TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their home stand tonight, hosting the Visalia Rawhide in game five of a six-game series. After tonight's game, fans will enjoy a post-game Fireworks display, thanks to La Rocque Better Roofs! The Quakes take a day off on Monday, then host Lake Elsinore here at home for six straight. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: This will be the 11th of 18 meetings at LoanMart Field between the Quakes and the Arizona Diamondbacks Cal League affiliate and the 14th of 30 head-to-head meetings overall. The Quakes dropped two of three at Visalia to start the year, but rebounded by winning five of six here at home back in late-April and have now won eight of 13 overall.

LAST GAME: The Rawhide stunned the Quakes on Friday night, scoring 11 times in the sixth inning to rally from a five-run deficit and defeat Rancho by a final of 13-10 at LoanMart Field. Ramses Malave hit a three-run homer to give the Rawhide the lead for good against Horacio Andujar (0-1), while S.P. Chen capped the 11-run frame with a three-run double. The Quakes got three hits and two RBIs from Luis Rodriguez and two hits and three RBIs from Damon Keith in the loss. Visalia reliever Eric Mendez (2-1) go the win, with reliever David Sanchez earning the final out for his third save.

FRIDAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made four total roster moves on Friday, with two relievers being placed on the Injured List and two relievers joining the club from Extended Spring Training in Arizona. RHP Carlos De Los Santos and RHP Yamil Castillo both were placed on the IL, while RHP River Ryan and RHP Horacio Andujar were both added to the Rancho roster. Ryan was acquired in the Matt Beaty trade during Spring Training this year with the San Diego Padres. Last year, Ryan was a position player, spending his brief tenure at the Padres Complex as a hitter. Upon being traded to the Dodgers, they have converted him to a pitcher. When he pitches in this series, it'll mark his pro debut as a pitcher. Ryan was an 11th-round choice of the Padres in the 2021 draft out of UNC-Pembroke. Andujar, who debuted and suffered the loss on Friday night, signed with the Dodgers out of the Dominican Republic in 2018.

FEEL THE POWER: The Quakes hit one home run in Thursday's loss, giving them their first home run of the series, their first since May 20th and just their second since May 15th. Last night however, Rancho got their offense back in gear by slugging four home runs, as Luis Rodriguez (4), Damon Keith (5), Yeiner Fernandez (2) and Julio Carrion (3) all went deep. The Quakes have now hit 45 home runs, which is now third in the league, behind Fresno (51) and San Jose (49).

KEITH ON FIRE AGAIN: After going hitless in the final three games of the Fresno series last week, Damon Keith has caught fire this week against Visalia, racking up four straight multi-hit games. He's gone 9-for-16 in this series with seven RBIs over the four-game stretch so far.

LOADED WITH PROSPECTS: The Quakes now have five players that Baseball America and MLB Pipeline have rated as Top-30 within the organization. They are led by the Dodgers' number-one overall prospect, catcher Diego Cartaya. Cartaya broke out in 2021, as he appeared in 31 games with the Quakes, hitting .299 with 10 homers and 31 RBIs, before suffering a season-ending back injury. Cartaya is back in Rancho to at least start the year and is in good health. He's joined by LHP Maddux Bruns (#12), INF Alex De Jesus (#20), OF Luis Rodriguez (#25) and OF Jake Vogel (#29).

EDGARDO HENRIQUEZ: Right-hander Edgardo Henriquez will go to the mound for his ninth appearance, eighth start and second against Visalia. In his lone appearance against the Rawhide, he allowed two runs (one earned) on four hits over three innings in a loss on April 29. In his last appearance overall, he allowed four runs on six hits over two innings in a loss to Fresno on May 22. Henriquez was signed out of Venezuela in 2018 by the Dodgers.

LIAM NORRIS: Lefty Liam Norris makes his eighth start overall tonight and his third against the Quakes. In two prior outings versus Rancho, has allowed just two runs on five hits over 7.2 innings in two no-decisions. In his last start overall, he allowed three runs on one hit with four walks, while recording just one out in a no-decision versus Lake Elsinore on May 22. Norris was third-round pick (90th overall) in the 2020 draft by Arizona, out of Green Hope HS in Cary, North Carolina.
