Today's Game

The Fightin Phils return home and open a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the seventh-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and seventh-of-12 games at FirstEnergy Stadium. The Fightin Phils won the first series between the teams 4-2 from May 13-18. Reading heads to New Hampshire from Aug. 5-10. The R-Phils lead the season-series four games to two.

Game 55 Recap

The Fightin Phils fell on Sunday to Harrisburg 3-1, and ultimately dropped the series to the Senators. Chuck King started and did not allow a run through the first-three innings of the game. King was tagged for an unearned run in the fourth and another run in the fifth. In total, King allowed two runs (one earned) on four hits over five innings, with a career-high three walks and five strikeouts. On the other end, Riley Cornelio kept the Reading bats quiet. He allowed no runs on two hits over six innings, while walking four and striking out six. Reading got a run back in the seventh off Thomas Schultz. Josh Breau doubled and scored on a Felix Reyes single to make it 2-1. But, the Senators tacked on an insurance tally off Gunner Mayer in the bottom of the seventh when Joe Naranjo singled home Carlos De La Cruz. Reading was unable to manufacture any offense against Garrett Davilla and Daison Acosta, the latter of which got the save.

Hammering Homers in Harrisburg

The Fightin Phils matched a season-high with four home runs on Saturday night (last 4/15 vs BNG) and hit nine home runs last week, which was tied for most in the Eastern League for the week. Reading has also hit a home run in four-straight games, from Wednesday to Saturday. In the fifth inning on Saturday, Cade Fergus and Aidan Miller hit back-to-back home runs. It was the first instance of back-to-back home runs this season and the first consecutive home runs for Reading since Aug. 7, 2024, when Gabriel Rincones Jr., Otto Kemp and Trevor Schwecke went back-to-back-to-back. Paul McIntosh hit two home runs on Saturday, matching a career-high for the third time and first time since Aug. 31, of last season with Pensacola. It was the second two home run game by a Reading hitter this season, with the other being Robert Moore on Apr. 15 vs Binghamton.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller hit his team-leading sixth home run of the season on Saturday night and had two more hits. He also stole a base on Sunday, putting him alone in first in the Eastern League with 22 stolen bases. Additionally, Miller ranks third in the Phillies organization in stolen bases with his 22. His 22 stolen bases has already surpassed Reading's high in stolen bases from last season, when Gabriel Rincones Jr. had 20 swiped bags. After hitting just .203 in April, Miller posted a .284/.364/.432 (.796 OPS) slash line over 24 May games, along with 11 runs, four doubles, three home runs and eight RBI.

Anthony Keeps Rolling

Keaton Anthony was named the Phillies Minor League Hitter of May last Wednesday. Despite snapping a 12-game hitting streak on Thursday, Anthony singled on Sunday to extend his on-base streak to 24 games. His 24-game on-base streak is the longest by a Fightin Phils since Carlos De La Cruz reached in 38-straight games from May 12-June 25, of the 2023 season. Anthony's Eastern League ranks are: 2nd AVG (.328), 9th OBP (.379), 2nd SLG (.525), 5th OPS (.904), 3rd hits (58), 1st 2B (21), 1st XBH (26) and 3rd TB (93). Since May 1 (29 games), Anthony is slashing .368/.417/.604 (1.021 OPS), with 15 runs, 14 doubles, one triple, three home runs and 17 RBI.

Welcome to the Show Kemp

The Philadelphia Phillies called Otto Kemp up to the big leagues on Saturday and had his first three hits on Monday at home. Kemp, who spent much of the second half of 2024 with the Fightin Phils, becomes the second former R-Phil to make their big league debut this season, joining Mick Abel. Kemp played 64 games with Reading in 2024 and slashed .258/.353/.476 (.829 OPS) with 12 doubles, three triples, 11 home runs and 39 RBI.

I'll Take a DeMartini

The Phillies promoted No. 15 prospect Carson DeMartini to Reading ahead of Tuesday's game. The 22-year old has played in just 77 career professional games and slashed .284/.402/.474 (.876 OPS) over 53 games with Jersey Shore (A+) this season. He added 34 runs, 10 doubles, one triple, eight home runs and 31 RBI. The Phillies took DeMartini in the fourth round of the 2024 draft out of Virginia Tech.

This Day in Baseballtown History

Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight with a 26-31 record, which is fourth in the Northeast Division and 12.5 games out of first place. The Fisher Cats were home against Altoona last week and took five-of-six games, shutting out the Curve in the first four contests. After this week, New Hampshire hosts the Somerset Patriots. New Hampshire's roster has five players on the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline): Charles McAdoo (12), Juaron Watts-Brown (15), Jace Bohrofen (22), Dasan Brown (27) and Peyton Williams (28).

Pitching for the Fisher Cats

Righty Deveraux Harrison makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. Harrison is 4-5, with a 4.98 ERA (26 ER, 47.0 IP) over 10 starts. He's allowed 42 hits, 25 walks and struck out 45 (8.62 SO/9.0 IP). Harrison earned a win last Wednesday vs Altoona, tossing six-shutout innings, with two hits, three walks and five strikeouts. At Reading on May 17, Harrison earned the win as he allowed one run over 5.2 innings pitched. Harrison made 26 appearances with New Hampshire in 2024, going 5-8 with a 4.65 ERA. The 24-year old was drafted by Toronto in the ninth round in 2022 out of Long Beach State in California.

He went a season-high four innings and allowed just one hit, facing just one above the minimum. He also struck out three hitters and allowed no walks on the night. Neunborn was perfect through the first three innings, and after allowing a double to Jacob Young in the fourth, he finished his night strong by stranding Young and retiring the final two batters he faced. Neunborn was relieved by Gunner Mayer in the bottom of the sixth inning.
