### GONE FISHING

Over the first 4 games of the series, the Shuckers have outscored the Blue Wahoos 34-12, a +19 run differential.

- The Shuckers have gone 19-for-45 (.422) with a runner in scoring position during the series, while Pensacola has been held to 4-for-35 (.114).
- Since the start of 2025, the Shuckers are 14-5 against the Blue Wahoos at Keesler Federal Park, the best record against any Southern League opponent over that span.

### REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

The Shuckers set a season-high on Thursday with 15 runs, tied for the 4th-most runs in a game in franchise history and the 3rd-most in a game at Keesler Federal Park.

- The Shuckers are among the Double-A leaders in home runs (1st, 12), on-base percentage (1st, .418), OPS (1st, .916), walks (T-1st, 50), runs (T-3rd, 52), stolen bases (4th, 19) and average (6th, .288).

### A RUTHIAN START

**1B BLAKE BURKE** enters today as the Double-A home run leader, with 6 across his first 7 games of the season... 13 of 30 Double-A teams have recorded fewer than 6 home runs this season.

- Since his Southern League debut on August 2, 2025, Burke leads Minor League Baseball with 17 home runs and is 1 of 30 players with at least 10 over that span.
- On Thursday, Burke became the 1st Double-A player in the Digital Stats Era to record 6 home runs in a team's first 6 games.

### HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

With a home run on Wednesday, the Shuckers tied the Double-A record with 10 home runs through their first 5 games... The Shuckers are the 9th team in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005) to reach the mark and the 3rd since 2018.

- The Shuckers 8 home runs during the Opening Series are tied for the 5th-most in a Double-A Opening Series since 2005.

### RUNS? WHAT ARE THOSE?

**RHP TANNER GILLIS** tied his career-high with 5.0 shutout innings in relief on Friday... Gillis retired 14 consecutive batters to begin the outing and 15 of 16 batters faced.

- Gillis has recorded 7.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to April 4, 2026, the longest streak by a Shucker pitcher this season.
- Gillis tied the longest shutout relief outing in franchise history (since 2015)... He became the first to reach the mark since **RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS** in 2023.

### I'M JUST A KID AND I MAKE PITCHER'S LIVES A NIGHTMARE

**SS/2B JESÚS MADE** tied the Shuckers single-game franchise record on Thursday with 2 triples as part of a 3-for-6 game with 4 RBI... Made became the 3rd player in franchise history with multiple triples in a game, joining **1B/3B/OF MIKE BOEVE** (4/25/24 at PNS) and **1B TYLER BLACK** (6/29/23 vs. MIS).

- Over the last 5 games, Made is 11-for-21 with a home run, 2 triples, 4 walks and 7 balls in play at 100+ MPH.
- Made enters today among the Southern League leaders in hits (1st, 12), triples (T-1st, 2), RBI (T-5th, 7), average (8th, .375) and OPS (10th, 1.038).

### MR. CONSISTENCY

**2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE** (9-for-26) enters today as 1 of 4 Southern League players who have recorded a hit in all 7 games to begin the season.

- The 7-game streak ties O'Rae's longest hit streak at the Double-A level and the 2nd-longest of his career... His career-long streak is 9 consecutive games between July 3-18, 2023, with the ACL Brewers.

### MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

**SS/2B JESÚS MADE** enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

- Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (21 AB), Kevin McGonigle (52 AB) and JJ Wetherholt (48 AB) all reach 130 AB.

### BACK IN THE SADDLE

**MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO** returns to the Shuckers dugout for 2026 after 2 seasons as a Roving Infield Instructor with the Brewers organization.

- After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 51 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,449 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

### PROSPECT-PALOOZA

The Shuckers have 4 Top 30 prospects on their roster, including 2 Top-100 prospects and 2 Top-10 prospects.

- The 4 are: **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** (No. 1, No. 3 overall), **RHP BISHOP LETSON** (No. 7, No. 96 overall), **RHP TYSON HARDIN** (No. 13) and **1B BLAKE BURKE** (No. 18).

### TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

**RHP TYSON HARDIN** (0-1, 15.00) makes his 2nd start of the season and his 1st at Keesler Federal Park... Last season, Hardin held a 3.27 ERA (4er, 11.0ip), struck out 12 and did not allow a walk in 3 starts against Pensacola.
