3.2 innings in a no-decision. Long is in his third season with the Baysox and has gone 4-9 with a 5.33 ERA in 38 outings, including 22 starts. Long has pitched against the Flying Squirrels six times in his career, going 1-1 with a 1.95 ERA (6 ER/27.2 IP). Long was selected by the Orioles in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of a California high school.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 12 stolen base attempts this season, which leads all 30 Double-A teams and ranks tied for fifth among the 120 MiLB teams. Sugastey leads the Eastern League with seven runners caught stealing. Morgan is second in the league with five.

BERI BOMBS: **Victor Bericoto** hit two homers last Sunday afternoon at Harrisburg, belting a three-run homer in the first and a solo home run in the seventh. It was the first two-homer game of his Double-A career and the second of his professional career. He also had a two-homer game in 2023 with High-A Eugene. He went deep again on Friday night, the 25th over his Flying Squirrels career, which ties him with **Frankie Tostado** for eighth on the franchise's all-time home run list. In his last five games since Sunday, Bericoto is batting .526 (10-for-19) with three homers, three doubles, three walks and seven RBIs.

ARTY PARTY: After batting .077 (2-for-26) in his first eight games of the season, **Aeverso Arteaga** is batting .476 (10-for-21) on his current six-game hit streak since April 13, adding a double, a homer and five RBIs. The streak dating back to the final game of the road trip to Harrisburg and each game of the current series against the Baysox. He's currently tied for the third-longest active hit streak in the league.

PLAY THE HITS: The Flying Squirrels have collected 110 hits through their first 14 games this season, which is the second-most in the Eastern League. The team is batting .246 (110-for-448), which is also second-highest in the league. However, the Richmond offense is batting .203 (24-for-118) with runners in scoring position, which is 11th the league, but they went 6-for-15 in Friday's 10-0 win.

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's season-opening Flying Squirrels roster includes 22 players who have previously played for the Flying Squirrels. There are six players who have made their team debuts, including **Aeverso Arteaga**, **Sabin Ceballos**, **Manuel Mercedes**, **Rodolfo Nolasco**, **Braxton Roxby** and **Joe Whitman**. Roxby, acquired from the Reds in a trade earlier this year, is the only newcomer with previous Double-A experience.

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster, including the United States (20 players), Venezuela (3), the Dominican Republic (2), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 20 American-born players, 11 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (2), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Kentucky (1), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1) and Texas (1). There are 11 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, six were signed as non-drafted free agents, six as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades and one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft. For 23 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and five have played with other major-league organizations.

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: Last season, 14 former Flying Squirrels players reached the majors for the first time. That was the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvali**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors last season were **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023), **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24), **Parker Dunshee** (2023), **Grant McCray** (2024), **Sandro Fabian** (2021) and **Trevor McDonald** (2024). **Christian Koss** (2024) made his debut for the Giants earlier this week as the first new former Flying Squirrel in the majors this year. Dating back to 2022, 23-of-the-last-26 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. The 2023 season saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Victor Bericoto** is tied for third in hits (15), tied for third in total bases (28), fourth in OPS (1.035), fourth in walks (7), tied for fourth in homers (3), sixth in SLG (.596), tied for sixth in walks (10), seventh in OBP (.439) and eighth in batting average (.319). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for fourth in homers (3), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (7), tied for fifth in runs scored (10) and tied for sixth in total bases (26). **Jack Choate** is fourth in strikeouts (21).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes six players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Trent Harris** (No. 26), **Aeverso Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). There are also six players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1954: Parker Field officially opened for its first International League Opening Day. The Richmond Virginians lost to the Rochester Red Wings, 4-3. Manager Luke Appling rode a 1912 Hudson to lead a pregame parade down Broad Street. Two first-inning errors by the Vees gave the Red Wings a 2-0 lead. Richmond scored three in the fifth to take the lead, capped by a two-run homer from starting pitcher Dick Starr. Rochester tied the game with a homer by Allie Clark in the eighth. Norfolk native Al Richter hit a go-ahead single in the ninth. It was Richmond's first season hosting IL baseball since 1917. **1980:** The Richmond Braves beat the Pawtucket Red Sox, 3-2, at Parker Field. Tied, 2-2, in the bottom of the ninth, Bruce Benedict hit a single off the glove of third baseman Wade Boggs to put runners on first and third. Pawtucket manager Joe Morgan brought center fielder Reid Nichols in to set up a five-man infield and pinch-hitter Steve Hammond hit a ball to first, but Rufino Linares beat the throw home to score the winning run. Richmond put a runner on third in the eighth inning, but Pawtucket pulled off a hidden ball trick at first base helped work out of the inning. **1984:** After back-to-back rainouts had postponed the Richmond Braves' final home opener at Parker Field against the Columbus Clippers, play was halted on April 19 after one inning. The suspended game was completed on April 20, the fourth attempt to get the game in, and the R-Braves overcame a 7-0 deficit to win, 9-8. Brad Komrinsk hit a two-run triple in the fifth to cap a five-run frame and bring Richmond within two. Rufino Linares hit a two-run, go-ahead double in the sixth to move the R-Braves ahead, 8-7. Columbus won the second game of the night, 2-1, in eight innings after it was scheduled for seven. **1999:** The Richmond Braves beat the Indianapolis Indians, 2-0, on the road at Victory Field. Richmond pitchers Bruce Chen, Mike Cather and Marc Pisciotta threw eight hitless innings. Reliever Adam Butler allowed an infield single in the top of the ninth when he was late covering first base to break up the no-hit bid. **2016:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 3-2, in 11 innings at The Diamond. Ricky Oropesa won the game with a walk-off home run in the bottom of the 11th.
