**BACK ON TRACK:** After breaking a four-game losing streak with a rain-shortened victory in the series opener last night, the FredNats look to continue their unbelievable dominance of the Delmarva Shorebirds tonight in another edition of the Copa de la diversion games. The FredNats will once again become the Fundadores de Fredericksburg tonight with Bryan Polanco on the mound for FXBG. Polanco has been a consistent presence both in long relief in the bullpen and in the starting rotation this year for the FredNats, leading the team in wins, innings pitched and ERA among starters. He faces Ty Weatherly for Delmarva, who was activated from the 7-day injured list today.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT**: The FredNats blitzed Delmarva starter Blake Money, scoring three runs in the first nine pitches of the game. Brenner Cox, Elijah Green, Brandon Pimentel and Roismar Quintana all singled in the first, and Sammy Infante's sac fly drove in a run as well. That was plenty of run support for Travis Sthele, who pitched six scoreless innings before the game was called in the 7th inning due to rain. The shutout was the 9th of the year for FredNat pitching.

**COMPLETE DOMINATION**: The FredNats are 15-1 this year against Delmarva, and .500 against the rest of the Carolina League. In 15 games this year against the Shorebirds, FXBG has outscored Delmarva 99-39 this year and has swept two out of the three series the teams have played this year, including the second six-game series sweep in franchise history in the first week of July. FredNat pitching has 145 strikeouts of the Shorebirds in 145 IP this year against Delmarva, and has shut out the Shorebirds a whopping six times.

**HE'S BACK:** Brandon Pimentel has regained the Carolina League lead in RBIs, and he's currently working on a six-game RBI streak with his 62nd of the year coming in the first inning of last night's game. He's led the league in RBI since Opening Weekend, and has regained the league lead after losing it for a couple days last home stand.

**DOMINANT STARTS:** After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last month. Since June 11, the beginning of the last Carolina series, FredNat starters have logged 153 innings and allowed just 26 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.53. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In the last full six-game series alone, FredNat starters pitched 16.1 scoreless innings, allowing a total of seven hits.

**FORTY ONE AND ONE:** Last Tuesday's loss was the first time all season that the FredNats lost a game when leading after seven innings, and both doubleheader sweeps have pushed the team's record in that scenario to 41-1. FXBG's loss in Friday night's game was the first time all season the team bas blown a lead after eight innings.

**DOMINANT DAVIS:** In his return season from Tommy John surgery that wiped out his entire 2023 campaign, Marc Davis is making the most of his time in Fredericksburg. After five more innings on Friday night allowing no earned runs, he's now allowed just one earned run in his last five starts. Covering 25 innings in that time frame, his ERA is 0.36, the opponents are hitting just .143 against him, and his WHIP is an excellent 0.88. Davis also has 25 strikeouts in that span.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 40-7 this season when scoring first, including 34 out of the last 36 wins. FXBG was beaten for the first time in nearly a month when scoring first in Salem last weekend.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats'leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 193-159 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**TODAY'S START:** Bryan Polanco is set to make his 12th start of the season, this evening against the Delmarva Shorebirds. Polanco made a spot start at the end of April against Delmarva, and his since taken over a starting role after the promotion of Jose Atencio.

**NOTHING NEW:** While Polanco had been primarily a relief arm with Fredericksburg this year, starting games is a role he's more than familiar with. In his MiLB career, 17 of Bryan's 33 career appearances have been as a starting pitcher. In 2022 and '23 in particular, he started 16 games compared to just six relief appearances.

Further simplifying the transtition, Polanco has served as the "bridge guy" out of the FredNat bullpen this year, capable of handling longer outings. Of his five relief appearances, Polanco has worked three innings once, 4+ innings three times, and even logged a five inning relief outing on 5/1 vs Down East.

**AGAINST THE SHOREBIRDS:** Polanco has seen Delmarva three times this season, twice as a starter. He's been very effective against them, spinning 14 innings with just three earned runs against him, for an ERA of 1.93.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Polanco shutout Carolina over five frames in his last start before the break. He allowed two hits and walked three Mudcats, but worked around the traffic behind him to earn a win.
