SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels extended their winning streak to eight games, beating the Curve, 2-1, at CarMax Park. The win capped the first six-game sweep in Flying Squirrels history, winning each game of the inaugural series at the new ballpark. **Darien Smith** started for Richmond and did not allow a baserunner until the fifth inning. He finished his outing with 4.1 hitless innings pitched and set a career high with nine strikeouts. Smith issued a walk in the fifth that scored against **Cesar Perdomo** on a single by Javier Rivas, who had both of the Curve's hits in the game. In the bottom of the fifth, **Scott Bandura** gave the Flying Squirrels a 2-1 lead with a two-run double. Perdomo threw 3.2 scoreless innings with four strikeouts. **Mitch White** closed his first affiliated save with a scoreless ninth inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, in their first six-game road series of the year. This week marks Richmond's first visit to Hartford since August 29-September 3, 2024, when they won four-of-six. Facing the Yard Goats in the final series of the 2025 season and the final series at The Diamond last September 9-14, the Flying Squirrels won the first five games before dropping the finale.

The Flying Squirrels are looking to extend their winning streak to eight games. The 7-1 start matches the team's best record through eight games in franchise history, even with 2021. A win tonight would match the 2021 season as the best start through nine games with a 8-1 record. That same stretch from May 5-13 is also the team record for the longest win streak in franchise history at eight. The Curve are looking for their first win of 2026.

STARTING STRONG: The Flying Squirrels' 7-1 start matches the team's best record through eight games in franchise history, even with 2021. A win today would match the 2021 season as the best start through nine games with a 8-1 record. That year, the Flying Squirrels lost their season opener before winning eight straight from May 5-13.

GREAT EIGHT: The Flying Squirrels' eight-game win streak is tied for the longest in franchise history, even with May 5-13, also beginning with the second game of the season. That year was the team's only other 8-1 start through nine games. In the eight wins of the current streak, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in six of them. In four of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. On April 4, they scored two in the ninth for an 11-9 win at Erie. In last Tuesday's home opener, they never trailed but jumped ahead in the bottom of the eighth for a 3-2 win over the Curve. On Thursday, they scored two in the eighth for another 3-2 win against Altoona. On Saturday, the Curve scored two in the top of the 10th before the Flying Squirrels walked off with three in the bottom of the 10th. The eight-game winning streak is the longest of any of the 150 teams in Major League Baseball and Minor League Baseball so far in 2026.

MEET THE TEAM: This year's season-opening Flying Squirrels roster including 19 players who have previously played in Richmond. There are nine players who have made their Richmond debuts this season, including **Maui Ahuna**, **Charlie Szykowny**, **Mitch White**, **Darien Smith**, **Greg Farone**, **Logan Martin**, **Cesar Perdomo** and **Dylan Carmouche**. Each of the newcomers also made their Double-A debuts this season. Of the 28 players, 11 were acquired by the Giants in the MLB Draft, five were signed by the Giants as international free agents, five were signed by the Giants from independent teams, four were acquired via trade and three were signed as non-drafted free agents.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have the best record in the Eastern League and are tied for the best record of all 150 teams across Major League Baseball and Minor League Baseball, even with the Double-A Southern League's Chattanooga Lookouts. The Richmond offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.285) and hits (87).

