### TODAY'S HEADLINES

#### Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 288-271 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints could not overcome a seven-run third inning for the Iowa Cubs in an 11-8 loss on Monday. The I-Cubs hit three home runs in the third inning, taking an 8-1 lead. The Saints would trail 10-1 after the top of the sixth inning, but would out-score the Cubs 7-1 the remainder of the game. 11 of the Saints' 13 hits came after the fifth inning in the loss, including Yunior Severino's 20<sup>th</sup> home run of the season that came in the ninth inning. Byron Buxton went 1-for-3 with a walk and run scored on Major League rehab. Emmanuel Rodriguez also made his Triple-A debut, going 0-for-3 with two walks and an RBI.

BRENT'S BACK: Brent Headrick returns to the Saints' pitching staff tonight, making his first AAA appearance since April 6 at Nashville, where he threw 5.0 shutout innings with seven strikeouts. Headrick was placed on the 7-Day Injured List on April 8 with a left forearm strain. He made one minor league rehab appearance with Fort Myers on August 28, throwing 1.1 innings. Last season, Headrick started 12 games (19 total app) for the Saints, going 4-2 with a 4.68 ERA and made his Major League debut, going 3-0 with a 6.31 ERA in 14 appearances

ANOTHER RECORD FOR RANDY: Randy Dobnak, who is scheduled to throw in relief tonight, sits at 114 strikeouts for the season, one short of the single-season record 115 he recorded last year. Dobnak is also the single-season record holder with 10 victories this season. He is tied for the second-most wins in the league this year and his 114 punch outs are good for the eighth-most in the league.

REHAB RUNDOWN: Byron Buxton will play his second game on Major League Rehab with the Saints tonight. Buxton was placed on the Twins' 10-Day Injured List on August 15 (retro August 13) with right hip inflammation. In his previous rehab stint, Buxton went 0-for-6 with an RBI. In his current stint, he is 1-3 with a run scored. In his 14 career games with the Saints, Buxton has hit .279 (12-43) with two Saints Score First ......39-22 doubles, a triple, three home runs and 11 RBI.

> A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: DaShawn Keirsey Jr. has put together an impressive 2024 campaign, recording 118 hits, 14 home runs and 35 stolen bases. He is the only International League player and one of two in Triple-A (Samad Taylor - TAC) this season to record at least 100 hits, 10 home runs and 30 steals. He is one of 14

**ELECTRIC EELES:** Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .408 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 41 of the 47 games he's played in, drawing 21 walks and been hit by a pitch seven times. He is fifth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .433 across three levels.

S Severino has now collected 111 hits on the season, becoming the sixth player in franchise history, and second this season (DaShawn Keirsey Jr.), to surpass the 100-hit mark in a single season. He also ranks second in the single-season home run charts, trailing the 21 long balls that Jair Camargo and Chris Williams hit last season.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins dropped 2-1 to Tampa Bay on Tuesday night. David Festa took the loss, striking out seven over 5.0 innings. Carlos Santana went 2-for-3 with a solo home run in the loss.

MiLB Rehab start

LAST APPEARANCE: 8/28 v CLR...made minor league rehab start with Single-A Fort Myers, his first outing since since April 6 at Nashville...threw 1.1 innings in the start, allowing two hits and one walk...allowed singles to the first two batters he faced, retiring the next three in the first inning...started the second inning with a hit batter and a walk before recording a flyout to finish the start...of 35 pitches, threw 21 fastballs, 11 sliders and three changeups...did not factor into the decision in an 8-1 Mighty Mussels loss.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 4/6 @ NAS...made second start of the season, throwing 5.0 shutout innings, allowing two hits, three walks and seven strikeouts...allowed singles in the second and third innings... five of seven strikeouts were swinging...recorded first win of the season in 3-0 Saints victory.

CALL HIM STEPH HEADRICK: Played basketball all three years at Reed-Custer (IL) HS from 2014-16. Made a school record 127, 3-points as a junior in 2015, tied for 17th most in a single-season in state history. He earned All-State in basketball as a junior and senior in 2015 & 2016 and All-Area and All-Conference all three years from 2014-16. His team won the regional championship all three years.

