MOVING ON UP: The Skeeters are set to begin their first season in affiliated minor league baseball as the Triple A affiliate of the Houston Astros. The Skeeters are one of three independent teams that rose to the affiliated minor league ranks this offseason, along with the St. Paul Saints (AAA, MIN) and the Somerset Patriots (AA, NYY).

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through their first nine seasons of existence, the Skeeters played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in 2016 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. The Skeeters still hold the Atlantic League single-season record for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from their 2013 season.

CLOSE TO HOME: Based on approximate mileage, the Skeeters are located second-closest to the stadium of their parent club out of Triple-A teams. The Skeeters are located approximately 22 miles from Minute Maid Park. The St. Paul Saints are located approximately 11 miles from the Minnesota Twins' Target Field.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey is entering his third year as the manager of the Astros Triple A affiliate. He led Round Rock to the best record in Triple A in 2019 (84-56) and to the Pacific Coast League Finals. Storey got his first managerial job in the Astros system in 2018 with Class A Quad Cities, winning the Western Division of the Midwest League. Storey appeared at the MLB level with the Astros in 2012 and the Blue Jays in 2013 as a right-handed pitcher. He still holds numerous career pitching records for Florida Atlantic University.

MAJOR TALENT: The Skeeters roster features eight players with Major League service time: OF **Ronnie Dawson**, IF **Alex De Goti**, IF **Taylor Jones**, RHP **Nivaldo Rodriguez**, RHP **Peter Solomon**, C **Garrett Stubbs**, IF **Abraham Toro**, RHP **Hector Velazquez**. All but Velazquez have appeared at the Majors with the Astros.

PROSPECT POWER: The Skeeters have nine players ranked inside the Astros top-30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline): RHP **Tyler Ivey** (No. 9), RHP **Shawn Dubin** (No. 11), RHP **Peter Solomon** (No. 14), RHP **Jojane Torres** (No. 20), IF **Taylor Jones** (No. 21),

RHP **Brett Conine** (No. 23), RHP **Austin Hansen** (No. 24), RHP **Nivaldo Rodriguez** (No. 25), OF **Ronnie Dawson** (No. 29)

WELCOME TO AAA: The following players are set to make their first Triple A appearances: RHP **Brett Conine**, RHP **Shawn Dubin**, RHP **Austin Hansen**, RHP **Tyler Ivey**, RHP **Seth Martinez**, RHP **Nivaldo Rodriguez**, RHP **Jojane Torres**, IF **CJ Hinojosa**, OF **Jake Meyers**, C **Michael Papierski**, C **Colton Shaver**, IF **Miguelangel Sierra**, RHP **Peter Solomon**

PUT IT ON THE MANTEL: **Ronnie Dawson**, **Alex De Goti** and **Peter Solomon** each made their Major League debuts with the Astros this season. Dawson went 1x5 with a run through 3 G, De Goti went 2x6 with a run and RBI through 6 G and Solomon tossed a scoreless 2 IP in relief, allowing just one hit and striking out two.

ASTROS UPDATES: The Astros on May 5 put infielder Abraham Toro on the Minor League Injured List with a right oblique strain. Toro had been assigned to Sugar Land to begin the season. The Astros also announced the signing of RHP Ryan Eades and assigned him to the Skeeters. Eades appeared at the MLB level in '19 with Minnesota and Baltimore. Minnesota selected Eades in the second round of the '13 MLB Draft from Louisiana State University

DE "G.O.A.T" E: IF Alex De Goti did not appear in a game in 2020 but is coming off a 2019 campaign in which he led Astros minor leaguers in plate appearances (548), tied for the lead in games (127) and was third in runs (83), hits (133) and doubles (29). He spent the entire '19 season with Round Rock (AAA).

WELCOME TO ABQ: The Skeeters are making their first trip to Albuquerque in franchise history. The Skeeters and Isotopes are scheduled to play each other 30 times this season and are both in the East Division of Triple-A West. The Isotopes visit Constellation Field in Sugar Land for the first time from May 27-June 1.

GOT THE NOD: Dubin is set to make his first career start at the Triple A level and is making his first Opening Day start at the professional level. Dubin's only other appearance on Opening Day came on 4/4/19 with Quad Cities (A) when he collected a two-inning save vs. Burlington (2 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 4 BB, 3 SO).

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: Dubin did not make an appearance at the Major or Minor League level in '20 due to the pandemic-shortened season. He last appeared at the affiliated level in '19, spending the bulk of the season with Fayetteville (A+) after beginning the year with Quad Cities (A) ... Went a combined 7-5 with a 3.58 ERA (44 ER/110.2 IP) and three saves in 25 games (19 GS).

PROSPECT CREDENTIALS: Rated as the Astros No. 11 prospect, per MLB Pipeline, and is rated as the Astros No. 14 prospect, per Baseball America ... Rated as the No. 19 prospect in the Carolina League following the '19 season, per Baseball America

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Was named the Midwest League Player of the Week on 4/21/19 with Quad Cities (A) after throwing six scoreless innings and allowing one hit while striking out seven in his start that week vs. Cedar Rapids ... Named Carolina League Player of the Week on 9/2/19 with Fayetteville (A+) after striking out 10 over seven scoreless innings in his start that week at Carolina.

PUT 'EM AWAY: Led Fayetteville (A+) with 132 strikeouts in '19 and was fourth of Astros minor leaguers with 152 strikeouts on the season ... Logged three starts with at least 10 strikeouts (all with Fayetteville, A+), including a professional career-high 11 strikeouts on 8/3/19 vs. Myrtle Beach

INNINGS EATER: Was second on Fayetteville (A+) with 98 2/3 IP and tied for seventh of all Astros minor leaguers in '19 with 110 2/3 IP.

COLLEGE DAYS: The Astros selected Dubin in the 13th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Georgetown College (Georgetown, KY). Struck out a school-record 128 batters and went 9-1 with a 2.09 ERA in his lone season at Georgetown College after transferring from the University of Buffalo. He became the third player in Georgetown College history to be named an NAIA First-Team All-American.
