Today's Game

The Fightin Phils continue their final home series, and penultimate series, of the 2024 season against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It's the only meetings between the teams this season. Reading and Erie did not face off in 2023, and this is the first meeting between them since July 26-31, 2022, at Erie (Erie won series 5-1). It's the first time the SeaWolves come to FirstEnergy Stadium since May 4-9, 2021 (Erie won 4-2) to open the 2021 season.

Game 127 Recap

The Fightin Phils used a four-run bottom of the ninth inning to rally for a 6-5 win over Erie on Wednesday night to grab the 2-0 edge in this week's six-game series. Christian McGowan lasted just one inning, but the bullpen combined to allowed three runs on four hits over the final eight innings of the game. Justin Crawford, Gabriel Rincones Jr. and Robert Moore all had two hits, and Otto Kemp drove in two runs. Aidan Miller had a big RBI single in the bottom of the ninth to keep the line moving, leading to the eventual walk off on catchers' interference.

A Rare Comeback

Wednesday's game was not the first time in R-Phils' history that they won a game on catchers' interference. Reading had a walk-off catchers' interference on June 20, 2007, when Jason Hill drew the interference to five Reading a 3-2 win over Binghamton. Wednesday's win was the second time this season Reading won a game when trailing entering their final at bats. The other instance was on July 14 against Akron at home.

Eastern League Honors for Chace

Moises Chace was nothing short of dominant in his third Double-A start on Saturday, which led to his selection as Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. After setting a then-career high with 10 strikeouts over 4.2 innings last week at Binghamton, he followed that with a new career-high 13 strikeouts over a career-best six-innings pitched last Saturday. His 13 strikeouts are the most by a Reading pitcher this season, with the previous high being 11, done three times. The last Reading pitcher with exactly 13 strikeouts in a game was Adam Walker on May 10, 2001, at Portland. His 13 strikeouts were also the most in a game by a Fightin Phil sine Spencer Howard had 12 on Sept. 4, 2019, against Trenton. In total, Chace retired 18-of-19 hitters and the final 16 he faced. 13 of his 18 outs were via a strikeout (72%). He collected 19 swing and missed on the night, with 13 of those coming against his fastball. Since his Double-A debut (August 17), Chace leads the Eastern League with 29 strikeouts.

It's Miller Time

The Philadelphia Phillies announced on Tuesday that No. 1 prospect (according to MLB Pipeline) Aidan Miller was promoted to Reading from High-A Jersey Shore. Miller was the Phillies first round draft pick in the 2023 draft. He began the season with Single-A Clearwater and after a strong start with the Threshers, Miller was promoted to Jersey Shore on June 11.

Crawford Cruising

Justin Crawford turned in another stellar performance on Wednesday night. The Phillies No. 3 Prospect had two hits, one run and a stolen base. Crawford now owns 14-multi hit games over his 32 appearances on the season, meaning he has two-plus hits in a game 44% of the time. He also leads the team with six three-hit games since joining Reading on July 19.

Home Cooking

Following Wednesday night's win, the Fightin Phils are 35-30 at FirstEnergy Stadium this season. After last night, Reading has clinched a winning record at home for the first time since going 36-33 in 2022. This comes after the R-Phils posted a 23-44 record at home last season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

September 5, 2023: At Reading, six first-inning runs lead the R-Phils to a 6-3 win over Portland. Zach Haake was excellent, going a season-high (tied career high) six innings and allowed just one hit, no runs and four strikeouts. Carlos De La Cruz hit a two-run homer in the first and Pedro Martinez also homered.

Sup SeaWolves

Erie enters tonight with a 32-26 record in the second half, which is second-best in the Southwest division. They went 38-29 in the first half and won the division. The SeaWolves will play Akron in the Southwest division finals in two weeks. Their roster has four players on the Tigers' top-30 prospects list, according to MLB Pipeline: Jackson Jobe (2), Hao-Yu Lee (8), Troy Melton (12) and Eric Silva (29).

On the Mound for Erie

Righty, and Tigers No. 2 prospect Jackson Jobe makes the start tonight for Erie. This season, Jobe has made 15 starts for Erie and is 3-2, with a 2.03 ERA (66.2 IP, 39 H, 36 BB, 73 SO). Jobe last pitched Aug. 30 against Richmond, allowing no runs on three hits over just 1.2 innings pitched. He walked one and struck out three. Jobe was on the IL from May 2 to July 5, which included a rehab stop with High-A West Michigan. Jobe split 2023 between four levels in the Tigers system, going 2-4, with a 2.81 ERA over 16 starts. He began his pro career in 2022 between Single-A Lakeland and High-A West Michigan. The Tigers drafted the 22-year old in the first round (third overall) of the 2021 draft out of Heritage Hall High School in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Took loss on July 1 at Wilmington, allowing six runs on three home runs. Earned win with six innings of one-run ball on May 11 vs Wilmington. Earned win with six-scoreless frames, striking out eight, on May 4 vs Bowling Green. Was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week following start. Struck out career-high nine over six innings on Apr. 16 in win vs Brooklyn. Also allowed just one-earned run. Had back-to-back wins to open season. Pitched for Trenton in MLB Draft League in summer of 2022, going 2-1, with 2.45 ERA over six appearances and two starts, prior to getting signed. 4-2 record, with 3.42 ERA over nine appearances and eight starts in 2021.
