SALEM YOU DIRTY DAWG: After getting back in the win column with a come-from-behind victory last night over the Salem Red Sox, the FredNats send the red-hot Jarlin Susana to the mound tonight on Thursday night in Salem to try and win their second straight. Susana has completely turned around his season in June after a rough month of May, pitching 20 innings over his last four starts with just two total runs allowed for an ERA of 0.90 in that stretch. Also in that stretch, he has 32 strikeouts against just nine walks, and has allowed just eight total hits, six of which are singles. He faces Salem lefty Noah Dean, who returns to Salem after spending the 2023 season here as well.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats fell behind for the second straight day, but rallied for two runs in the 9th to break a 2-2 tie and ultimately win the game 4-2. Jose Colmenares homered and drove in the fourth run in the 9th for the best offensive night of his season, and Cristhian Vaquero's RBI broke the tie in the 9th. The FredNat bullpen was once again clutch, finishing the game with four shutout innings, with Anthony Arguelles earning his third save in the last week and a half for FXBG.

DOMINANT ARMS: During last week's four-game winning streak against the Wood Ducks, the FredNat arms dominated the Down East lineup. In the four wins, the FredNats have allowed just five runs to score in 36 innings for an ERA of 1.25. The staff has posted 45 strikeouts against 15 walks, and Down East hit just .158 in those four losses. Each time, the FredNat starter pitched at least five innings, with two of the starts lasting into the 6th inning.

UNBEATEN AFTER 7: The FredNats remain a perfect 29-0 when leading after seven this year, and also a perfect 31-0 when leading after eight innings, including three out of the four wins this week. The winning formula all season has been the offense taking a lead in the middle innings, and the bullpen holding onto that lead each time.

OH SYKORA: After making his professional debut on May 1 with Fredericksburg, 2023 Nationals third round pick Travis Sykora has taken the Carolina League by storm in the first two months of his professional career. He's pitched five complete innings in each of his last three starts, and has allowed just three runs in that time frame with 24 strikeouts and only six walks in June.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 27-5 this season when scoring first, including 23 out of the last 24 wins. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses the last two weeks, and had come from behind in its last three wins before yesterday.

RBI KING: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 52. This year, Pimentel is hitting .341 with runners in scoring position, and is 12-for-29 (.414) with runners in scoring position and two outs. He's also 5-for-10 with three doubles, two home runs and 18 RBI with the bases loaded this season, being at his very best with the stakes high.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 179-152 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Jarlin Susana is set to make his 12th start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a sinker, a tight slider, plus a curveball and a changeup.

EARLY-SEASON HIGHS: After an up-and-down April last year, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

LATE-SEASON LULL: Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

LAST TIME OUT: Susana has flipped a switch lately, and that continued against Down East. Jarlin fired five shutout innings with seven strikeouts, with the Woodies managing just two base hits. Susana has allowed just two earned runs in 20 innings over his last four starts.
