SO, THAT'S WHAT IT FEELS LIKE: The Omaha Storm Chasers fell behind 8-0 through the first three innings after the Louisville Bats plated eight runs on nine hits against left-hander **Marcelo Martinez**, who was making his Triple-A debut, and ultimately fell, 12-2. It was the most lopsided home loss of the season for Omaha, and just the fifth home loss of the season. The Chasers scored their two runs in the fourth on a solo home run by **INF Emmanuel Rivera** and an RBI single by **OF Bubba Starling**.

UNFAMILIAR FEELING: The Chasers 12-2 loss on Saturday marked the first loss by 10+ runs since May 20, when Omaha fell to Iowa, 16-1, in a day game at Principal Park. It was also the fourth time this season Omaha allowed 10+ runs, all losses. It was just the second time this season—including May 20—that Omaha has trailed by 8+ runs at any point in a game. Omaha has trailed by four runs or more in a game just six times this season—5/5 vs. STP, 5/20 @ IOW, 5/21 @ IOW, 5/26 vs. IND, 6/16 vs. LOU, 6/19 vs. LOU. Omaha has only lost back-to-back games once this season on 5/20 and 5/21 @ IOW, winning 20 of their last 25 games since. The Chasers are 6-0 in Sunday games this season.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 28-11 (.700), the Omaha Storm Chasers have the second-best record in Minor League Baseball, trailing Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (27-11, .711), which play in the Triple-A East Northeast Division. Omaha's 28 wins are tied for the most in MiLB with San Jose (Low-A, SFG) and Tampa (Low-A, NYY). Omaha leads the Triple-A East Midwest Division by 6.0 games, which is the second-largest divisional lead in all of baseball.

HOME RUN HEROES: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and all of Minor League Baseball with 81 home runs (40 games), including 20 home runs in the last five games. The Chasers have three games with at least five home runs this week, including a seven-homer game on 6/13 @ STP that set a modern franchise record (2011-present). The Chasers' 81 home runs are also more than 12 Major League teams. Omaha has recorded at least one home run in 26 of its last 28 games—including a 13-game homer streak from 5/16-6/1—and has recorded 19 multi-homer games, including three-four homer games, five five-homer games, and one seven-homer game. **INF Ryan McBroom** currently leads the league with 13 home runs, **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** and **INF Emmanuel Rivera** are second with 12, and **INF Gabriel Cancel** is tied for sixth in the league with 10. Omaha is the only team in Minor League Baseball with four players with 10+ home runs.

RED HOT RIVERA: **INF Emmanuel Rivera** has homered in four of the five games this week against Louisville, batting .474 (9-for-19) with one double, four home runs, and seven RBIs. Rivera has hit safely in a season-high seven straight games, batting .444 (12-for-27) in that span with a .500 on-base percentage. His 12 home runs on the season are tied for second in the league while his 35 RBIs are tied for first in the league with Durham's Wander Franco.

MEIBRYS MAGIC: **C Meibry Vitoria** leads the team and is tied for fifth in Triple-A East with a .410 on-base percentage. Vitoria is currently in the midst of a 15-game on-base streak (5/29-pres.) after beginning the season with a 14-game on-base streak from 5/4-5/27. Overall, Vitoria has reached base in 29 of the 30 games he's played this season. The only time he was kept off base was on 5/27 vs. IND, when he went 0-for-4. Vitoria also leads the team with 18 walks.

OLIVARES ON TOP: **OF Edward Olivares** has been recalled by Kansas City and optioned to Triple-A Omaha three times in the last three weeks. He was initially recalled on 5/30, then optioned on 6/3, recalled again on 6/6, optioned again on 6/9, recalled once more on 6/14, and optioned back to Omaha on 6/17. Despite playing only five games with the Chasers in June, Olivares still qualifies for the Triple-A East league leaderboards and ranks first in average (.370), second in on-base percentage (.447), and eighth in slugging (.593). In seven total games with Kansas City, Olivares has gone 6-for-23 (.292) with three runs scored and a stolen base.

RYAN ON A RAMPAGE: **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** is 7-for-18 (.389) with two home runs, two doubles, and four RBIs in five games against Louisville, following up a 9-for-21 (.429) week with five home runs and nine RBIs in five games against St. Paul that earned him Triple-A East Player of the Week honors. Since joining the Chasers on May 28, O'Hearn is batting .371 (26-for-70) with 12 home runs and 25 RBIs, reaching base safely in 17 of 18 games and hitting safely in 15 of 18. In 16 games in June, O'Hearn is batting .381 (24-for-63) with all 12 of his home runs.

FOR OMAHA: **LHP Daniel Lynch** makes his sixth start (seventh appearance) of the season and his second of the series. He held Louisville to one run on six hits in 5.2 innings—tying his season-high—recording three strikeouts while walking one in an eventual 11-5 win. Lynch has 31 strikeouts and four walks in 31.1 innings with Omaha. He's recorded no more than four strikeouts in each of his last three starts while tallying at least six in each of his first three outings. Lynch played collegiately at the University of Virginia, which plays in the College World Series this afternoon against Tennessee, from 2016-2018, striking out 105 in 88.2 innings in his junior season in 2018.

FOR LOUISVILLE: **RHP Bo Takahashi** makes his eighth start of the season and second of the series, his first time making two starts in one series this season. He allowed seven runs on nine hits—including two home runs—in 4.0 innings. Takahashi has allowed six home runs in 13.0 innings across three starts in June.
