NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies were shutout by the Bowie Baysox, 3-0, at Mirabito Stadium on Thursday night. RHP **Blade Tidwell** was sharp, as he struck out six batters over six innings of one-run ball. His held Bowie scoreless over the first five frames, before allowing a lead off home run to Jud Fabian in the sixth. Brandon McIlwain recorded his sixth multi-hit game. Rowdey Jordan extended his hitting streak to seven games.

LET'S GET ROWDEY: Infielder/outfielder **Rowdey Jordan** hit a single in the ninth inning on Thursday and extended his hitting streak to seven games. Jordan homered in the seventh inning on Tuesday in the series opener against Bowie. Over his seven-game hitting streak, Jordan is hitting .371 (9-for-24) with a 1.066 OPS, two runs batted in, four runs, a homer, two doubles, and four walks. Jordan has recorded a hit in 16 of his last 18 games.

FOREVER YOUNG: Mets infield prospect **Wyatt Young** went 2-for-4 with two singles in the lead off spot on Wednesday against Bowie. Over his last 10 games, Young is hitting .379 (11-for-29) with three runs batted in, three runs scored, seven walks, two hit by pitches, and three stolen bases. The 24-year-old currently ranks T-1st in on-base percentage (.434) and 12th in batting average (.291) among qualified Eastern League hitters. He has recorded a hit in nine of his last 10 games and has reached base in 14 of his last 15 games.

THE KID FROM BROOKLYN: Brooklyn native Jaylen Palmer doubled and walked on Wednesday and has been on a tear over his last four games. He is riding a four-game hitting streak, hitting .400 (4-for-10) with a .600 on-base percentage, a 1.500 OPS, two runs batted in, two doubles, and a home run over that span. Palmer was activated off the injured list on April 29 and has played in six games with Binghamton this season. The 23-year-old grew up in Brooklyn and went to Holy Cross High School in Flushing, which is less than five miles from Citi Field.

ALL'S WELL WITH TIDWELL: Mets No. 2 pitching prospect Blade Tidwell was sharp again on Thursday at Mirabito Stadium. Tidwell allowed just one run on four hits and a walk over six innings with six strikeouts. Tidwell currently ranks 3rd in strikeouts (44), 8th in WHIP (1.07), 9th in ERA (2.41), and T-9th in innings pitched (37.1) among qualified Eastern League pitchers. The 22-year-old has allowed two runs or less in six of his seven outings, has gone at least five innings in four outings, and has recorded at least nine strikeouts three times

THE BOWIE BAYSOX ROSTER: The Bowie Baysox current roster features nine of the Baltimore Orioles top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline: #2 Samuel Basallo (#14 OVR), #7 Dylan Beavers, #10 Seth Johnson, #12 Jud Fabian, #14 Max Wagner, #16 Trace Bright, #23 John Rhodes, #24 Alex Pham and #27 Frederick Bencosme. MLB Pipeline ranked the Baltimore Orioles as the No. 1 farm system in all of baseball for the sixth-straight ranking, dating back to the midseason ranking in 2021. Here's how the rest of the top 5 shaped out: #2 Chicago Cubs, #3 Milwaukee Brewers, #4 San Diego Padres, and #5 Detroit Tigers.
