ON FRIDAY... The Hot Rods dropped the fourth game of the series to the Braves by a score of 6-1. Bowling Green made three errors resulting in three unearned runs. Michael Mercado tied Jayden Murray for the longest outing this year by a Hot Rods starter, going 5.0 innings. He gave up two runs on four hits, walking one and striking out five. The loss bring the Hot Rods to 5-5 on the road and have now dropped three out of their last five games.

ABOUT ROME... Over the last two games, Braves pitching has struck out the Hot Rods offense 28 times. With the win 6-1 on Friday night, Rome has tied Bowling Green for first place in the High-A East South Division. Their two consecutive wins is also the longest active streak in the league, with nobody have more that just one win in their last two games.

FIRST TO DOUBLE-DIGITS... The Hot Rods are the first in the High-A East to reach double digit wins this season. They boast the highest run differential in the league, outscoring their opponents by 28 runs this year. Along with leading the High-A East in the category, they are second among all High-A teams across the country with their 28-run differential, sitting only behind the Everett AquaSox who have put 53 runs between them and their opponents.

KEEPING OPPONENTS QUIET... Despite a loss 2-1 on Thursday night, Hot Rods pitching has held opponents to three or less runs in nine games this season, including four shutouts. Over the nine games, Bowling Green has a record of 8-1. The pitching staff as a unit has recorded 11.34 K/9 so far this season.

SLOW SATURDAYS... Through the six days of the week the Hot Rods play, their worst days at the plate have come on Saturdays. Bowling Greens offense has hit just .143 at the plate through 63 at-bats on Tuesdays. The pitching staff has posted its second highest ERA out of the week on Saturdays with a 5.68.

FRIDAY'S NOTES... Mercado tied Jayden Murray for most innings pitched for a Hot Rods starter with 5.0... Aranda had his fifth multi-hit game of the season... Qsar had his fourth multi-hit game of the season...Hot Rods are 7-3 in games decided by four or more runs... Bowling Green is now 2-1 on Fridays... Until the first inning of tonight's game BG pitching had not allowed an earned run in games played on Fridays... After hitting 19 home runs through 12 games, Bowling Green has been homerless through the first four games against Rome... The Hot Rods offense has struck out 10 or more times in 12 of 16 games this season... That's a K/9 of 12.4 for opposing pitchers...

NOW PITCHING: PEYTON BATTENFIELD... A strong start to the season turned into a weekly award for Battenfield, earning the High-A East Pitcher of the Week. Through his first three appearances, he has struck out 22 batters in 12.0 innings, coming out to a team leading 16.88 K/9. On May 11 against Asheville, Battenfield set his career high for K's in a game, fanning nine Tourtists over 4.0 innings of work. All three of his outings have gone 4.0 innings, with two starts and one relief appearance. The lone showing from the Bullpen was May 16 against Asheville, coming after Tanner Dodson opened the first 2.0 innings of the game.

Ariel Soriano led the team with two RBI and a run scored. He finished 1-4 on the day with a double. Granden Goetzman went 2-4, scoring two runs and helping lead to a 5-0 shutout victory.


