Reading fell in a slugfest 10-8 to Binghamton Tuesday night. Johan Rojas and Matthew Kroon each had four hits, while Nick Podkul and Cam Cannon both chipped in two. Jose Alvarado struggled in his lone inning of work and Matt Seelinger stayed dominant in the seventh.

Dueling Superfectas

Johan Rojas and Matthew Kroon each had four hits last night, marking the first time two R-Phils have had four-or-more hits in a game since Dylan Cozens and Jake Fox did it on June 2, 2016 at the Portland Sea Dogs.

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as perhaps the best defensive centerfielder in Minor League Baseball. Rojas has 14 defensive runs saves so far this season, while no other MiLB center fielder has more than seven. To compare, the leaders in MLB have 10 in 2023.

With a hit Tuesday night, Carlos De La Cruz has now reached base in 22-straight games, surpassing Logan O'Hoppe's 21-game mark in 2022. De La Cruz also owns a 13-game hitting streak, in which he's hitting .302 over that span. McCarthy Tatum has also reached base in 14-straight games. Nick Podkul has two more hits last night, and has now reached base in 22-of-23 games he's played in so far in 2023.

Bullpen Blues

This week's series features the two bullpens with the highest ERA in the Eastern League. Reading enters tonight ranked 11th with a 5.53 ERA, and Binghamton is 12th with a 5.56 ERA. In wins this season, Reading bullpen has a 2.53 ERA, but in losses, that number rises 7.61. Tuesday night, both teams' bullpens combined to allow eight-earned runs over seven innings pitched.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies were also postponned last night due to poor air quality in Philadelphia. The Phillies and Tigers are scheduled to complete their series tonight at 6. Lehigh Valley was postponned for the second-straight night at Syracuse due to poor air quality. Jersey Shore made it four teams in the orgniazation to also not play last night. Finally, Clearwater did play and beat Fort Myers 7-2 to improve to 38-14 on the season and inch very close to a first-half title.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 8, 2013: At Reading, Carlos Zambrano, recently signed and trying to make a comeback with Philadelphia, picks up the win as the Fightin Phils beat Harrisburg, 2-1, in game 2 of a doubleheader. Zambrano goes 6.0 innings, allowing one earned run on three hits and three walks while striking out seven.

Ponies Rumbling into Reading

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Binghamton. The Rumble Ponies sit in fourth in the Northeast standings, fourgames ahead of Reading. The Ponies entered the series losers of five straight since winning game one at Altoona next week. After this week, Binghamton returns home to welcome Portland after finishing off a 12-game road trip.

Ponies Pitcher

Righty Jose Chacin gets the start tonight for Binghamton. After starting the season at triple-A Syracuse, he has been with Binghamton since Apr. 12. Overall, Chacin is 0-2 with a 5.13 ERA over 10 games and seven starts. At Altoona last Wednesday, he went 5.1 innings, and allowed three runs on six hits, with three walks and three strikeouts. He signed with the Mets im 2015 as an international free agent.
