**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Reading Fightin Phils, 4-1. Reading opened a 2-0 lead in the third inning. Aquimedes Gamboa hit an RBI double and later scored on a single by Jhailyn Ortiz. In the fifth, Jack Conley extended the lead to 3-0 with an RBI double. Richmond broke the shutout in the bottom of the sixth with a solo homer by **Frankie Tostado**, his tenth of the season. Reading plated a fourth run in the top of the ninth with an RBI single by Grenny Cumana. Reading starter Jack Perkins allowed one run over 5.2 innings to pick up his third win. Richmond starter **Trenton Toplikar** tied a career high with 7.0 innings of work and allowed three runs with no walks and four strikeouts. Former George Mason pitcher Brian Marconi worked the final six outs with three strikeouts to pick up his eighth save of the season.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the only trip to Richmond this season for Reading. The Flying Squirrels won five-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium when the teams previous met from May 25-30.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost 11 of the last 13 games after winning 12 of the previous 16 to close within one game of first place in the division. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 9.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .234 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.92 ERA for the season.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS** have lost four of their last five and 15 of their last 20 games. Reading's offense is ranked 11th in the Double-A Northeast with a .228 batting average and are tied for third with 91 home runs. Reading's pitching staff is ranked 10th in the league with a 5.06 ERA. Reading's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including SS Bryson Stott (No. 2), RHP Francisco Morales (No. 3), RHP Hans Crouse (No. 4), OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 21), LHP Kyle Dohy (No. 24) and RHP James McArthur (No. 28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Aaron Blair** makes his third start for the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he worked three scoreless innings last Friday against the Baysox, working around three hits, two walks and one hit batter by inducing three double plays. He made his Richmond debut in Akron on July 24 and allowed three runs in 2.0 innings of work. He pitched through the first 2.0 innings without allowing a run before surrendering three walks in the third with no outs. Blair began the season with the independent West Virginia Power and had his contract selected by the San Francisco Giants on July 23. He made his first start of the year on May 29 against Southern Maryland, picking up a win after allowing one run over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts. He began a start on June 3 against Long Island but left in the first inning with an injury before the game was suspended for rain. Blair was the 36th-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks out of Marshall University, the highest draft pick in the school's history. He was traded to the Atlanta Braves in December 2015 along with Dansby Swanson and Ender Inciarte for pitchers Shelby Miller and Gabe Speier. Blair reached the majors for the first time in 2016 with the Braves. He missed most of the 2018 season and all of 2019 after undergoing shoulder surgery. He signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2020 but was released in May after the MiLB season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **For more on Blair, see page two.**

**FOR READING:** Right-hander James McArthur makes his 10th start of the season and 14th overall appearance. He most recently pitched last Thursday against Somerset and worked 4.0 scoreless innings. It was his second straight scoreless appearance, totaling 7.0 innings of work. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels on May 29 in Reading and allowed a season-high-tying five runs over 2.2 innings in a loss. McArthur was drafted by the Phillies in the 12th round in 2018 out of Ole Miss. His father, Gregory, played four seasons in the Baltimore Orioles organization from 1978-1982.

**TAKE A WALK:** In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Minicuzzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 25 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 105 walks, which sits him tied for second in the team's history in career walks with **Jarrett Parker**. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

**POWER SURGE:** This season, the Flying Squirrels rank ninth in the circuit with 83 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 125 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .386 slugging percentage, which is 11th in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Surpassing a .382 mark from 2013). Richmond's 83 home runs this season is a higher total than the entire 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!:** Over his last 13 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .310 (13-for-42) with four homers, four doubles, one triple and 13 RBIs. He homered in three consecutive games from July 17-20 and added a fourth on July 29 against Bowie. Rincones has picked up two hits in both games against Reading this week, including three doubles.

**SWINGING FOR THE VINCE:** In his last 24 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .307 (27-for-88) with six home runs, five doubles and 20 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 13 homers this season and second with 36 RBIs. He is hitting .170 (8-for-47) over his last 12 games since July 18 with 20 strikeouts.

**SIMON SAYS:** **Simon Whiteman** is batting .349 (22-for-63) over his last 17 games since July 15 with six doubles, one homer and six RBIs. Whiteman leads the team with 13 stolen bases this season, which is tied for fifth in the Double-A Northeast. For the year, Whiteman has picked up a total of 30 steals in 33 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season. Over his last three games, Whiteman played the center field for the first time in his professional career.

**TORRES ON A TEAR:** **Bryan Torres** is currently riding a 12-game hitting streak dating back to July 3, which is the longest hit streak for any player on the Flying Squirrels this season. During that span, Torres is batting .378 (17-for-45) with two doubles, a triple and seven RBIs. He has picked up two hits in four of his last seven games played. Torres has also collected four RBIs in his last four games. He is batting .298 this season in 33 games, which would be the highest average of his professional career. Torres is playing his first season at the Double-A level after previously topping out at the rookie level before 2021.

**LEFT ON BASE:** Over the last 13 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .136 (15-for-110) with runners in scoring position and have left 116 runners on base. For the year, Richmond has hit .133 (8-for-60) with the bases loaded, which is the second-lowest mark of the 120 full-season minor league teams this year.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for seventh with 49 RBIs. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for fifth with 13 stolen bases. **Joey Marciano** (28/T-4th), **Frank Rubio** (27/T-6th), **Patrick Ruotolo** (27/T-6th) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (27/T-6th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **RJ Dabovich** is tied for sixth in the league with six saves. **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for ninth in the circuit with five saves. **Sean Hjelle** is ranked second with a 3.15 ERA, eighth with 69 strikeouts, tied for fifth with 14 starts, tied for ninth with 65.2 innings pitched, tied for fifth with a .241 BAA, fifth with a 1.20 WHIP and sixth with a .600 winning percentage.

**FREE FALLING:** The Flying Squirrels have lost 11 of the last 13 games since July 21. On August 1, their record dropped .500 for the first time since May 5 (1-1). In that span, Richmond has been outscored 60-40. Four of the losses have been by one run and three have been by two runs. Prior to this stretch, the Flying Squirrels were tied for second place in the Southwest Division, one game behind first-place Akron. The team has fallen back to fifth and is now nine games back.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13 - on IL) and **Sean Hjelle** (14). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baseline" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Three players, including Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
