FRISCO BEGINS SECOND HALF WITH 4-2 LOSS:

The second half of the season began Tuesday night at Riders Field, as Frisco started a six-game series against Corpus Christi with a 4-2 loss to the Hooks. Frisco designated hitter **Dustin Harris** hit his second home run in the last week and 13th of the season, while starter **Avery Weems** struck out five batters in five innings Tuesday night in the loss. Corpus Christi (1-0, 32-37) starter Misael Tamarez struck out six batters and walked none Tuesday night and gave up two runs on two hits in 5.2 innings. The Hooks scored first in the top of the third inning with an unearned run, as Corpus Christi shortstop Grae Kessinger scored on a Frisco (0-1, 36-33) defensive error to take a 1-0 lead. Frisco tied the game in the bottom of the fourth on the Harris home run, his 13th of the season to make Tuesday's score 1-1. Harris is now tied with teammate **Trey Hair** for the most Frisco home runs this season. Hair picked up his 13th long ball two nights ago in an 8-4 loss to Arkansas on Sunday. The RoughRiders scored another unanswered run to take a 2-1 lead in a bottom of the sixth that featured two Hooks defensive errors. Riders center fielder **Josh Stowers** reached on a fielding error on a pop-up by Hooks first baseman Bryan Arias. After Stowers swiped his 14th bag of the year, he scored to give the Riders a 2-1 lead as Frisco catcher **Matt Whatley** bunted his way to first and advanced on a throwing error by the starter Tamarez. Corpus Christi responded in the ensuing inning with a three-run home run from catcher Cesar Salazar to eliminate the Riders advantage and take a 4-2 lead in the top of the seventh. Hooks pitcher Chandler Casey (2-0) struck out four in 2.1 scoreless innings to relieve Tamarez, while Frisco pitcher **Kevin Gowdy** (0-2) finished responsible for two of the three runs on the Hooks go-ahead homer. Frisco right fielder **Kellen Strahm** walked to bring the tying run to the plate in the bottom of the ninth but couldn't generate any more offense to drop their first game of the second half of the season.

WELCOME TO THE SECOND HALF:

Yesterday marked the 70th game of the season and, thus, the second half of the season began. The Riders just missed the playoffs by three games in the first half, with the San Antonio Missions winning the First Half South Division crown in the Texas League. Frisco won seven of its last 10 games to pull close to the Missions, but over that same span, San Antonio has made the biggest difference as San Antonio has gone 15-7 in June, while the Riders have gone just 10-13. In the second half, the RoughRiders will try to win the division to make the playoffs for the first time since 2014. If San Antonio wins both halves, the playoff spot goes to the team with the best overall record (both halves combined) in the division.

VS. THE HOOKS:

In the last series the Riders played against Corpus Christi, a series split, there were 22 combined homers in the six games. **Dustin Harris** led the way with four homers for the Riders while also driving in 10 runs over his five games. **David Garcia** also belted two homers himself. The Riders averaged six runs per game over the six games with a .892 team OPS.

MUST BE THE HAIR:

Trey Hair has been on fire in June. In the month, he is second in the Texas League in home runs with eight, while owning a .623 slugging percentage. Hair's 13 home runs this season are tied with **Dustin Harris** for the most on the RoughRiders and tie a career-high. He hit his career-best 13 last season in 66 games while he has managed 13 in just 45 games this season so far. The 13 long balls from both Hair and Harris are also the most in the organization.

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonathan Ornelas** has been on fire at the plate all season long, but recently, he has been even better. Over his last 14 games, Ornelas is hitting .356 (21-for-59)/.443/.525 with two doubles, a triple, two home runs, nine RBIs and five runs. This season, he leads the Riders with 28 multi-hit games and 13 games with three or more hits. Ornelas is leading all active hitters in Double-A with a .333 batting average while he is first in hits (87). His batting average is tied for the seventh-best in the minors and he is tied for second in hits in MiLB.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Since May 27th, over his last 24 games, Strahm is hitting .375 (30-for-80)/.474/.538 with four doubles, three home runs, 15 walks, 17 runs and seven RBIs. His .375 average since May 27th is the 16th-best in Minor League Baseball among qualifiers. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .261 and his OPS from .528 to .764. In his last 30 games, he is batting .333/.433/.461/.894. Among those with at least 190 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is sixth in walk rate (16.3 percent).

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 4-20 when scoring three runs or fewer and 18-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 70 games, Frisco has hit 94 long balls (1.3 per game) which is the second-most in the Texas League and 13th in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 185 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (topping 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). Out of their 70 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 48 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.0 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 22 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 10-12. **Trey Hair** and **Dustin Harris** have the team lead with 13, tied for seventh in the league.

ABOUT CODY

-Grew up in Aledo, Texas, just an hour away from Frisco. Valedictorian at Aledo High School while helping the baseball team to the state semifinals his junior season (owning a 1.37 ERA) and earning the 2016 All-District 8-5A MVP Pitcher award.

-Grew up a Rangers fan. Derek Holland was his favorite player.

-Married Madi O'Neal (a former softball player at Baylor) on December 15, 2019.

-At Baylor, missed almost his entire final season after being diagnosed with thoracic outlet syndrome, which causes the nerves that pass between the collarbone and first rib to become compressed. He received surgery in March of 2019 before being selected by the Rangers in the June draft. Ranked as a potential second rounder before the injury.

-After FR season at Baylor, spent a lot of time adding good weight to bulk up and it paid off. Following a freshman season in which he went 5-5 with a 5.52 ERA, he turned in a 7-5 season with a 2.38 ERA to earn Big-12 Pitcher of the Year honors.

-Teammates with former Riders infielder Davis Wendzel at Baylor.

2022 SEASON

-Enters season as the Rangers No. 20 prospect.

-Opening Day starter for the RoughRiders (April 8th), exiting in the fifth without allowing a run before both stranded runners scored and were charged to him.

-Allowed career-highs in runs (10) and walks (4) in start on April 22nd against Northwest Arkansas. Gave up a grand slam to former Baylor teammate Nick Loftin in loss.

-Start at Wichita on 5/31 was cut short due to rain that suspended the game with one out in the top of the second inning. Started and went 4.0 IP on Sunday of the series.

2021 SEASON

-The No. 30 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com. Finished the season as a Texas Rangers Organizational All-Star by MLB.com.

-Led Texas farmhands with 128 strikeouts and was tied for second in innings pitched (96.1).

-Started the 2021 season with High-A Hickory, owning a 33.2 percent strikeout rate and a 6.5 percent walk rate.

-On July 22nd, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 14 K against Asheville in a win.

-Whiffed nine over 5.1 innings in Double-A debut against Amarillo on August 5th.

-Struck out 23 before walking a batter over his first three starts with the RoughRiders.

-Seven-inning start against Arkansas on August 18th is the longest start for the RoughRiders on season and also a career-best for Bradford.
