#### **GAME INFORMATION**

POSTSEASON PONIES: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies clinched a spot in the Eastern League Postseason with the Northeast Division first-half title. It marks' Binghamton's 13th-time reaching the postseason in its 33-year franchise history and the second time in the last three years under fourth-year manager Reid Brignac. Binghamton has won three Eastern League Championships (1992, 1994, 2014) and last reached the Eastern League Championship Series in 2023. NEW YORK METS AFFILIATES: The New York Mets are currently the only organization that has had three affiliates clinch a first-half title and spot in the postseason: Double-A Binghamton (Eastern League Northeast), High-A Brooklyn (South Atlantic League North), and Single-A St. Lucie (Florida State League East). The Detroit Tigers have had two affiliates clinch a first-half title: High-A West Michigan (Midwest League East) and Single-A Lakeland (Florida State League West) with Double-A Erie ahead by 0.5 a game in the Eastern League Southwest with three games left. FIRST PLACE PUNIES: The Rumble Ponies are 43-21 and hold the best winning % in Double-A and 4th-best in MiLB (.672). The Rumble Ponies have been in sole possession of first in the Eastern League's Northeast Division since May 18. Binghamton is 25-6 in its last 32 G. since May 14. LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Harrisburg Senators, 4-2, on Thursday afternoon at FNB Field. DH Nick Lorusso (2-for-4, HR, 2 RBI, R, 2 K) blasted a two-run HR in the first inning, his third HR of the season.

JETT IS TAKING DFF: SS/CF Jett Williams, the Mets No. 1 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 46 overall prospect, is hitting .345 (20-for-58) with a 1.112 OPS, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 14 R, 6 2B, 3 3B, 11 XBH, 3 SB with three three-hit games and seven multi-hit games in 15 games in June. Williams has recorded a hit in 10 of his last 13 games, and is hitting .400 (20-for-50) with a 1.260 OPS, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 13 R, 6 2B, 3 3B, 11 XBH, 7 BB, and 2 SB in that span He was named the Eastern League Player of the Week last week (June 9-15), after he produced a .385 AVG (10-for-26), .467 OBP, .962 SLG, 1.428 OPS, 8 XBH, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 8 R, 3 3B, 2 2B, 4 BB, and 1 SB in six games at Richmond. The 21-year-old ranks among the EL: .402 OBP (4th), .921 OPS (5th), .519 SLG (5th), .298 AVG (6th), 29 XBH (2nd), 108 TB (T-3rd), 5 3B (T-2nd), 18 2B (6th), 62 H (T-7th), 41 R (3rd), 34 BB (T-6th), 19 SB (T-5th).

GOTTA GO MORABITO: OF Nick Morabito, the Mets No. 16 prospect (MLB Pipeline), went 2-for-3, R, BB, K, 2 SB on Thursday, which marked his fourth-straight multi-hit game and extended his hit streak to six games (12-for-29, .414 AVG, 1.054 OPS, 7 RBI, 7 R, 6 2B, 5 SB). In 14 games in June, Morabito is hitting .333 (20-for-60) with 13 RBI, 11 R, 8 2B, 3 BB, 6 SB with eight multi-hit games. The 22-year-old ranks among the Eastern League: 26 SB (1st), 21 2B (T-1st), 67 H (3rd), 26 XBH (T-5th), 38 R (6th), .295 AVG (7th), 101 TB (7th). Morabito has 26 XBH in 60 games this season, after he recorded 26 XBH in 119 games across Single-A. St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn all of last year. PARADA PARTY: C Kevin Parada is on a tear over his last 25 games (26-for-84, .310 AVG, .390 OBP, .607 SLG, .997 OPS, 7 HR, 19 RBI, 16 R, 4 2B, 12 BB, 25 K), after getting off to a slow start over his first 25 games this year (10-for-82, .122 AVG, .375 OPS, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 3 R, 5 BB, 29 K). He upped his season batting average from .122 to .217 and OPS from .375 to .695 over his last 25 games. Since May 16, Parada ranks among Double-A: 7 HR (T-2nd), .607 SLG (4th), .997 OPS (6th) and the Eastern League: 7 HR (T-1st), .607 SLG (2nd), .997 OPS (3rd), 19 RBI (T-7th), 51 TB (7th), .310 AVG (9th). In 13 games in June, Parada is hitting .326 with 1.048 OPS, 4 HR, 11 RBI, and four multi-hit games. BUILT CLIFFORD TOUGH: 1B/OF Ryan Clifford, the Mets No. 6 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is riding a 13game on-base streak (14-for-45, .311 AVG, 1.117 OPS, 4 HR, 10 RBI, 7 R, 4 2B, 8 XBH, 13 BB, 10 K). Clifford ranks 2nd in the Eastern League with 12 HR. In 15 games in June, Clifford has 4 HR (14 H), 10 RBI, 7 R, 14 BB (12 K), .948 OPS. He had a strong May (27 G, .267 AVG, .843 OPS, 5 HR, 20 RBI, 11 R, 14 BB) and ranked T-3rd in the EL in HR (5) & 3rd in RBI (20) in May, after he hit .200 with a .703 OPS, 3 HR, & 9 RBI in April. The 21-year-old ranks among the EL: 12 HR (T-1st), 39 RBI (5th), 40 BB (T-3rd), 100 TB (8th), 24 XBH (9th),

**SMITH ARMY KNIFE:** OF/INF **D'Andre Smith** is riding a five-game hit streak (9-for-22, .409 AVG, .980 OPS, 1 HR, 3 RBI, 1 R, 1 BB, 1 SB with four multi-hit games in that span. In 13 games in June, Smith is hitting .302 with an .860 OPS, 2 HR, 11 RBI, 4 R, 6 XBH, 4 BB, and 3 SB with six multi-hit games.



## 15 REID BRIGNAC

## MANAGER

YEAR WITH BNG: 4th YEAR WITH NYM: 6th HOMETOWN: St. Amant, La.

-Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16).
-In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.
-In 2023, Brignac led Binghamton to the postseason for the first time since 2017, going 39-27 in the second-half and 17-5

in the final 22 games. Binghamton swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the first time since 2014, before falling to the Erie SeaWolves.

-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, Bryce Montes de Oca).
-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School in Louisiana.



## 26 MARIANO DUNCAN BENCH COACH

-Mariano Duncan begins his fourth year as bench coach with the Rumble Ponies and seventh year in the Mets organization. He previously served as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2021 & in the same role with Kingsport in 2019. -Duncan has Major League coaching experience, after serving as the first base coach for the Los Angeles Dodgers for five seasons from 2006-2010. He has spent time on various minor league staffs affiliated with the Dodgers and Chicago Cubs, before joining the Mets organization in 2019.

-The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Dodgers, Cincinnati Reds, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Toronto Blue Jays. He is a two-time World Series champion ('90 Reds and '96 Yankees), one-time All-Star (with Philadelphia in 1994), and was inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008. He made his MLB debut for the Dodgers on April 9, 1985, at the age of 22. Duncan finished third for the 1985 N.L Rookie of the Year.
