# LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their Friday night contest with the Akron RubberDucks by an 8-6 final. After a 68-minute rain delay pushed back the start time, both lineups found their groove quite quickly. Bowie struck for four home runs on the night, including a career-high three from John Rhodes. Both Rhodes and Billy Cook launched solo shots in what was a three-run first inning for the Baysox. However, Akron would bounce back in the middle frames, as the RubberDucks tied the game at four in the third after an RBI double from Jonathon Rodriguez and a two-run blast from Juan Brito. Bowie retook the lead on Rhodes' second solo shot of the night in the bottom half. The RubberDucks would tie the game once again on a solo home run from Rodriguez in the fifth, and then take the lead for good in the sixth on an RBI single from Angel Martinez and a fielder's choice for the third RBI of the night for Rodriguez. Rhodes' third homer of the evening made it a one-run game in the seventh, but a late sacrifice fly RBI from Aaron Bracho gave Akron all the cushion it needed in the victory.

# TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron RubberDucks enter this weekend with a 43-39 overall record - 8-5 in the second half - tied with Richmond for first in the Southwest division second-half standings. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, Akron holds the third-best ERA (3.76) in the Eastern League this season, but has also committed the third-most errors (78), while hitting the fewest home runs (60) through 82 games. The RubberDucks' active roster is headlined by six of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, including IF Angel Martinez (No. 7 CLE), OF Petey Halpin (No. 13 CLE), IF Juan Brito (No. 14 CLE), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 18 CLE), IF Jose Tena (No. 19 CLE), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 26 CLE) and RHP Jack Leftwich (No. 28 CLE).

# TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Southpaw Doug Nikhazy is set to receive the ball for Akron tonight. The No. 26 prospect in the Guardians' system, per MLB Pipeline, Nikhazy has a staff-high 80 strikeouts through 62.1 innings this season, but also leads the staff with 44 walks. Nikhazy is coming off 4.2 innings where he allowed two runs on three hits against Harrisburg on Thursday, July 6. The left-hander has faced Bowie twice this season, tossing three shutout innings at Prince George's Stadium, yielding just one hit, on 4/12, before allowing five runs (three earned) on seven hits through 5.2 innings in Akron on 5/24. A 2021 second round pick of Cleveland, out of Ole Miss, Nikhazy pairs a low-90s fastball with a big, mid-70s curveball, and a mid-80s slider/cutter hybrid

# HAPPY HOLLIDAY

This weekend marks the Double-A debut for the No. 1 overall prospect in baseball, per MLB Pipeline, Jackson Holliday. Last year's No. 1 overall draft pick has soared through the Orioles' system. Entering this weekend, Holliday ranks top five in the system with a .331 average (2nd), .466 on-base percentage (1st), .523 slugging percentage (5th), .989 OPS (3rd), six triples (1st), and 64 walks (1st). Holliday's walk total and on-base percentage also rank fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. He is the second No. 1 overall prospect to don a Baysox uniform in quick succession, as Adley Rutschman (2021-22) also topped the prospect rankings during his time in Bowie. Holliday is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday. He is the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

# SLIPPING UP

Last night featured four combined errors between Bowie and Akron - two from each time. Both sides have shown struggles at times in the field. The Baysox have the fourth-most errors in the Eastern League this season with 77 through 82 games. Meanwhile, the RubberDucks' 78 errors are the third-most in the league. Only Hartford and New Hampshire (80) have more across the Eastern League in 2023.

# **LET HIM COOK**

Billy Cook has enjoyed a breakout at the Double-A level in the summer months, Cook has hit .317 since the calendar flipped to June - third-highest average in the Eastern League among players with at least 100 at-bats. Cook's 17 extra-base hits in that stretch (nine doubles, six home runs) are also fifth-most in the league, while his 12 stolen bases in as many attempts are second-most. Following last night, Cook currently has four extra-base hits and 12 RBI in his last six games. Cook currently leads active Baysox hitters in home runs (10), RBI (45), and stolen bases (17).

# ALL RHODES LEAD TO HOME

Friday was a career night for John Rhodes. The No. 19 Orioles' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, hit three home runs for the first multi-home run game of his career. The performance was a big slump buster for Rhodes, who had been just 2-for-27 at the plate in the month of July prior. Rhodes has clobbered Akron pitching this season, hitting .333 (13-for-39) against RubberDucks arms, with four of his eight home runs on the season. Rhodes' day at the plate on Friday was just the seventh three home run effort in Baysox franchise history.

# **COACHING STAFF**

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor leaguest 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving no to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
