Turn It Up to 11... This series marks the 11th time the Hot Rods have played in the postseason since the inaugural season in 2009. It is the fifth time Bowling Green has made the playoffs since rejoining the South Atlantic League in 2021, with 2023 being the only season that they missed. The Hot Rods won South Atlantic League titles in 2024 and 2022, also capturing a crown in 2021 while the league was briefly renamed the High-A East League.

The Drive for Five... With the SAL playoffs beginning, Bowling Green is in search of their fifth league championship in team history. Bowling Green took down Rome and Hudson Valley to claim the crown in 2024. In 2022, the Hot Rods rolled through Rome and Aberdeen for their third championship. The Hot Rods handled the Greensboro Grasshoppers in a five-game series, taking the win 3-2 in the High-A East League in 2021. The first championship in franchise history happened in 2018, winning series against the Lansing Lugnuts, West Michigan Whitecaps, and Peoria Chiefs to win the Midwest League crown.

Second Time Around... Trevor Harrison gets the nod for the series-opening game in Winston-Salem. It will be the second playoff appearance for the right-hander with the Hot Rods. Harrison appeared on September 9, 2025, for Bowling Green against the Hub City Spartanburgers. He tossed 3.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits, walking one and striking out three.

Playoff Experience... The Hot Rods have a handful of players with previous playoff experience. On the hitting side, Ryan Cermak, Carlos Colmenarez, Jhon Diaz, Nathan Flewelling, and Narciso Polanco have all appeared in at least one playoff game in their Minor League career. Noah Beal, Garrett Gainey, Trevor Harrison, and Jackson Lancaster headline the playoff experience for the pitchers.

Hello Again... The Hot Rods just finished a six-game series with the Dash on August 30. Overall this season, Bowling Green played 12 games across three series against Winston-Salem. The Hot Rods took the season-series 8-4, splitting the final series of the season. Each of the first two meetings between the teams consisted of three-game series with the Hot Rods taking the first 2-1 and the second 3-0.
