**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 4-3, in 10 innings. Joseph Rosa won the game with a walk-off single in the 10th inning after entering as a pinch hitter. Richmond took a 1-0 lead in the third with an RBI single by **Vaun Brown.** In the bottom of the inning, Cesar Prieto tied the game with a run-scoring single. Bowie took a 3-1 lead in the fifth with a two-run homer by Coby Mayo, his third straight game with a home run. **Brandon Martorano** tied the game, 3-3, with a two-run homer in the top of the seventh inning. **Landen Roupp** started the game and allowed one run over four innings. **Juan Sanchez** entered with the bases loaded and one out in the bottom of the eighth and escaped the jam without surrendering a run. He ended up working 2.2 scoreless innings on the night. Richmond batters struck out 15 times, including 10 over 5.2 innings by Baysox starting pitcher Chayce McDermott.

**TŪDAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale game of a six-day, seven-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today is the 12th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-1 at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29. The Sunday finale of that series was rained out. The Baysox will come to The Diamond for six-game sets from July 4-9 and August 8-13.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** were 14-7 through their first 21 games but are 13-28 since May 3. For the year, Richmond starters have thrown 222.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 310.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.33 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and is eighth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

**THE BAYSOX** are in fifth place in the Southwest Division but have won nine-of-12, including five-of-six last week in Erie and four-of-six in this week's series. Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including INF Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), INF Cesar Prireto (No. 16), RHP Justin Armbruester (No. 22) and OF John Rhodes (No. 26). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including Mayo (No. 8), Povich (No. 11), Prieto (No. 16), McDermott (No. 17), Rhodes (No. 19) and Armbruester (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Wil Jensen makes his first start of the season. He has pitched out of the bullpen 14 times this year, including two previous outings against the Baysox in Bowie. On April 25, he worked three scoreless innings and allowed one hit. Jensen pitched out of the bullpen in the second game on Wednesday's doubleheader and picked up a win, allowing one run, a solo homer by Billy Cook in the seventh, over three innings. This year, Jensen ranks eighth among Eastern League pitchers (min. 35 IP) n strikeout percentage (29.1) and ninth in ERA (2.97). He is also tied for third in the league and leads the team in wins (5). Jensen is tied with Bowie pitcher Connor Gillispie for the most relief innings pitched (36.1) in the league this season. Last year, he reached Double-A in mid-July and went on to pitched eight games (five starts) for Richmond, going 2-2 with a 4.91 ERA. Jensen was signed by the Giants as a free agent from Pepperdine University in 2020. For more on Jensen, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Carlos Tavera makes his seventh start of the season, his 12th overall appearance and his third start against the Flying Squirrels. He started the opener of the series on Tuesday and surrendered four runs over three innings with five strikeouts. He also issued four walks for the second consecutive start. He also faced the Flying Squirrels on April 26 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed a season-high five runs over 2.2 innings. Tavera was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Orioles out of UT-Arlington. This year marks his first season at the Double-A level. Tavera was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on May 28 after throwing five hitless innings at Akron on May 26.

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** Andy Thomas hit his sixth homer of the season on Friday night against the Baysox, a two-run shot in the first inning to give the Flying Squirrels an early lead. It was his second straight home run that gave the Flying Squirrels a lead. His last longball before Friday was a three-run shot on June 2 against the SeaWolves at The Diamond to move the Flying Squirrels ahead, 5-3. They went on to win that game, 6-5, with a ninth-inning walk-off.

**ILDVE LUC!:** Last Saturday night, **Marco Luciano** hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon and added a 432-foot, opposite-field two-run shot on Wednesday at Bowie. Since he began his season with his Double-A debut on May 3, his nine home runs are tied for the seventh-most in the Eastern League. He leads all Richmond hitters in home runs for the year. Luciano went on a five-game hit streak from June 10-14, during which he hit .588 (10-for-17) with four homers, a double, five walks and 10 RBIs. Since then, he has gone 0-for-9 in his last two games.

**ALRIGHT, ALDRETE:** Carter Aldrete homered in each of the first two games in this week's series at Bowie. On Tuesday, he hit a solo shot in the third inning. In the first game of Wednesday's doubleheader, he clubbed a solo homer in the fourth. Since his promotion to Double-A on July 23, 2022, Aldrete has the most home runs (14), RBIs (52), hits (82), doubles (19) and extra-base hits (33) of any Flying Squirrels player. His eight homers this year are tied for second-most on the team.

WELCOME BACK, WADE: Wade Meckler was reinstated from the injured list last Saturday after missing 12 games. In his five games back from the IL, he has reached base 10 times (six hits and four walks). In his first game back, he reached base three times with two walks and a two-run double. He went 3-for-5 with a double on Saturday night. For the year, Meckler leads all minor league hitters (min. 120 PA) in batting average (.410). He has picked up 14 hits and seven walks in his 11 Double-A games since being promoted from High-A Eugene on May 17.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Hayden Cantrelle is ninth in OBP (.391). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for third in triples (3). Carson Seymour is ninth in ERA (3.26) and 10th in WHIP (1.23). Kai-Wei Teng is sixth in strikeouts (68).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is first in batting average (.358), sixth in OBP (.402), ninth in OPS .871), first in hits (81) and tied for sixth in total bases (106). Coby Mayo is tied for eighth in home runs (11), third in OBP (.413), fourth in SLG (.563), third in OPS (.976), tied for seventh in hits (62), first in doubles (21), tied for first in extra-base hits (34) and fourth in total bases (120). John Rhodes is tied for third in triples (3).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Two former Flying Squirrels players have made their MLB debuts for the San Francisco Giants this week. On Tuesday, Keaton Winn pitched in St. Louis and allowed one run over four innings in the Giants' 11-3 win, becoming the first Giants player in franchise history to pick up a save in his debut. Last season, Winn joined the Flying Squirrels in mid-August and went 2-3 with a 4.15 ERA in six starts to close the regular season. On Wednesday, Luis Matos made his major league debut against the Cardinals and went 1-for-3. He was on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster this year and .304 with three homers in 31 games before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on May 17. On the year, six former Flying Squirrels have made their MLB debuts, all with the Giants, including Tristan Beck (2021-22 Flying Squirrels), Casey Schmitt (2022), Patrick Bailey (2023) and Ryan Walker (2021-22). On Wednesday, Matos became the 90th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the big leagues.