THE YARD GOATS are 4-5 on the season, tied for fourth in the Northeast Division. They opened the season 3-1, including taking two-of-three at home against the Baysox, before dropping four-of-five entering this series. In 2025, the Yard Goats went 69-68, third-best in the Northeast Division. Hartford's roster features three players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including LHP Griffin Herring (No. 12), 2B Roc Riggio (No. 15) and C Cole Messina (No. 23). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list features four Hartford players, including Herring (No. 9), Riggio (No. 10), Messina (No. 21) and LHP Konner Eaton (No. 26).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Logan Martin** makes his second Double-A start. It is also his second appearance as a member of the San Francisco Giants organization. He made his Double-A debut on Wednesday at CarMax Park, allowing three runs on two hits in four innings against the Curve. Martin was acquired by the Giants from the Kansas City Royals in a trade on November 11, 2025 for right-handed pitcher Mason Black. A native of Paducah, Ky., Martin finished his collegiate career at the University of Kentucky and was selected by the Royals in the 12th round of the 2023 MLB Draft. He spent all of last season with High-A Quad Cities, going 8-4 with a 3.45 ERA in 22 starts. For the year, he ranked second in the Midwest League in wins. **For more on Martin, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander **Connor Staine** makes his second appearance of the season. He pitched out of the bullpen on Wednesday at Reading and allowed three runs over 2.2 innings with five walks in his season debut. In his first Double-A season last year, Staine went 3-8 with a 4.91 ERA in 25 starts. He made one start against the Flying Squirrels, which came in the final game at The Diamond on September 14, and allowed two runs over 6.1 innings in a no-decision. Staine was selected by the Rockies in the fifth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Central Florida.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey**, **Zach Morgan**, **Onil Perez** and **Drew Cavanaugh** combined to catch 74 stolen base attempts last season, which ranked first among the 30 Double-A teams and led the Eastern League by 20 over Hartford (54). Sugastey led all Double-A catchers with 50 runners caught stealing. He set a franchise record for the most caught stealing in a season in Flying Squirrels history, passing Jackson Williams' mark of 35 set in 2015 with his 36th on July 26 against Portland. For his career with Richmond, Sugastey's 66 runners caught stealing is the most in franchise history, passing Williams' (2010-11, '15) previous mark of 59.

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 268 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PACKING THE HOUSE: In 2025, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in total (446,679) and average (6,768) attendance for the fourth consecutive season. The average attendance was the highest in the franchise's history. Tuesday's inaugural game at CarMax Park had been sold out for more than a month, marking the 16th consecutive home-opener to sell out for the Flying Squirrels. This season, the Flying Squirrels lead all 120 MiLB teams in average attendance (8,235).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Drew Cavanaugh** is tied for first in doubles (5), second in OPS (1.371), tied for second in extra-base hits (6), third in OBP (.571), third in SLG (.800), tied for fourth in runs (9) and sixth in batting average (.400). **Dayson Croes** is tied for second in hits (12). **Jonah Cox** is tied for fourth in stolen bases (6) and tied for sixth in RBIs (8). **Turner Hill** is tied for first in triples (2), tied for first in runs (10), tied for sixth in RBIs (8). **Cesar Perdomo** is tied for first in ERA (0.00). **Jack Choate** is tied for second in wins (2). **Greg Farone** is tied for sixth in strikeouts (13) and tied for seventh in WHIP (0.89). **Tyler Vogel** is tied for first in saves (2). **Darien Smith** is first in BAA (.077) and fourth in WHIP (0.72).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features three players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bo Davidson** (No. 3), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 24) and **Joe Whitman** (No. 25). **Adrián Sugastey** is rated by Baseball America as the top defensive catcher in the Giants organization and **Jonah Cox** is rated as the top defensive outfielder. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 7), **Maui Ahuna** (No. 20) and Whitman (No. 26).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1958: The Richmond Virginians beat the Boston Red Sox, 5-1, at Parker Field, capping a sweep of a two-game exhibition series. The only Red Sox run of the game scored on a pinch-hit, solo homer by Ted Williams in the eighth inning. He had also hit a pinch-hit, eighth-inning homer the previous day. Deron Johnson hit a three-run homer off Bob Porterfield in the bottom of the eighth. Jim Coates started on the mound for the Virginians and threw five scoreless innings, striking out five. **2018:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin' Phils, 3-1, in their home opener at The Diamond. The sellout crowd of 9,845 set a new record as the largest in franchise history. Jordan Johnson started and threw six scoreless innings. He also hit a solo homer in the fifth. **2022:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 10-6, at The Diamond. Richmond scored eight runs in the fourth inning fueled by a single-inning franchise-record four homers by Sean Roby, Jacob Heyward, Shane Matheny and Brandon Mar torano. Roby also homered in the second, one of a then-team-record five in the game.
