CLARK LIFTS 'CAPS TO WILD WALK-OFF TO CAP OPENING WEEKEND: Outfielder Max Clark delivered a gametying home run and Andrew Jenkins scored on a game-ending wild pitch as the West Michigan Whitecaps capped off a series sweep of the Dayton Dragons with their second consecutive walk-off victory by a score of 7-6 in 10 innings Sunday afternoon at LMCU Ballpark. The Detroit Tigers top prospect finishes the series 4-for-10 with five RBI while drawing six walks to just three strikeouts and his first home run of the season – a three-run shot – helping West Michigan complete the sweep. Dayton jumped in front early, as outfielder Yerlin Confidan crossed the plate on a sacrifice fly in the first inning before coming home on a passed ball in the third - putting the Dragons in front 2-0. Meanwhile, Dayton starter Adam Serwinowski looked strong through three innings of work, limiting the 'Caps to three baserunners while recording two strikeouts to maintain the 2-0 lead. West Michigan responded with three runs in the fifth - featuring a two-run double from Cole Turney - forging in front 3-2. It was short-lived, however, as Dayton rallied for four runs in the seventh – highlighted by a Leo Balcazar RBI single taking a commanding 6-3 advantage. The 'Caps were down to their final out in the eighth inning with a pair of runners on base when Clark delivered the biggest swing of the contest - launching a ball over the left field wall to level the game at 6-6. In extra innings, 'Caps reliever Preston Howey stranded a runner on third base with back-to-back punchouts in the top of the tenth to keep the game tied at 6-6 before Andrew Jenkins crossed the plate on the wild pitch in the bottom half - sending West Michigan to the 7-6 win, and their second walk-off in as many days.

BRICEÑO BOMBS: After suffering a knee injury that cost him three-plus months of playing time in Iow-A Lakeland last season, the Maracay, Venezuela native (Miguel Cabrera's hometown) kicked the door down in the Arizona Fall League - earning MVP honors after posting a staggering .433 batting average with 10 home runs, and 27 RBIs through 25 games.

CLARK MAKING HIS MARK: When asked to describe 19-year-old outfielder Max Clark, High-A West Michigan manager Tony Cappuccilli kept it simple, "He's a 19-year-old dude who plays baseball—and he's good at it". Once the Tigers drafted Clark third overall in 2023 and signed him for \$7.7 million, the hype began to build. Through it all, the Indiana prep product has remained unfazed. After a rocky start to his pro career - hitting just .154 through 11 games with Lakeland in 2023 - the Tigers No. 2 prospect and the No. 5 prospect in baseball exploded in 2024 - slashing .279/.372/.421 with nine homers, seven RBI, and 29 stolen bases.

TOP DOG IN THE MILB: The Tigers have the best farm system in baseball heading into the 2025 season, boasting six prospects in MLB Pipeline's updated top 100: P Jackson Jobe (No. 5), IF Max Clark (No. 6), IF Kevin McGonigle (No. 28), IF Bryce Rainer (No. 52), C Thayron Liranzo (No. 81), and IF Josue Briceño (No. 94). The Tigers are one of six teams with six or more prospects listed, one of two teams with three top-30 prospects and the only team with two prospects in the top six. The Boston Red Sox, who rank third, are the only other team in baseball with two top-10 prospects and three top-30 prospects. The Tigers replace the Baltimore Orioles, who held the top spot in the preseason lists for the past three seasons but now rank 15th, after graduating previous top prospects - such as infielder Jackson Holliday.

FOR WEST MICHIGAN: RHP Carlos Marcano makes his 2025 Whitecaps debut on the mound after spending the entirety 2024 campaign with the 'Caps - where he posted a 3-11 record with a 3.86 ERA, 97 strikeouts, and an opponent BAA of .276. The Maturin, Venezuela native kept his head above water as a 20-year-old in the Midwest League, and looks to take another step forward this season. Marcano is slated to start games 1 & 6 of this series. Information for pitchers to follow can be found in the ensuing pages.

