TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque tied the series last night at a game a piece after a 17-2 victory ... Lefty Carson Palmquist is scheduled to make his 2025 season debut today while Farmington, NM, native Seth Silseth is expected to take the hill for Salt I ake

RUNS A PLENTY: Albuquerque's 17 runs last night are the most since the club also scored 17 runs on August 11, 2024, vs. Sacramento (a 2024 season-high).

BIG INNING: The Isotopes plated eight runs in the fifth inning yesterday, the most in a frame since June 13, 2024, vs. El Paso when the team scored nine in the fourth inning (season-high).

BASE KNOCKS: Albuquerque compiled 18 total hits last night, the most since also tallying 18 on August 14, 2024, at Round Rock

**XBH**: The Isotopes registered seven extra-base hits last night. Coming into the game, the club had recorded seven extra-base hits over the first four games of the season.

AIN'T LIFE GRAND: Aaron Schunk swatted the Isotopes first grand slam of the season in the fifth frame last night. In 2024, Albuquerque did not hit their first grand slam until July 13 vs. Tacoma (Jimmy Herron).

B2B: Schunk and Braxton Fulford hit back-to-back homers in the fifth inning yesterday, the club's first set of back-to-back homers on the year (last: Greg Jones and Zac Veen, September 3, 2024, at Tacoma).

**KEEP 'EM COMIN**': The Isotopes plated runs in the first three frames (five total runs) of the game last night, the first time the club has scored in three-straight innings since August 31, 2024, vs. Reno.

DOWN UNDER: Starter Jack O'Loughlin earned the win yesterday after tossing 5.0 shutout frames. He allowed just three hits and one walk with three punchouts. He's the first Isotope starter to earn a win on the year. The last Albuquerque starter to not allow a run over 5.0+ frames was Peyton Battenfield on September 19, 2024, at Reno (6.0 IP).

YF: Yanquiel Fernandez ended his four-game hitless streak with two hits last night, including a double.

MILLER TIME: Owen Miller connected on his first homer of the season yesterday, a solo shot. He also tallied an RBI single for his first multi-hit game of the year.

VEEN: Last night, Zac Veen registered four RBI, tying a career-high (other: April 13, 2024, vs. Bowie), and his second multi-hit contest of the year after swatting a single and the team's first triple of the season. He also extended his hit streak to five games. He is one of eight Triple-A players to have a hit in every game this the season.

**BITTER**. Byan Bitter tied a career-high with four hits last night (three times; last: May 28, 2024, vs. Reading), including a double and his second homer of the year. He has a hit in three-straight games (7x13).

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk went 2-for-5 with a grand slam and a single yesterday, ending his 0-for-7 slump over his first two games of the year. It's Schunk's third grand slam with the lsotopes (others: May 3, 2023, vs. SUG and May 21, 2023, vs. TAC).

KEST DADDY: Keston Hiura collected his first two hits of the season last night, both singles. He also walked and drove in a run.

AMADOR: Adael Amador recorded his second multi-hit game of the season yesterday with two singles. He has a hit in three of the four contests he's played.

**FULFORD**: Braxton Fulford blasted a solo homer in the fifth frame last night, his first dinger of the season and second at Triple-A (other: September, 22, 2023, vs. Oklahoma City).

APRIL 3: The Isotopes will play just their third game in club history on April 3 today (also: 2024 and 2003, the club's first game in franchise history)

HITTING COACH: Jordan Pacheco, entering his fourth season with the club, is the longest tenured Isotopes hitting coach, surpassing Steve Phillips (2006-08).

SALT LAKE TIES: Bees right-handed pitcher Dakota Hudson pithed for the Isotopes in 2024 ... Salt Lake right-hander Chase Silseth hails from Farmington and was named Gatorade New Mexico Player of the Year in 2018 after his senior year at Piedra Vista High School ... Isotopes infielder Keston Hiura played in 37 games for the Bees last season, blasting 20 home runs with 42 RBI.

## NUCLEI NOTES

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID**: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

**CHRIS MICHALAK**: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

**MICHAEL RYAN**: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

**SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT**: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
