GAME INFORMATION

PONIES PACE: The Rumble Ponies have won 11-straight games, which is the 3rd-longest win streak in franchise history. Binghamton's longest regular-season win streak in franchise history is 15 games (July 22-August 8, 2000) and 2nd-longest is 12 wins (July 20-August 1, 2006). The Ponies have not lost a game since May 23 in G2 vs. Richmond. Binghamton is 35-17 and in 1st place by 6.0 games in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League. Binghamton is 17-2 over its last 19 games, since May 14. The Ponies are a season-best 18 games over .500 and have been in sole possession of first place since May 18.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Somerset Patriots, 4-3, on Wednesday at Mirabito Stadium. Binghamton leads the series 2-0. RHP **Jonah Tong** (W, 5 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 11 K) twirled five no-hit innings in the victory. CF **Nick Morabito** (1-for-3, RBI) hit an RBI single. DH **Kevin Parada** (0-for-2, RBI, R, 2 BB) drew an RBI walk. RHP **Douglas Orellana** (2.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 2 K) pitched two scoreless innings in relief.

TONG TERRIFIC: RHP **Jonah Tong**, the Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 99 overall prospect, was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May. Tong made five starts in May and led the Eastern League with a 1.35 ERA, .122 BAA, 42 K, and 14.2 K/9, and ranked third with a 0.90 WHIP. Tong threw 6.2 perfect innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts on May 10 vs. Reading in Binghamton's first perfect game in franchise history and the first perfect game for a full-season minor league affiliate since 2017. The 21-year-old won three games during the month and did not allow more than two runs or four hits in any of his starts in May. He was the EL Pitcher of the Week twice in May. Tong is the first Binghamton pitcher or position player to win an EL monthly award since RHP Dom Hamel in September 2023. This season, Tong ranks 2nd in full-season MiLB and leads Double-A and the EL in strikeouts (83), K/9 (15.24) and strikeout rate (42.3%). He ranks 3rd in full-season MiLB with a .137 BAA and is T-3rd-fewest hits allowed (23) among pitchers with 40+ IP.

THORN IN THEIR SIDE: LHP **Zach Thornton** is slated to make his seventh Double-A start tonight. In his last start, Thornton twirled a two-hit shutout with a career-high-tying and Double-A career-high eight strikeouts over six innings in the win on Friday against Chesapeake. Thornton recorded the first complete game of his professional career, after the game was rain-shortened in the top of the seventh inning. Over Thornton's last four starts, he is 2-0 with a 0.74 ERA (2 ER in 24.1 IP) and 26 K and 2 BB with opponents hitting .120 against him. The 23-year-old ranks 2nd in full-season MiLB with 11.40 K/BB (57-to-5 K-to-BB ratio) and a 2.6% walk rate in 10 starts across A+ Brooklyn and AA Binghamton. Thornton holds a 32-to-3 K-to-BB ratio in six Double-A starts.

GOTTA GO MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito**, the Mets No. 17 prospect (MLB Pipeline), had a strong month of May. Morabito hit .326 (29-for-89) with an .833 OPS, 1 HR, 11 RBI, 14 R, 8 2B, 9 XBH, 9 BB, 12 SB (12-for-14) in 25 games in May. Morabito is riding an eight-game on-base streak (11-for-28, .393 AVG, .973 OPS, 9 RBI, 4 R, 4 2B, 3 SB). The 22-year-old ranks among the EL with 20 SB (T-1st), 14 2B (T-5th), 50 H (T-6th), 29 R (T-7th), and 19 XBH (T-9th). Morabito is in his first Double-A season and was the 2024 Mets Minor League Player of the Year.

PARADA PARTY: C **Kevin Parada** walked twice and drove in a run on Wednesday. Parada has turned a corner over his last 15 games (14-for-47, .298 AVG, .981 OPS, 4 HR, 11 RBI, 9 R, 9 BB, 11 K). Parada's first 25 G (.122 AVG, .375 OPS, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 3 R, 5 BB, 29 K). The 23-year-old is riding a 12-game on-base streak and recorded his first 3-hit game of the season on May 16 at Hartford and hit 2 HR with 4 RBI in his next game on May 17, which kick-started this strong stretch.

RAMIREZ RAKES: OF **Alex Ramirez** has been red-hot over his last 15 games (since May 14), hitting .360 (18-for-50) with a .918 OPS, HR, 10 RBI, 9 R, 4 2B, 5 XBH, 4 BB, 11 SB (11-for-12) in that span. Prior to his hot stretch, Ramirez went 0-for-21 over an eight-game span from May 2-14. Ramirez ranks T-1st with Nick Morabito in the EL with 20 SB, after he led the EL with 40 SB last year.

BUILT CLIFFORD TOUGH: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford**, the Mets No. 5 prospect (MLB Pipeline), ranks among the Eastern League with 8 HR (T-4th most), 29 RBI (9th), 27 BB (T-7th). Clifford had a strong May (27 G, .267 AVG, .843 OPS, 5 HR, 20 RBI, 11 R, 14 BB) and ranked T-3rd in the EL in HR (5) & 3rd in RBI (20) in May, after he hit .200 with a .703 OPS, 3 HR, and 9 RBI in April.

LAST START: Thornton twirled a two-hit shutout with a career-high-tying and Double-A career-high eight strikeouts on Friday night in Bowie against Chesapeake...Thornton earned his second Double-A win and lowered his ERA at the level to 2.30...He recorded the first complete game of his professional career with the game being rain-shortened...Over his last 4 GS (24.1 IP, 2 ER, 0.74 ERA, 26 K, .120 BAA, 3 scoreless starts).

2025 SEASON: Eastern League Pitcher of the Week (May 20-25) 6.1 perfect innings with 6 K against Richmond on May 24...Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Week (May 12-18) after earning first Double-A win and combining for 12 strikeouts, no walks, and just two runs allowed over 12 innings at Hartford in two starts...Promoted to Double-A Binghamton on April 30...Named High-A South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month for April...Ranked 6th in the MiLB in ERA (0.44) and 9th in WHIP (0.68) and led High-A South Atlantic League in ERA and wins (3) at time of promotion...Set Brooklyn franchise record for K-to-BB ratio (25-to-2) in a single season...Made four starts with High-A Brooklyn and went 3-0 with a 0.44 ERA and 25 strikeouts and just two walks in 20.2 innings (1 ER and 12 hits allowed)...Began the season with High-A Brooklyn.

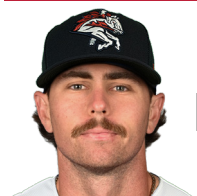

-Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16).
-In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-consecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.
-In 2023, Brignac led Binghamton to the postseason for the first time since 2017, going 39-27 in the second-half and 17-5 in the final 22 games. Binghamton swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the first time since 2014, before falling to the Erie SeaWolves.
-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, Bryce Montes de Oca).
-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School in Louisiana.
