An announced crowd of 8,293 fans were treated to an amazing promotional night, which included a replica jersey, a pitcher's duel and a post-game fireworks show. The attendance ranked first in the California League (by 3,544 people) and Single-A (by 1,694), while ending 17th overall in all of Minor League Baseball. For the Grizzlies offense, Jason Hinchman was not retired, reaching base four times (two walks, one single and one HBP). Jake Snider mashed a double and walked once. Fresno starter Jack Mahoney (1-1) took the tough-luck loss after surrendering two runs over five and one-third innings of work. Mahoney allowed five hits and two walks while fanning three.
