### Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound today, looking to bounce back from a series-opening loss (have not started a series 0-2 since 8/26-8/27/25 at Louisville). Scranton/WB will counter with RHP **Alexander Cornielle**. Columbus is 32-17 (.653) versus right handers this year. Cornielle has never pitched against Columbus in his career (tonight is 4th game in the IL).

### vs. the RailRiders

Since a 14 game win streak over the RailRiders from 4/24/13-8/9/14, the Clippers have gone 17-24 against Scranton/WB (4-2 in last series played, 2023 in Huntington Park). Prior to last night, no active Clippers had ever played against the RailRiders (**George Valera** played in the 2023 series, but is currently on waivers; **Kolby Allard** had pitched 3G, but was released on Monday).

### Better Late Than Never

Each of the last two Columbus wins have come in the last at bat (both in extras), coming on the heels of three last at bat wins in the last home stand vs. Omaha (two walk-offs). The Clippers now lead the IL with 11 such wins, in addition to pacing the circuit with 111 runs scored from the 8th inning on (.937OPS from the 8th on, +87 on 2nd place). The 24 comeback wins for Columbus also lead the IL.

### Close-ing the Gap

Columbus has won five straight 1-run games (Sunday's was the lone game of Indianapolis series not decided by at least five) and seven of the last eight, improving to 9-7 in those games (.562, t-7th in the IL). In addition, the Clippers have gone 12-4 in the last 16G with a margin of three or fewer (26-18, .591, 3rd best). Over the last 26G, in which the Clippers are 17-9, they have a +3 run margin (132-129).

### Getting There

**Cooper Ingle** reached the qualification level for rate statistics in the IL on 6/7 and his current .424OBP ranks 3rd in the IL. Ingle has slumped to a .282OBP over the last 18G (15x74, .203, 9BB, 21K), but since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, he has the best OBP in the IL (.410, +10 points on 2nd place, **Christian Cairo**). As a catcher, Ingle has a 1.164OPS in 30G (.480OPS in 15G elsewhere).

### Naying It

**Bo Naylor** has reached base in 15 of 16G, posting a .414OBP (12BB in last 47PA; also has 2HR and 15K, yielding a 62% three true outcome rate). Since joining the team on 5/27, he is tied with **Kody Huff** for most RBI on the team (11), while scoring the most runs (13). Columbus catchers are hitting .297/.440/.525, leading the IL in all three categories (2nd in all is Memphis: .288/.403/.519).

### Learning Experience

**Ralph Velazquez** has struck out in 30% of his plate appearances in Triple-A (26K, 87PA), after turning in a rate of 17% in 64G at Double-A over the last two seasons (50K, 295PA). He averaged a homer every 21.4AB in Akron, but has just 1HR in 79AB with the Clippers (6/7 vs. Omaha). Over his last baker's dozen, Velazquez is hitting .173 (9x52), but has 6XBH (.346SLG) and 22K (39%).

### Struggling Slugging

**CJ Kayfus** enters today with a .313SLG since getting optioned on 4/13 (5XBH in 23G, all doubles). Last season, Kayfus had 31XBH in 68G for the Clippers, including 13HR (last on 7/19/25 at Iowa, 108AB since). Aside from a 4RBI outing on 4/26 at Buffalo, Kayfus doesn't have any other multi-RBI games in his last 39G, dating to 7/3/25 (18RBI total; had 36RBI in first 52G with Columbus).

### Forty Forty

**Kody Huff** scored for the 40th time this year on 6/13 at Indianapolis, marking his first season with 40 runs and 40RBI. Despite having played only 55G this season, he is just five short of his career high in the runs department (45 in 98G with Akron in 2024) and his next RBI will tie a personal best there (47RBI in 101G with Columbus last year). He already owns career highs in triples (3) and HR (9).

### Out(field) of Position

**Milan Tolentino** will start in center today, his first time playing the outfield as a pro (533G on the infield). **Dayan Frias** is making his 15th career appearance in the outfield (12th with Columbus this season) and **CJ Kayfus** will be playing his 81st game in the outfield (146G at 1B in the minors). **Cooper Ingle** is behind the plate today, but has played 4G in left this year (first games of his career).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

Thursday, June 18

## This Date in Clipper History

6/18/2019

Trailing the Red Wings by a score of 8-2 after five innings at Huntington Park, **Brandon Barnes** got the comeback rolling with a 2-run homer in the 6th and **Adam Rosales** tied it with a 2-run homer in the 8th. Following the Rosales blast, **Greg Allen** and **Daniel Johnson** hit back to back doubles to cap the 5-run inning and give Columbus the 9-8 lead that would ultimately be the final score.

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,438 to 1,386).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 97-88 (.524) in pitch reviews, with batters going 51-60 (.459) and pitchers/catchers going 46-28 (.622). They have run out of challenges in 34G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 3-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 53-36 when playing past regulation (.596, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 89G to require extra play, 70 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 827, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

## On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 93 through the first 69G (on pace for 201SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 22CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 4th most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (48; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,938RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.34 through the first 69G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 166HR (over 10HR under the average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 10th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 36G this season (24-12, .667), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Milan Tolentino** bunted the winning run into scoring position in an extra-inning win at Indianapolis on 6/14. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 88-23 (.793) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 5-2 mark this season (.714, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers lead the IL in last at bat wins this year (11) while playing in the 2nd most games decided in the last at bat (Scranton/WB has played 20). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 93G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 45-48 (.484, 15th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 424-437 (.492), 394-391 with Columbus (.502).

#### Unfortunate Run:

Prior to 3GS from 4/19-5/1 (14.2IP, 16ER), Avila had only one stretch of consecutive games with at least 5ER in his previous 248G as a professional. That run came with El Paso in 2023, as he surrendered at least 5ER in each of 5G to end April (19.0IP, 27ER). In total, he has given up at least 5ER on 24 occasions, maxing out at 7ER with both Fort Wayne in 2017 and San Diego in 2023.

#### From the 'Pen:

After 10GS to start the season, Avila began June by pitching in relief on starter's rest. He gave up 3ER in both outings, 6/5 vs. Omaha and 6/11 at Indianapolis, turning in a 7.71ERA (7.0IP, 8H, 8R, 6ER, 2BB, 6K).

#### Out of Here:

Giving up 6HR in his last 4G (73BF), Avila is the only Clipper pitcher to surrender double digits this season (11HR, tied for 9th most in the IL; 222BF). Most of that damage has been done at Huntington Park (8HR to 114BF, .583SLG; 3HR to 108BF on the road, .385SLG).

#### 2026 Spring Training:

Avila pitched six times for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 3.24ERA (8.1IP, 10H, 4R, 3ER, 1BB, 4K). He was released on 3/17, then signed a new minor league deal on 3/22 and assigned to minor league camp.

#### Last Season:

Pitched for Yakult in Japan... in the Central League (Majors) went 7-8 with a 4.04ERA in 15G (82.1IP, 70H, 41R, 37ER, 30BB, 61K)... in the Eastern League (minors) was 0-1 with a 1.33ERA in 6G (20.1IP, 12H, 3R, 1ER, 12BB, 13K).
