History vs. Beloit

The Nuts are 78-74 all-time vs. the Sky Carp, 36-39 in Lansing and 42-35 in Wisconsin. The Lugnuts did not play Beloit in either 2021 or 2023, going 2-10 vs. the Sky Carp in 2022.

In 2003, the Lugnuts met up with Beloit in the Midwest League Championship Series, sweeping the series in three games. It's the Nuts' most recent of their two titles.

Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, open the second half of Midwest League action with the third game in a five-game series with the Beloit Sky Carp, High-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins. These are the only meetings between the teams this season. Lansing has lost a season high four consecutive games, dropping two over the weekend at home to Cedar Rapids before falling in the first two games of this series. Last night's game was canceled.

Last Game, Wednesday: Sky Carp 2, Lugnuts 0. Josh Zamora delivered a two-run single in the fifth inning off Dylan Hall, one of only three Beloit base hits in the whole game, and the Sky Carp won their second straight contest in the series. Henry Bolte went 1-for-4 with his league-leading 17th double in the losing cause, while Cameron Masterman finished 1-for-4 to extend his hitting streak to nine games.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jaksa on the call.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Sky Carp through Sunday before returning home for a nine straight days at Jackson Field vs. West Michigan and Fort Wayne.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in runs scored (349), total bases (890), doubles (118), triples (28), RBIs (321), on-base percentage (.353), slugging percentage (.408) and OPS (.761), and is tied for 1st in batting average (.261) and 2nd in base hits (569).

A Lineup of Starters: The Lugnuts are expected to use Grant Judkins, Mitch Myers and Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang on the mound today. All three have made starts this season for Lansing, which has used a total of 13 different starting pitchers (and 19 total pitchers).

Streaking: OF Cam Masterman has hit safely in a 2024 team-high nine straight games, while Luke Mann has hit safely in eight straight games. Jonny Butler has reached base in 13 straight games, the team's longest current on-base streak.

The Athletics Connection: Which current Major Leaguer suited up for both Beloit and Lansing on his way up the ladder? The answer is Max Schuemann, who played for the Snappers in 2019 and the Lugnuts in 2021 and is now a member of the Oakland Athletics. Schuemann was one of 17 Beloit Snappers from 2019 to go on to play for Lansing when the A's reaffiliated with the Nuts in 2021. Three years later, he made his Major League debut. (If coaches were included in the question: pitching coach Don Schulze, who pitched in the Major Leagues between 1983 and 1989, was the Beloit pitching coach in 2018 and 2019 and has served as the Lugnuts' pitching coach from 2021-present.)

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 24), southpaw Will Johnston (No. 27) and outfielder Bryan Buelvas (No. 29).

Nothing but Goose Eggs: 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher Grant Holman has pitched 26 1/3 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this season, 19 1/3 with Midland and 7 innings with Las Vegas, the most scoreless innings for any MiLB pitcher. Holman tossed another scoreless frame on Tuesday, fanning two.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: The Lugnuts were no-hit for the second time this season (and there's still one more no-hitter to go before the year ends, unfortunately), falling 14-1 at Bowling Green. The Nuts' only run was scored on a third-inning fielding error by 1B Ryan Dunn. Future MLBer Blake Snell pitched the first three innings for BG, walking five and striking out four, and three relievers took it the rest of the way. Meanwhile, the Hot Rods scored eight in the fourth, piled up 15 hits (four by Dunn) and romped. The final Hot Rods pitcher, Marcus Jensen, who pitched the last 1 1/3 innings and struck out Kevin Patterson to end the game, had no idea that he had completed a no-hitter and did not understand why he and his fellow pitchers were posing for a picture after the game. The Lugnuts scored exactly one run in each game of the three-game series at Bowling Green Ballpark in getting swept.

2019: In his return from the Injured List, Otto Lopez homered off the very first pitch he saw (thus extending a 23-game on-base streak), and the Lugnuts won at Dayton, 4-0, behind six scoreless innings from Troy Watson.

Last Outing: History: On June 13, relieved Jake Garland beginning in the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since 2003.

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball*... he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).
