LAST GAME: The Space Cowboys scored a season-high 11 runs Tuesday night in Tacoma with an 11-5 win over the Rainiers. Korey Lee hit his second home run of the season and finished the night with three RBI. All but one player in the Space Cowboys starting lineup Tuesday collected at least one hit and seven different players drove in runs.

PB & JJ: JJ Matijevic has homered four times through the first 13 games of the season and is tied for third in the Pacific Coast League. He hit the first Space Cowboys home run at Constellation Field on Tuesday and hit the first-ever home run in Space Cowboys history on April 5 at Sacramento. Matijevic tied for the Sugar Land team lead with 16 home runs in 2021 and was second of all Astros minor leaguers with a total of 25 home runs on the season.

CANNOLI: Enoli Paredes tossed 1 2/3 innings of scoreless relief on Friday, recording all five outs with strikeouts. Paredes has allowed just one unearned runs through four appearances this season (6 IP), striking out eight batters.

SOME PEOPLE CALL THEM: Opening Day on April 5 was the first-ever game for the Astros' Triple A affiliate under the Sugar Land Space Cowboys brand. The Astros re-branded their Triple A affiliate on Jan. 29, following the purchase of the Sugar Land franchise in 2021. Sugar Land had played under the "Skeeters" brand for the first 10 years of its existence. They spent 2012-20 as members of the independent Atlantic League and rose to the Triple A level for the 2021 season.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandana and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- Horizon Gradient: Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms. The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon
- Mission Patch: This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

KEEPING IT 100: Korey Lee enters the season rated as the No. 70 overall prospect in baseball, per Baseball America. RHP Hunter Brown is rated as the No. 95 overall prospect in baseball – and Lee rated at No. 97 – per FanGraphs.

WRECK 'EM: : The Astros on Saturday selected the contract of left-hander Parker Mushinski from the Space Cowboys, while placing right-hander Ryan Pressly on the 10-Day IL. Mushinski, who's set to make his Major League debut, is the first Space Cowboys player to receive a promotion to the Astros this season. Mushinski has allowed just one unearned run through 4 2/3 innnigs this season. The Astros selected Mushinski in the seventh round of the 2017 MLB Draft from Texas Tech.

PUNCHIES: The Space Cowboys pitching staff is tied for fourth in all of Minor League Baseball with 146 strikeouts. They've struck out at least 12 batters in four of their last six games.

HOLY HENSLEY: Over his last eight games, David Hensley has hit .417 (10x24) with a triple, home run and five RBI. Hensley hit his first career Triple A home run in Sunday's win at Sacramento, traveling 431 feet, which is the farthest from a Space Cowboys player this season.

SPACE COWBOYS AFTER DARK: The Space Cowboys' 12-inning contest on April 8 at Sacramento was the longest game in Sugar Land's Triple A history by both innings and time-of-game, including extra-inning games (4:34). Sugar Land played two 11-inning games in 2021, with the last coming on July 18 at Albuquerque. The previous high for timeof-game was a 4-hour, 30-minute game on August 2, 2021, vs. El Paso, which was an 8-7, 10-inning loss for Sugar Land.

READY TO RIDE: The Space Cowboys brand pays respect to elements that are key to the identity of Greater Houston. The NASA Johnson Space Center is located in Houston and the Cowboys element is a nod to the rugged, Western roots that are embedded in Houston as Texas' largest city.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his third season as the manager of the Astros' Triple A affiliate and his second with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

THE FUTURE: The Space Cowboys Opening Day roster featured nine players ranked within the Astros' top 30 prospects (per MLBPipeline): C Korey Lee (No. 2), RHP Hunter Brown (No. 3), IF Pedro León (No. 4), RHP Peter Solomon (No. 7), RHP Shawn Dubin (No. 8), LHP Jonathan Bermudez (No. 19), RHP Tyler Ivey (No. 20), OF Alex McKenna (No. 22), OF Corey Julks (No. 28).

EAST, WEST: Sugar Land won the Eastern Division of the formerly-named Triple A West, with a record of 75-55. They posted the second-best record in all of Triple A West, behind only Tacoma (78-52).

