TODAY'S GAMES: Winners of back-to-back games, the Sugar Land carries on their six-game series against the Isotopes... This continues a stretch where the Space Cowboys play 13 games in 13 days... Sugar Land is 4-6 on the road trip so far.

ABOUT THURSDAY NIGHT: Jairo Solis allowed a two-run homer to the second batter of the game, but then retired 9 straight hitters and 17 of the last 20 he faced, surrendering just one more hit, a walk and a hit batter while striking out 7... Shay Whitcomb hit a go-ahead three-run homer in the third, David Hensley added a two-run double in the 4th and Quincy Hamilton homered in the 7th to put the Space Cowboys up 6-2... RHP Austin Hansen hurled the final three frames, giving up just one run while locking down the save.

ROSTER MOVES: C César Salazar recalled by Houston... RHP Jimmy Endersby reinstated from the Development List... RHP Cesar Gomez transferred to Corpus Christi.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 12 players drafted by the Astros, 4 international signings and 2 player signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys roster boasts eight of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include C Corey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), RHP Misael Tamrez (#11), INF Joe Perez (#14), RHP Forrest Whitley (#19), OF Quincy Hamilton (#22) & RHP Shawn Dubin (#23)

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 3-5-0 in six-game series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-0 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 2-0-0 in their last two home series and 2-2-0 overall at Constellation Field.

BEGINNING WITH A BANG: Bligh Madris hit a lead-off home run on the very first pitch on 6/2, his sixth overall homer of the season... It was the fourth lead-off home run this year by Madris, who has hit in the lead-off spot 28 total times for the Space Cowboys. His lead-off home runs have come on the first pitch three times with the other coming on the second pitch of the game. When hitting in the lead-off spot this year, Madris is slashing .282/.397/.530/.927 with 5 doubles, 3 triples, 6 home runs, 19 RBI and 21 walks.

ON THE RECORD: RHP Joe Record has made 11 straight outings without allowing an earned run, tossing a perfect ninth to secure the his seventh save on Wednesday night... In the month of May, Record made 13 appearances, giving up just 2 earned runs in 13.2 innings, converting 6 of 7 saves in that span... His seven saves are tied for the second most in the PCL this year, and Record is tied for third in the Pacific Coast League in appearances with 23.

LEE-DING THE WAY: After notching 10 doubles in May, Corey Lee has already collected three doubles in June, giving him 16 for the season, tied for the second most in the PCL.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high in MiLB.

GOING IN FRONT IN GRAND FASHION: On 5/13, for the second time in 8 games, the Space Cowboys hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning, with Rylan Bannon launching a grand slam. The grand slam capped a six-run frame and helped finish a comeback from 4-1 down to win 7-5... Justin Dirden delivered the other go-ahead grand slam on Friday, 5/5 @ ABQ, part of a 7-run frame that pushed the Space Cowboys over the top after trailing 8-2 going to the seventh.

BIRTHDAY LAUNCHING POINT: Outfielder Pedro Leon turned 25 on 5/28 and celebrated by blasting a solo home run... Since his birthday bomb, Leon has hit safely in seven of his last eight games, slashing .357/.400/.929/1.329 with a double, 5 home runs and 9 RBI... He's homered in five of his last eight games and four of his last five.

WHAT'S YOUR NAME, MAN?: In his Triple-A debut on Wednesday night, Quincy Hamilton homered in each of his first two times up, launching an opposite-field homer to left in the 2nd and a solo home run to right in the 4th... It's the second multi-home run game of his career for Hamilton, with his other coming on July 15, 2022 while with High-A Asheville... Hamilton provided an encore on Thursday night, hitting a solo home run in the 7th inning, giving him three homers in two games... Including his final game with Double-A Corpus, Hamilton has homered in three straight games and has homered in five of his last eight contests.

WHIFFS ON WHIFFS ON WHIFFS: RHP Misael Tamarez generated an impressive 18 swings and misses on Wednesday night against Albuquerque, the most swings and misses in Triple-A on Wednesday night... The right-hander effectively used his slider, hurling 43 of them and getting 14 whiffs on 24 total swings against his slider, throwing it for strikes 68% of the time... Jairo Solis followed on Thursday night by also generating 18 swings and misses, the second most in Triple-A on Thursday, getting 10 whiffs on his slider and 6 swing and misses on just 10 total curveballs... In their first three games, Sugar Land pitching has walked just 8 batters, the fewest in the PCL in that span, while striking out 27 hitters.

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee - 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On Tuesday, 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at sspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- **Horizon Gradient:** Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms. The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon
- **Mission Patch:** This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

His inherited runner scored as part of an 11-run inning for Round Rock.

WELCOME TO THE 'STROS: Signed by the Astros as a free agent on May 8 and assigned to Sugar Land... Had elected free agency following the 2021 season, did not pitch in 2022.

QUITE AN IMPRESSION: Was the opening day starter for the Staten Island FerryHawks of the independent Atlantic League on April 28, 2023 against the Charleston Dirty Birds... Threw 5.0 hitless innings, allowing just one base runner on a hit-by-pitch.... Struck out 11 on 67 pitches, 49 strikes.

IN THE CARDS: Owner of "World Champion Sports Cards." Helped organize the first ever Palm Beach Card Show at the Palm Beach Convention Center in January of 2023.

WITH THE NATIONALS: Has made 48 career appearances, two starts, at the Major League level... Amassed a career ERA of 5.98 with two holds and two save in two save chances... Across 64.2 innings with Washington, walked 28 and struck out 77, holding opponents to a .231 batting average against.

DEBUT SZN: Made his Major League debut with the Nationals on September 5, 2018... Appeared in five games, one start, going 0-0, 5.87 ERA in 7.2 innings.

MR. MCGOWIN GOES TO WASHINGTON: Traded from the Angels to the Nationals, along with RHP Austin Adams, in exchange for 2B Danny Espinosa on 12/10/2016... At the time of the trade, was rated as the #20 prospect in the Angels organization by MLB.com

PCL PRIOR EXPERIENCE: Made 22 starts with the Salt Lake Bees in 2016, going 6-12 with a 6.11 ERA, hurling 116.1 innings.... Also made 11 starts for Triple-A Fresno in 2019, going 7-2 with a 3.86 ERA.
