TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a sixgame home series against the Birmingham Barons to close the first half. This is the last time these two clubs will meet this season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Baron edged out the M-Braves 2-1 in a pitching battle to even the series at two games apiece. LHP Domingo Robles took a tough luck loss, allowing two runs on a home run in six innings. RHP Matthew Thompson pitched a season-high seven innings and allowed a solo home run to Justin Dean.

GRAND SALAMI TIME: Less than halfway through the season, the M-Braves have a club record four grand slams, including the first ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell).

The M-Braves hit 17 home runs this past week, their most in a series this season. The club hit 10 homers from April 25-30 at Biloxi.

LET THE GOOD TIMES ROLL: Over the last sixseries, the club is 3-0-3 (22-13 overall), including a five-game sweep of Chattanooga from May 9-14 and a series win over Pensacola from June 13-18. The M-Braves are 24-15 since May

AGAINST THE BARONS: The M-Braves won four of six against the Barons from May 30-June 4, their first road win of the season. The M-Braves hit .282 with a .415 OBP in the series, combining for 43 runs and drawing 44 walks in six

Landon Stephens came out on fire, accumulating eight hits, two home runs, two doubles and seven RBI in the first three games. Luke Waddell hit in all six games, going 9-for-25 and drawing seven walks to reach base 16 times.

THIS TEAM KNOWS HOW TO PITCH: The M-Braves lead the Southern League in pitching, are 2nd in Double-A, and 12th in MiLB with a 3.64 ERA. M-Braves starters rank 8th in Double-A with a 4.04 ERA. The M-Braves finished May with the fourth best ERA in MiLB at 2.99.

PROSPECTING: 7 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (11), INF Cal Conley (13), OF Jesse Franklin V (14), RHP Alan Rangel (26), RHP Tanner Gordon (28), C Tyler Tolve (29) and LHP Luis De Avila (30).

HOME RUN ADVANTAGE AT HOME FIELD: The M-Braves rank second in the league with 79 homers - 48 on the road while their opponents have just 47 total home runs. 16 different players have at least one homer with Landon Stephens leading the way with 13, tied for the league lead

The M-Braves have 31 home runs at home and hit 12 home runs at Trustmark Park from June 6-11 vs Biloxi. M-Braves opponents have just eight home runs at Trustmark Park this season.

STREAKIN' TOLVE: Tyler Tolve increased his onbase streak to 17 games (May 24) with a base hit last night. Over the streak, Tolve is slashing .286/.352/.449 with two home runs, two doubles, five walks, and eight RBI. Javier Valdes posted the club's longest on-base streak, 19 games, from April 23-June 1.

ALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer homered in three straight games from May 23-25, becoming the sixth M-Brave to do so. Lugbauer achieved the feat from July 25-28, 2021.

The first baseman went to the 7-day Injured List on Wednesday, ranking among the league leaders in home runs (12, 1st), RBI (38, T-4th), SLG (.600, 1st), OPS (.986, 1st), OBP (.386, 6th) and XBH (25, 4th) at the time.

Lugbauer recorded his first career M-Braves triple on May 13 against the Lookouts, then another on May 16 at Montgomery. He made his profesional pitching debut on May 17 at Montgomery tossing 2/3 scoreless innings with a strikeout of Logan Driscoll on an 87 mph fastball. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mileper-hour home run, which ranked 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls at the time.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 58 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011), Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26).

WADDYYY: Luke Waddell reached base 19 times this past week, going 12-for-24 with three home runs, two doubles, four walks, and nine RBI. Waddell hit a go-ahead, two-run home run in the completion of Thursday's game on Friday.

DE AVILA DELIVERS: Luis De Avila has delivered four solid starts in June, going 2-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 22.1 innings. The left-hander ranks top 10 in the league in ERA (3.03, 3rd), IP (59.1, 8th), OPP AVG (.208, 4th), and WHIP (1.26, 8th).

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens homered in three straight games from June 16-18 to propel himself into second in the league with 13 homers. He is the eighth M-Brave all-time to homer in three straight. Stephens has seven homers and is slugging .618 over 19 games in June.

HOT VOD: Victor Vodnik has yet to allow a run in 12.0 innings over eight appearances. Since the start of May, Vodnik has a 0.81 ERA in 22.1 innings over 15 appearances with 12 walks to 35 strikeouts.

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox has allowed one earned run in 14.2 innings over 14 relief appearances with the M-Braves, including five walks to 22 strikeouts. The right-hander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings.

RETURN OF THE DEAN: Justin Dean comes back to the M-Braves after spending June 9-18 with Triple-A Gwinnett. In his first game back on Wednesday, Dean smashed a line drive off the right field wall and sped around the bases for an inside the park home run. In the series, Dean is 6-for-13 with two homers and three RBI.

OLD FRIEND ALERT: Tyler Neslony played 245 games for the M-Braves from 2017-21. In 17 games against his old team, Neslony is batting .350 with three homers, eight doubles, and 13

TODAY'S GAME

 Tanner Gordon makes his 29th Double-A start (8th this season) and 13th overall start of the 2023 season. This will be Gordon's third career start against Birmingham. In his last start against the Barons, Gordon gave up two runs in six innings on August 25, 2022.

LAST TIME OUT

Gordon bounced back from a rough Tuesday start with six shutout innings. The right-hander gave up just one hit and three walks with three strikeouts.