PISTOL PETE: RHP Peter Solomon was named Triple A West Pitcher of the Year and the Sugar Land Pitcher of the Year in 2021. Solomon ranked among the Triple A West leaders in wins (8, T-3rd) and strikeouts (112, 3rd).

LEVEL UP: The Space Cowboys enter their second season as the Triple A affiliate of the Houston Astros. By approximate mileage, the Space Cowboys are the second-closest Triple A team to their parent club (22 miles), trailing only the St. Paul Saints (Triple A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins).

WHERE TO FIND US: Beginning in 2022, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys can be seen on MiLB.TV. Longtime Houston broadcaster Gerald Sanchez returns as the play-by-play voice of the Space Cowboys.

CRAFTY LEFTYS: Left-handers Zac Rosscup and Adam Morgan have combined to appear in parts of 14 MLB seasons. Both were signed by the Astros to minor league contracts during Spring Training.

HE GETS ON BASE: Michael Papierski returns to Sugar Land after leading Triple A West and all Astros minor leaguers with 64 walks. He posted a .379 on-base percentage throughout the season, which was the highest of all Triple A players with a minimum of 400 plate appearances.

JOHNNY ROCKETS: Left-hander Jonathan Bermudez was named the 2021 Astros Minor League Pitcher of the Year. Bermudez went 3-5 with a 3.32 ERA in 18 games (15 GS) with Double A Corpus Christi before receiving his first Triple A promotion and going 2-1 with a 3.06 ERA in seven games (5 GS) with Sugar Land to close out the season. Bermudez trailing only teammate JP France in innings pitched (111.0) and strikeouts (146) of Astros minor leaguers. His combined 3.24 ERA on the season was the lowest of all Astros minor leaguers with a minimum of 60 innings pitched.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through their first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Rafael Peña and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his second season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Peña enters his first season on the Sugar Land staff after serving as the hitting coach for Double A Corpus Christi in 2021. He joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2018. Sutil enters his first season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

HYPER LOCAL: The Space Cowboys have three players on their roster that grew up in the Houston area in RHP Chad Donato (Cypress), OF Corey Julks (Friendswood) and RHP Nick Hernandez (Missouri City). Hernandez graduated from Dulles H.S. in Sugar Land, which is located less than five miles from Constellation Field, home of the Space Cowboys. Both Julks and Hernandez went on to play for the University of Houston, with both earning All-American Conference First Team honors at points during their career with the Cougars.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Six players went on to make their Major League debut in 2021 after appearing with Sugar Land: RHP Tyler Ivey, RHP Ralph Garza Jr., LHP Ryan Hartman, OF Jake Meyers, OF Jose Siri and RHP Seth Martinez. Siri and Meyers were both members of the Astros' postseason roster, with Meyers appearing in the ALDS before sustaining a season-ending shoulder injury and Siri appearing in both the ALCS and World Series.

It was the longest relief effort from a Space Cowboys pitcher this season and were the second-most single-game strikeouts from Space Cowboys pitcher ... The seven strikeouts on 4/12 were also tied for the fifth-most in a single game of Pacific Coast League pitchers this

SHINING BRIGHT: Rated as the No. 95 overall prospect in FanGraphs' Top-100 Prospect Rankings ... Is also ranked as the Astros' No. 3 overall prospect -- and top pitching prospect -- by MLB.com.

DETROIT K CITY: The Detroit native struck out a combined 131 batters in 2021, which was third-most of Astros minor leaguers ... Matched his career-high of 10 strikeouts on three occasions in '21, including once at the Triple A level on Sept. 25 at El Paso ... Averaged 13.9 SO/9 through 49.1 IP with Double A Corpus Christi.

INNINGS EATER: Was one of three Astros minor leaguers to throw at least 100 innings in 2021 (100.1 IP), along with Space Cowboys teammates JP France and Jonathan Bermudez

REVERSE SPLIT: Held left-handed hitters to a .217 opponent's batting average (18x83) at the Triple A level in 2021

WHAT'S UP IN WEST PALM: Received his second career invite to Astros Major League Spring Training in 2022 ... Went 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA (1 ER/5.2 IP) through two Spring Training starts.