ON THE LINKS: As if baseball and basketball weren't enough, Headrick also played two years on the Reed-Custer (IL) HS golf team.

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS: Headrick led Reed-Custer (IL) HS to a State Title during his senior season in 2016. Went 11-1 with a 1.94 ERA and 118 strikeouts and was named the Class 2A Player of the Year.

SEEING RED: Following his success in high school, Headrick spent three years at Illinois State University. He finished off his junior year by being named Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Year, All-MVC First Team, & All-MVC Tournament Team in 2019. While with the Redbirds in 2019 he went 9-3, 3.47 ERA (96.0 IP, 37 ER) while walking 31 and striking out 115 in 16 starts.

SPACE CAMP WOULD HAVE BEEN COOL TOO: Following the 2021 season, Headrick went to Twins velocity camp in hopes of increasing the speed of his fastball. While at the camp, he significantly altered his workout and cleaned up his mechanics. He was topping out at 89 mph in 2021. His average fastball jumped to 91 in spring training and topped out at 96. His shorter arm path allowed him to throw with efficient mechanics and his body was able to recover a lot faster. He was able to throw more often with less stress and was able to lift harder because he could recover faster.

GUYS WITH BIG HANDS...HAVE TROUBLE GRIPPING THE SLIDER: In late July, 2022 Headrick finally developed a slider grip while working with Double-A pitching coaches Pete Larson (now with the Saints) and Dan Urbina. He had worked with 10-12 grips in the past, but with his hands being so big he could never get one that worked. Not only did he find the grip, but he went from throwing a slider at 78 mph to throwing it at 83 mph.

BIG TEX: Headrick pitched the third and deciding game of the Texas League Championship in 2022 against the Frisco RoughRiders while with the Wichita Wind Surge. He tossed 7.0 scoreless innings on three hits while not walking anyone and striking out 11. He retired 19 of the final 20 batters he faced while throwing 95 pitches, 64 for strikes. He left leading 2-0, but Wichita lost 7-5 to Frisco in 10 innings.

JOHNNY BENCH MEET BRENT HEADRICK: It became a parlor trick for the Hall of Fame catcher, Johnny Bench. He went on TV, took photos, and in the last couple of years proved he could still do it: hold seven baseballs in one hand. Headrick, known for his large hands (see above note), can also hold seven baseballs in one hand.

CUBE SMART: Following the 2023 offseason, Headrick decided he wanted to learn how to solve a Rubik's Cube. His best time was 1:59 and he can routinely do it in under three minutes

SAINTS RANDY: In 2023, Dobnak was a workhorse for the Saints, setting a number of single-season records. He set the franchise record for starts (26), innings pitched (126.1 IP), and strikeouts (115). The 2023 season was Dobnak's third with the Saints and consequently he is the franchise leader in two of those three categories as well: his 33 starts are four more than the #2 pitcher, Simeon Woods Richardson, his 164.1 IP are 12.0 more than Ronny Henriquez, and his 147 strikeouts are just eight shy of Ronny Henriquez.

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often go to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3,380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield State.

TWILIGHT SPARKLE MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the USPBL.

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception of one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything bad."

NOT QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Párk, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his fiancées in full attire.

CANDLESTICKS MAKE A NICE GIFT: Before getting married, some of Dobnak's wedding registry gifts wound up in the Twins game notes on September 20 (Amazon Echo, 67-inch leaf rake and Pine-Sol). All of it was the handiwork of intern lan Kraft. The publicity of their registry becoming public made the soon to be married couple ask fans to donate to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital, which has always been important to Aerial Dobnak due to her lifelong desire to be involved with children and her experience with the loss of a friend to cancer during her freshman year of college at Alderson Broaddus University, instead of buying them gifts. Their initial goal was \$2,000 and within 8 hours that goal was met. Eventually they raised \$4,093. But the story didn't end there. A representative of St. Jude reached out to her on social media afterward, wondering if the couple would be willing to engage in more significant involvement with the hospital once the wedding buzz had died down. They jumped at the opportunity, and the Dobnak's were flown to the hospital in Memphis for a weekend in January to meet patients, connect with fundraising coordinators and evaluate their options for continued future engagement.
