### LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox defeated the Binghamton Rumble Ponies 6-3 on Thursday night for their fourth consecutive win and their seventh of nine against the Rumble Ponies this year. Bowie scored four runs in the third with three of them coming off the bat of **Samuel Basallo**, who blasted his ninth homer of the season. **John Rhodes** drove in another run, **Collin Burns** homered and **Cameron Weston** threw five shutout innings with six strikeouts to earn the win. **Dylan Heid** threw a season-high three perfect innings with a season-high four strikeouts.

### BASALLO IS HOT

Over his last 15 games, C **Samuel Basallo** is batting .345 (19-for-55) with four homers, two doubles, 14 RBI and an OPS of 1.019. With a three-run homer last night, Basallo extended his season-long on-base streak to 14 consecutive games, one game shy of matching **Dylan Beavers'** 15 game on-base streak, the longest on the team this season. The Orioles No. 2 prospect is tied for the fourth-most hits in the league (55) and the fourth-most homers (9).

### COUNTRY RHODES

OF **John Rhodes** is off to a solid start in the month of June. Over his last four games, the Orioles No. 23 prospect is batting .375 (6-for-16) with a homer, a double and six RBI. Rhodes has collected a hit and driven in a run in seven of his last eight games played. On Tuesday, he homered for the first time since April 24 at Richmond.

### HUSHING THE PONIES

In nine games against Binghamton this year, Bowie's pitching staff has recorded a 1.71 ERA in 79 innings, the lowest by any Eastern League team against the Rumble Ponies this season. After **Cameron Weston's** five scoreless innings last night, Baysox starters have combined to give up just seven earned runs over 35.2 innings thrown (1.77 ERA). The Rumble Ponies are batting just .169 against Baysox arms.

### BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (255.2) and strikeouts (305). Conversely, Bowie's starters have thrown the fewest number of innings in the league and in all of Double-A (209.0). Sunday at Somerset was the first six-inning start by a Baysox starting pitcher all season. The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.20 WHIP, which is good for fifth-lowest in Double-A.

### TIME FOR TRACE

RHP **Trace Bright** makes his 11th start of the season for the Baysox. The Orioles No. 16 prospect took the loss on Saturday at Somerset in his most recent start. He threw 4.1 innings, allowed four runs on six hits across one walk and five strikeouts. Bright has now punched out five or more batters in eight of his 10 starts this season. In his last start against Binghamton on May 15, Bright threw 4.1 shutout innings and scattered four hits and three walks in a no decision. The 23-year-old is looking to pitch five innings for the first time since April 26 at Richmond.

### SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies are third in the Northeast Division at 26-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Mets most recently split their six game series against Harrisburg at home. The last time Bowie and Binghamton met was from May 14 - May 19 and Bowie won four of six at Mirabito Stadium. Seven of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF/1B Ryan Clifford (No. 4), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Brandon Sproat (No. 13), OF Alex Ramirez (No. 16), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 18), RHP Nolan McLean (No. 19), RHP Joander Suarez (No. 28).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Joander Suarez makes his ninth start of the season for Binghamton. The 24-year-old took the loss on Saturday against Harrisburg in his most recent start and threw 4.2 innings with a season-high 10 strikeouts but gave up five runs on six hits. The Venezuelan has given up 14 runs over his last three starts after giving up only nine runs in his first seven outings. In his last meeting against Bowie on May 19, Suarez gave up two runs on three hits in just 2.2 innings in a no decision. The right-hander makes his third start of the season against Bowie.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
