WOOD WOULD

C MATTHEW WOOD extended his hit streak to 7 consecutive games on Friday... During the streak, Wood is 15-for-27 (.556) with 3 doubles, 2 home runs and 6 RBI.

☞ Wood enters today among the Southern League leaders in OPS (3rd, .909), on-base percentage (3rd, .404), walks (T-6th, 46) and slugging percentage (7th, .505).

☞ Since May 1 (45g), Wood owns a .287/.422/.545 slash line, a .968 OPS, 153 wRC+ and more walks (32) than strikeouts (21).

☞ Wood's 12 home runs are tied for the 3rd-most by a Brewers Double-A catcher this century (since 2000).

I'M A BOEVE-LIEVER

Entering today, **1B/3B/OF MIKE BOEVE** has reached base in 27 of his last 28 games, including a hit in 20 of his last 22 and 4 straight... Since May 1, Boeve owns a .337/.405/.487 slash line with an .893 OPS, 12 doubles and 6 home runs.

☞ Boeve enters today among the Southern League leaders in hits (T-2nd, 85), average (4th, .299) and on-base percentage (6th, .386).

A PERFECT 10

RHP JARON DeBERRY recorded his 2nd consecutive 10+ strikeout start on Thursday with a career-high 11 over 7.0 innings... DeBerry is the 4th pitcher in Shuckers franchise history with 10+ strikeouts in back-to-back starts and the 1st to achieve the feat since **RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI** in 2024.

MADE FOR THE GRAND MOMENT

SS JESÚS MADE recorded his 2nd career grand slam, and 1st in Double-A, on Thursday night... Entering today, Made is 7-for-18 with the bases loaded this season... Made enters today among the Southern League leaders in RBI (2nd, 58), hits (2nd, 85), triples (3rd, 5) and average (9th, .280).

☞ With the grand slam, Made (19y-62d) became the 1st teenager to record a grand slam in Double-A since **3B ISSAC PARADES** (ERI) on July 25, 2018.

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... Guerrero needs 11 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,489 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.