- Marcano, who was signed by the Tigers as an international free agent in 2021 (the same class

that featured Cristian Santana) was the youngest pitcher in the Florida State League to surpass 20

innings pitched in 2023. The teenager held his own in his first full season at the low-A level, tossing 100 innings while going 4-5 with a 4.50 ERA and generating 78 strikeouts and reducing hard contact (holding opposing hitters to a .237 batting average against).

2024: Marcano had a very up-and-down season as the youngest starter in the Midwest League - finishing 3-11 with a 3.86 ERA (lowest mark of his career) but he struggled with hard contact, finishing with a WHIP of 1.41. However, he controlled the strike zone well, allowing, on average, just three walks per nine innings pitched. 2023: After being a full-time member of the Flying Tigers bullpen the year prior, Marcano pitched well once again, limiting toe Peoria Chiefs to just two runs (one aired) in five innings in earning the win in the 'Caps 5-3 win over the Peoria Chiefs on May 22 at Dozer Park.

2022: Marcano came out of the bullpen in his first season with the Flying Tigers but struggled with hard contact, posting a 4.68 ERA while giving up 47 hits through 42.1 innings pitched. However, his strikeout-to-walk ratio stood out, generating 41 punchouts to just 18 walks on the season.

2021: Marcano enjoyed his breakout in the Dominican Summer League. Despite a 5.25 ERA, he displayed his ability to rack up his strikeout totals, punching out 41 hitters while allowing just 10 walks through 36 innings of work.

More: His repertoire includes a sinker/fastball, two breaking balls, and a changeup. The fastball/sinker is his primary pitch that sits in the low 90s which he's able to generate a ton of ground balls with. The two breaking balls are a curveball and a slider. The slider posted a 54% whiff rate in 2023, while the curveball posted a 36%.

Miller first joined West Michigan in May of 2024 as his seasons in Lakeland got significantly better with each passing season. After a good start in 2024, Miller earned the mid-season promotion, giving

the Whitecaps their first left-handed starting pitcher of the season.

2024: Miller started the 2024 campaign with a bang down in low-A Lakeland - going 2-0 with a 1.23 ERA and striking out 29 batters in just 22 innings pitched.

However, he struggled to find his strikeout pitch and allowed a lot of hard contact upon his arrival to West Michigan - going 3-4 with a 4.42 ERA while punching out just 50 batters in 77.1 innings pitched.

College: Posted a 3.63 ERA with a 6-4 record in 74.1 innings pitched while striking out 91 batters, being named first-team All-Ivy League with the Penn Quakers. 91 Ks were second-most in a single-season in Penn baseball history.

More: Played the 2021 season with the Savannah Bananas, a team that now has gone viral for it's unique version of baseball and its social media following in excess of 7 million viewers, becoming the 2021 Coastal Plain League Pitcher of the Year.

Acquired: Signed by the Detroit Tigers as an undrafted free agent on January 22 of this year.

College Days: He pitched six seasons in college for four teams across seven years: St. Joseph's Col-

lege (2016), Southern Illinois-Edwardsville (2018-20), Central Florida (2021) and Dayton (2022). - where he ranked top-10 in the country with a 1.26 BB/9.

Indy League: Before being signed by the Tigers, Serwa pitched with the Chicago Dogs - posting a 4.22 ERA while generating 103 strikeouts to just 23 walks accross 119.1 innings pitched.

Social Media Phenom: Serwa, who has been throwing knuckleballs since he was 9, went viral on social media Jan. 11 when a video of his bullpen at Tread Athletics in North Carolina was posted on X. Rob Friedman, also known as PitchingNinja, showcased Serwa's famous knuckleball with multiple videos on his X account, which has more than 500,000 followers. Serwa throws the fastest knuckleball ever recorded in baseball history, averaging 87 mph and maxing out at 88.5 mph. He also throws a slower variation of his knuckleball, which he calls the "Yoshi" pitch. His five-pitch mix is completed by a 94 mph four-seam fastball, a low-90s sinker and a low-80s curveball.

Repertoire: Serwa is the textbook definition of a junk baller, throwing the Knuckleball as his main pitch while working in a curve ball, sinker, and fastball. **Fun Fact:** Whitecaps catchers have been using larger gloves in order to corral the knuckleball.
