SUGAR LAND TAKES GAME FIVE

Sugar Land secured a series victory with an 11-4 win over Round Rock yesterday. The Space Cowboys took a 1-0 lead in the second on an RBI ground out by SS Jacob Amaya. Sugar Land plated three runs in the home half of the fourth. DH Cesar Salazar started the scoring and brought home Wagner on a single. Back-to-back run scoring singles to left field by Amaya and C Luke Berryhill rounded out the scoring in the inning and it was 4-0. 2B Jesus Bastidas drove in Salazar and Amaya on a bases loaded double increasing the lead to 6-0. In the seventh, Round Rock scored four runs to cut the Sugar Land lead to 6-4. It began with a sacrifice fly by LF Dustin Harris. RBI singles by RF Sandro Fabian and 2B Jonathan Ornelas plated two. The half-inning was capped off by an RBI ground out by 3B Jantzen Witte. LF Cooper Hummel answered for Sugar Land bringing home Wagner on an RBI single. Berryhill brought home two with a single up the middle to increase the Space Cowboys lead to 9-4. Amaya scored on a 3B David Hensley base knock as the advantage grew to 10-4. In the eighth inning, Amaya drew a bases loaded walk to add another run making it a final score of 11-4.

ANDERSON ON THE BUMP

Express RHP Shaun Anderson takes the mound for the series finale on Sunday. Anderson signed a minor league contract with the Texas Rangers last week. The righty was a third round selection by the Boston Red Sox in 2016. He has appeared in 63 games in the Major Leagues over parts of six seasons with a 5.84 ERA (88 ER/135.2 IP). He pitched in two games for the E-Train in 2021 and did not allow a run over 3.0 innings of work.

SANDRO SURGING

Express OF Sandro Fabian went 4-for-5 with a run scored and an RBI on Saturday. Fabian is tied for the team lead with seven multi-hit games. The righty is slashing .393/.433/.589 with four doubles, one triple, a home run, 14 RBI, nine runs scored and 11 strikeouts.

WELCOME TO THE J.O. SHOW

After going 1-for-18 in his previous six games, INF Jonathan Ornelas went 5-for-10 with a double and two RBI in his last two games. The righty went 3-for-5 with an RBI yesterday and lifted his batting average back above .300 for the season. He is slashing .302/.339/.434 this year.

SAMPSON SLAYS

RHP Adrian Sampson recorded the longest outing of the season for an Express pitcher after 7.0 innings with only two runs, and one earned run on six hits and three strikeouts on Friday night. It was the righty's first time recording 7.0 innings of work since September 30, 2022 when he was pitching for the Chicago Cubs. On Friday, he retired the final 13 batters he faced and secured the win.

ROSTER MOVE

INF Jayce Easley joined the Express on Sunday from High-A Hickory. Easley is at the Triple-A level for the first time in his career. The former fifth round selection in 2018 by the Texas Rangers was drafted out of O'Connor High School in Phoenix, Arizona.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
